# HP 150 Wired Keyboard User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

It features a full-sized layout with a numeric keypad, low-profile chiclet keys for quiet typing, and dedicated function key shortcuts. ## 2. SETUP

The HP 150 Wired Keyboard is designed for simple plug-and-play connectivity, requiring no additional software or drivers for basic functionality.

### 2.1 Package Contents

## 2.2 Connecting the Keyboard

1. Locate an available USB-A port on your computer (desktop PC, laptop, etc.).
2. Insert the USB connector of the keyboard's cable into the USB-A port.
3. The operating system will automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. The keyboard is ready for use once detected.

## 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The HP 150 Wired Keyboard provides a standard QWERTY layout with a full numeric keypad, suitable for general typing, data entry, and navigation.

- macOS

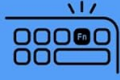
- Chrome OS

### 3.2 Function Keys (F1-F12)

The top row of keys (F1-F12) includes dedicated shortcut functions. These functions can be activated directly or by pressing the **Fn** key in combination with the desired F-key, depending on your system's default settings or specific software.

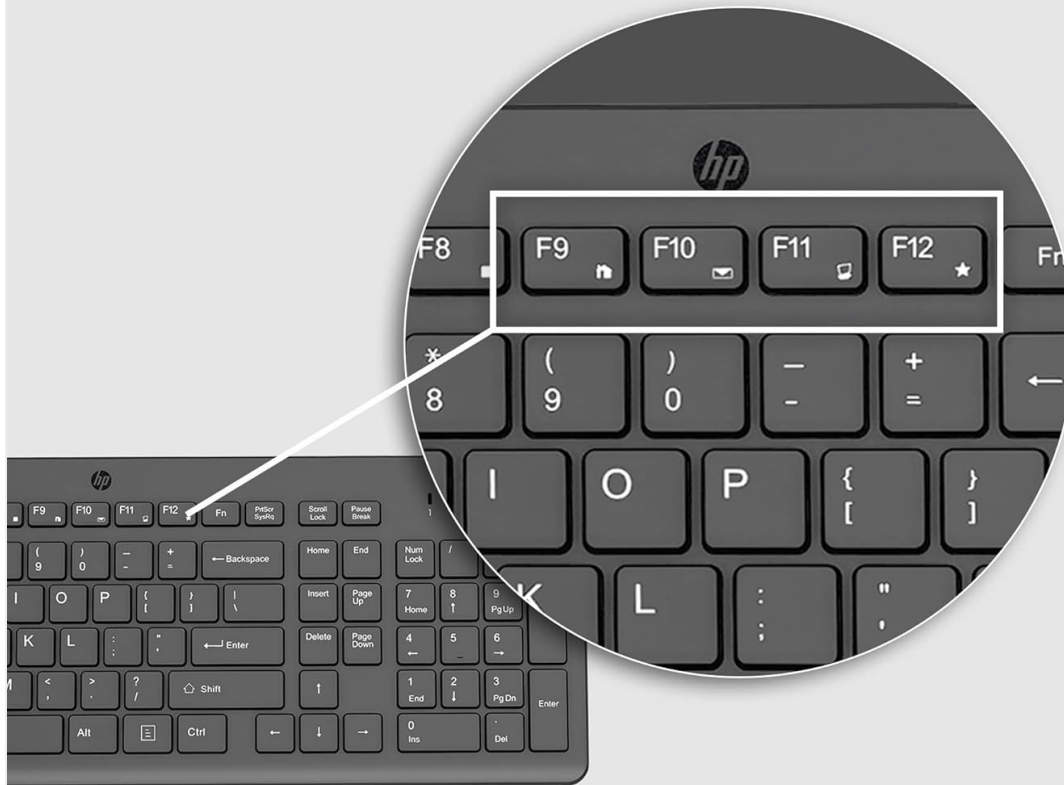


Figure 3: Function keys with integrated shortcuts.

## 3.3 LED Indicators

The keyboard features LED indicators to show the status of specific lock functions:

- **Num Lock LED:** Illuminates when the numeric keypad is active.
- **Caps Lock LED:** Illuminates when Caps Lock is engaged, indicating that all typed letters will be uppercase.
- **Scroll Lock LED:** Illuminates when Scroll Lock is active. Its function varies by application, often affecting scrolling behavior in spreadsheets or text editors.

