## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the PawHut Foldable Pet Stroller. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your pet stroller. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

## Safety Warnings

- Always ensure your pet is securely fastened inside the stroller using the internal safety leashes.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 20 kg (44 lbs).
- Never leave your pet unattended in the stroller.
- Ensure all locking mechanisms are engaged before placing your pet inside or moving the stroller.
- Regularly check the stroller for any signs of wear or damage. Do not use if damaged.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all components are present before assembly:

- Stroller Frame
- Pet Compartment (Oxford Fabric)
- Front Wheels (x2)
- Rear Wheels with Brakes (x2)
- Removable Cushion
- Instruction Manual

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to assemble your pet stroller:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging.

## 2. Attach Wheels:

- Insert the front universal wheels into their designated slots until they click securely into place.
- Attach the rear wheels with brakes to the rear axle. Ensure they are firmly attached and the brake mechanism is functional.

3. **Unfold Frame:** Locate the folding mechanism (often a latch or button on the handle or side frame). Release it and unfold the stroller frame until it locks into its open position. Ensure the frame is fully extended and stable.

4. **Install Pet Compartment:** If separate, attach the Oxford fabric pet compartment to the frame according to the specific instructions provided in the included manual.

5. **Place Cushion:** Insert the removable cushion into the bottom of the pet compartment for your pet's comfort.

## Folding and Unfolding

- **Unfolding:** Release the folding latch and extend the frame until it clicks into the fully open position.
- **Folding:** Engage the one-hand folding system, typically a button or lever on the handle, and collapse the stroller until it locks in the folded position.

## Securing Your Pet

The stroller is equipped with two internal safety leashes. Always attach these leashes to your pet's harness or collar to prevent them from jumping out during transport.

## Using the Brakes

The rear wheels feature directional brakes. To engage the brakes, press down on the brake levers located near the rear wheels. Ensure both brakes are engaged when parking the stroller to prevent accidental movement.

## Pet Access and Ventilation

The pet compartment features multiple zippered mesh openings for optimal ventilation and visibility. There are typically front and rear access points for easy entry and exit for your pet.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning Fabric:** The Oxford fabric components are machine washable. Refer to the care label for specific washing instructions.
- **Frame Cleaning:** Wipe the steel frame with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Dry thoroughly to prevent rust.
- **Wheel Maintenance:** Periodically check wheels for debris and ensure they rotate freely. Lubricate axles if necessary.
- **Storage:** Store the stroller in a dry, cool place when not in use.

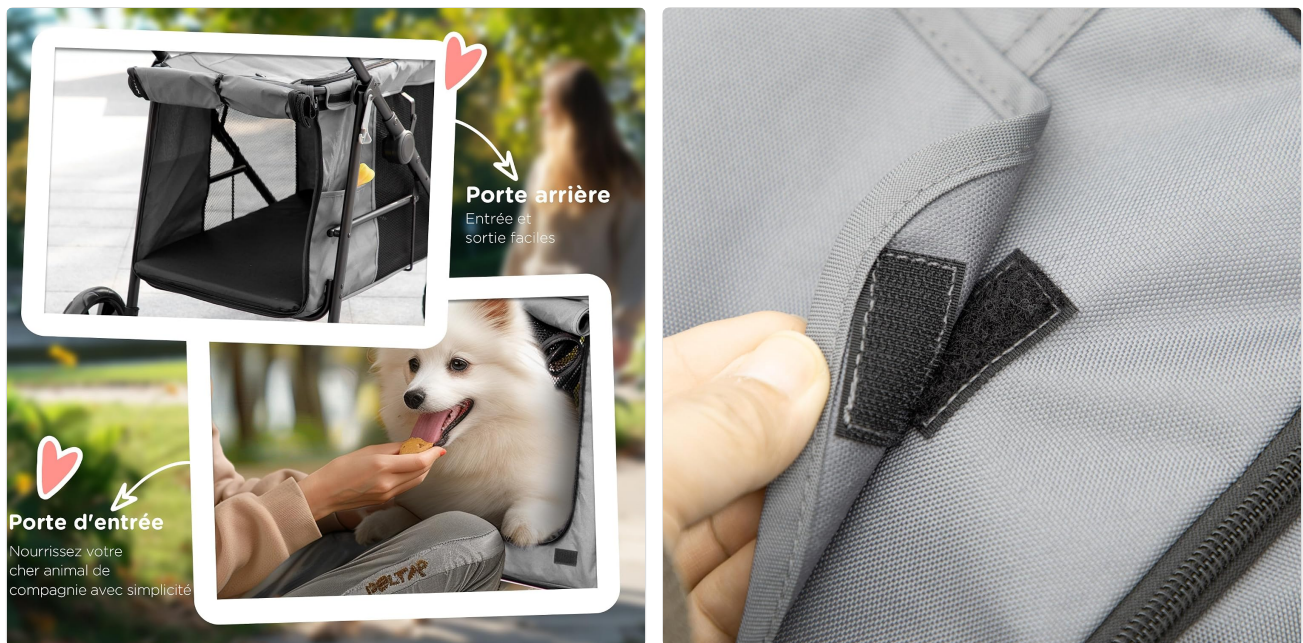


Figure 4: Details of fabric fasteners (Velcro and zipper) for easy cleaning and access.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Stroller does not fold/unfold smoothly:** Check for any obstructions in the folding mechanism. Ensure all latches are properly disengaged/engaged.
- **Wheels are stiff or squeaky:** Clean any dirt or hair from the wheel axles. Apply a small amount of lubricant if needed.
- **Brakes are not holding:** Verify that the brake levers are fully depressed. Check for any wear on the brake pads or wheel surface.
- **Pet seems uncomfortable:** Ensure the cushion is properly placed. Check that the pet is not too large for the compartment (refer to specifications).
