# Starfrit Electric Mini Pancake Maker - Instruction Manual

Model: 024724-006-0000

## 1. IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

---

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons. Read all instructions carefully before using this appliance.

- Read all instructions.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or the appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner. Contact customer service for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- To disconnect, remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The Starfrit Electric Mini Pancake Maker is designed for convenient preparation of individual 4-inch pancakes. It features a non-stick cooking surface for easy food release and cleaning, a cool-touch handle for safe operation, and an indicator light to signal readiness.

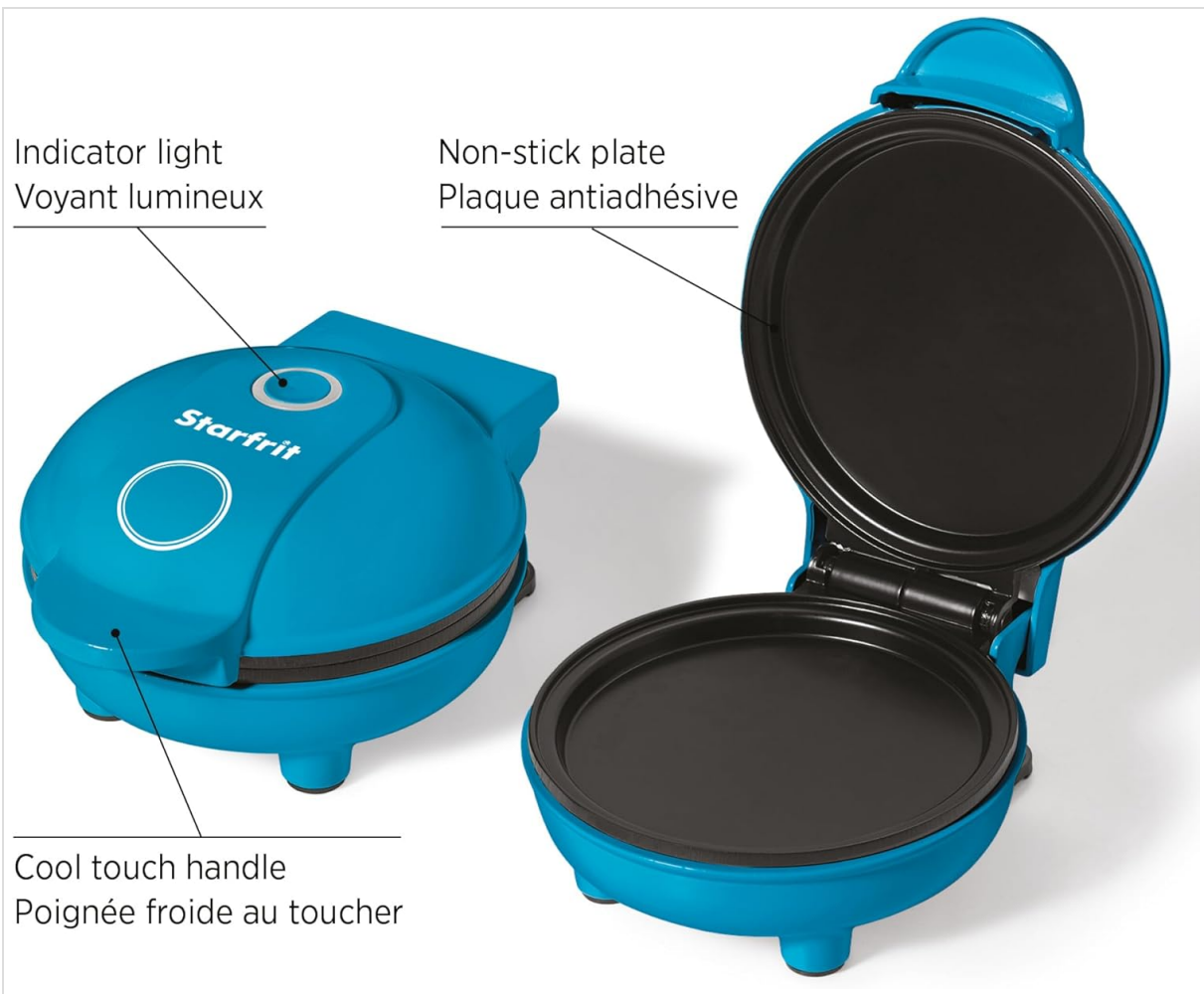


Image: Starfrit Electric Mini Pancake Maker with key components labeled, including the indicator light, non-stick plate, and cool-touch handle.

### 3. BEFORE INITIAL USE

---

1. Carefully unpack the pancake maker and remove all packaging materials.
2. Wipe the cooking plates with a damp cloth or sponge and dry thoroughly. Do not immerse the appliance in water.
3. For the first use, it is recommended to operate the appliance without food for a few minutes to burn off any manufacturing residues. A slight odor or smoke may be present; this is normal. Ensure the area is well-ventilated.
4. **Important Note:** The manufacturer advises against consuming the first few pancakes made with the appliance. This is to ensure any residual manufacturing oils or coatings are fully removed.

### 4. SETUP

---

1. Place the pancake maker on a stable, heat-resistant, and dry surface.
2. Ensure there is adequate space around the appliance for ventilation.
3. Plug the power cord into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet. The indicator light will illuminate,

signaling that the appliance is preheating.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps to prepare pancakes:

1. **Preheat:** Plug in the appliance. The indicator light will turn on, indicating that the unit is heating. Wait for the light to turn off, which signifies that the pancake maker has reached its optimal cooking temperature.
2. **Add Batter:** Carefully open the lid using the cool-touch handle. Pour approximately 1/4 cup of pancake batter onto the center of the bottom cooking plate. Do not overfill.
3. **Cook:** Close the lid. Allow the pancake to cook for a few minutes. Cooking time may vary based on batter consistency and desired browning. The indicator light may cycle on and off during cooking to maintain temperature.
4. **Check and Remove:** Open the lid to check for doneness. The pancake should be golden brown. Use a non-metallic utensil (e.g., plastic or silicone spatula) to carefully remove the cooked pancake. Avoid using metal utensils, which can damage the non-stick coating.
5. **Repeat:** Close the lid and allow the appliance to reheat if the indicator light comes back on. Repeat the process for additional pancakes.

## 6. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

---

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your appliance.

1. **Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the pancake maker from the electrical outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. **Wipe Plates:** Use a soft, damp cloth or sponge to wipe the non-stick cooking plates. For stubborn residue, a small amount of mild dish soap can be used, followed by wiping with a clean, damp cloth.
3. **Clean Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the appliance with a damp cloth.
4. **Do Not Immerse:** Never immerse the pancake maker, its cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
5. **Avoid Abrasives:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or metal utensils, as these can damage the non-stick coating and exterior finish.
6. **Storage:** Once clean and dry, store the appliance in a cool, dry place.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Appliance does not heat:**
  - Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
  - Check if the outlet is functional by plugging in another appliance.
- **Pancakes are not cooking evenly (bottom cooks faster than top):**
  - This can be a characteristic of some mini pancake makers. To achieve more even browning, you may carefully flip the pancake using a non-metallic spatula halfway through the cooking process.
  - Ensure the appliance is fully preheated before adding batter.
- **Pancakes stick to the cooking surface:**
  - Ensure the non-stick surface is clean and free of any residue.
  - Lightly grease the cooking plates with a small amount of cooking oil or butter before each use, especially if using a new recipe or if sticking occurs.

- **Smoke or odor during initial use:**

- This is normal for the first few uses as manufacturing residues burn off. Ensure good ventilation. If smoke persists after several uses, discontinue use and contact customer service.