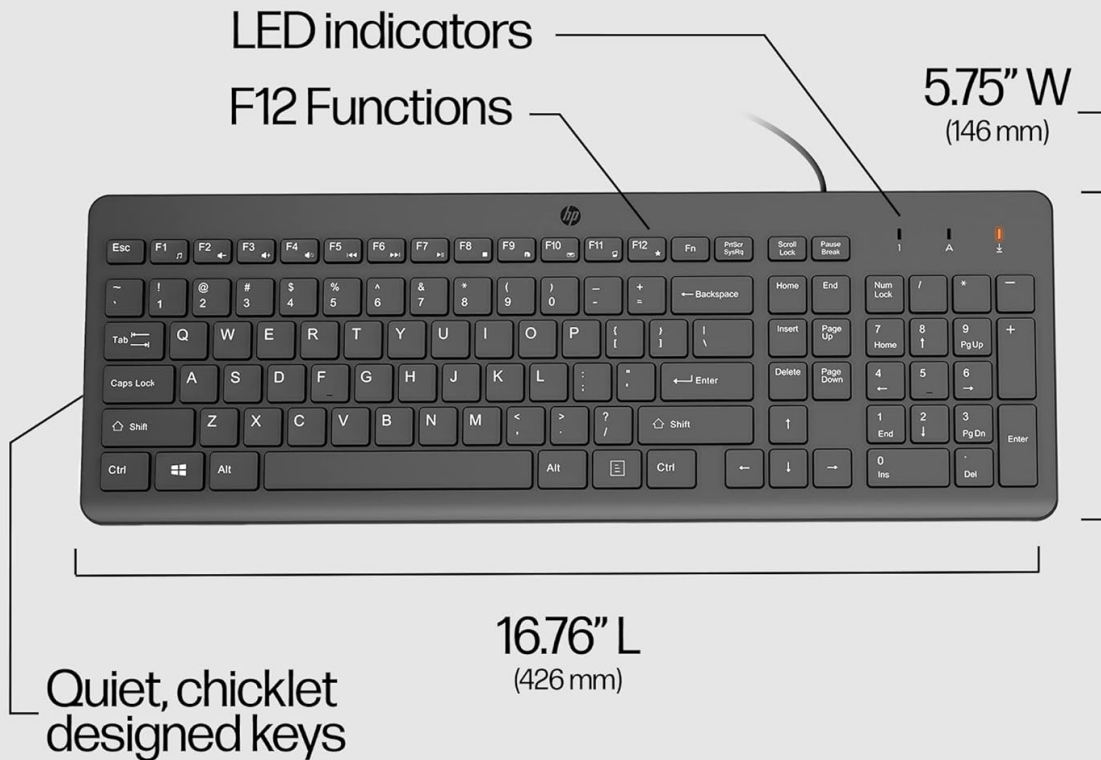


Figure 4: LED indicators for Num Lock, Caps Lock, and Scroll Lock.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your keyboard.

### 4.1 Cleaning

- Disconnect the keyboard from your computer before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to wipe the keycaps and surface.
- Avoid spraying liquids directly onto the keyboard.
- For debris between keys, use compressed air.

### 4.2 Storage

Store the keyboard in a dry, cool environment away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use for extended periods.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your HP 150 Wired Keyboard, refer to the following common solutions.

### 5.1 Keyboard Not Responding

- **Check USB Connection:** Ensure the USB cable is securely plugged into a working USB port on your computer. Try a different USB port.
- **Restart Computer:** Sometimes a simple system restart can resolve connectivity issues.
- **Test on Another Computer:** If possible, connect the keyboard to another computer to determine if the issue is with the keyboard or your original computer's setup.

### 5.2 Keys Not Working or Typing Incorrect Characters

- **Clean Keys:** Check for any debris or obstructions under the affected keys. Use compressed air to clear them.
- **Check Language Settings:** Ensure your operating system's keyboard language settings match your physical keyboard layout.
- **Driver Reinstallation:** Although plug-and-play, sometimes reinstalling drivers can help. Disconnect the keyboard, restart your computer, and then reconnect it.

### 5.3 LED Indicators Not Lighting Up

- **Verify Function:** Ensure Num Lock, Caps Lock, or Scroll Lock is actually activated. Press the respective key to toggle its status.
- **Check Connection:** A loose USB connection might prevent proper power delivery to the LEDs.
