PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Pocket Hose Copper Bullet is an innovative garden hose designed for ease of use and durability. It features a unique expanding and contracting design, making it lightweight and easy to store. The hose is equipped with robust copper anodized aluminum fittings and a multi-pattern spray nozzle.

- Lightweight and Compact:** Designed to be lightweight and shrink for easy storage when drained.

- Do not drink water from the hose unless explicitly stated that it is potable water safe. While the hose features lead-free components, local water quality and faucet conditions may vary.
- Always turn off the water supply and drain the hose after each use to prevent damage and ensure longevity.
- Do not leave the hose pressurized or exposed to direct sunlight for extended periods when not in use, especially in extreme temperatures.
- Avoid dragging the hose over sharp objects or abrasive surfaces that could puncture or damage the outer sleeve.
- Keep out of reach of children when not in use.
- Ensure all connections are secure before turning on the water to prevent leaks.

SETUP

1. **Unpack the Hose:** Carefully remove the Pocket Hose Copper Bullet from its packaging.
2. **Connect to Faucet:** Attach the larger, female end of the hose to a standard outdoor faucet. Ensure the connection is hand-tight to prevent leaks. The copper anodized aluminum connectors are designed for a secure fit.

3. **Attach Nozzle:** If not already attached, screw the Turbo Shot multi-pattern spray nozzle onto the male end of the hose. This nozzle is removable, allowing you to use other standard spray nozzles if preferred.
4. **Position the Hose:** Lay the hose out in the desired area. It will expand significantly once water is introduced.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Turn on Water:** Slowly turn on the water supply at the faucet. The Pocket Hose Copper Bullet will begin to expand to its full length (up to 100 feet) as it fills with water.

2. **Adjust Spray Pattern:** Use the Turbo Shot multi-pattern nozzle to select your desired spray pattern. The nozzle typically offers various settings such as pinpoint, full power, and fine mist. Rotate the nozzle head to cycle through the patterns.

3. **Watering:** Direct the water flow as needed for your gardening or cleaning tasks.
4. **Turn Off Water:** When finished, turn off the water supply at the faucet.
5. **Drain and Store:** Allow the water to drain from the hose. As the water drains, the hose will automatically contract back to its original compact size, making it easy to coil and store. Ensure all water is drained for optimal storage and longevity.

MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

- **Complete Drainage:** Always ensure the hose is fully drained of water after each use. This allows it to contract completely and prevents water from freezing inside during colder temperatures, which can cause damage.
- **Proper Storage:** Store the hose in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Its compact size makes it easy to store in a bucket, shelf, or hose reel.
- **Avoid Prolonged Sun Exposure:** While durable, prolonged exposure to harsh UV rays can degrade materials over time. Store indoors or in a shaded area when not in use.
- **Inspect Connections:** Periodically check the connectors for any signs of wear or damage. Ensure the rubber gasket is properly seated to prevent leaks.
- **Cleaning:** If the hose becomes dirty, wipe it down with a damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Hose not expanding fully.	Insufficient water pressure; kink in the hose; partial blockage.	Ensure faucet is fully open. Check for any kinks or twists in the hose. Verify water pressure at the source.
Hose not contracting fully.	Water still inside the hose; residual pressure.	Turn off water supply completely. Open the nozzle to drain all remaining water. Lift the hose to help gravity drain any trapped water.
Leaks at connections.	Loose connection; damaged gasket; damaged threads.	Tighten connections securely by hand. Inspect the rubber gasket inside the connector for damage and replace if necessary. Ensure threads are clean and undamaged.
Water flow is weak or inconsistent.	Partial kink; nozzle blockage; low water pressure.	Straighten any kinks. Clean the nozzle to remove any debris. Check water pressure from the faucet.


