1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Read all instructions before operating the vehicle. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or property damage.

- **Adult Supervision Required:** This product is intended for children aged 1-8 years. Constant adult supervision is mandatory during operation.
- **Weight Limit:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 66 lbs (approximately 30 kg).
- **Safety Belt:** Always ensure the child is securely fastened with the provided safety belt.
- **Operating Environment:** Use the vehicle on flat, dry surfaces such as asphalt, brick, or cement roads. Avoid slopes, uneven terrain, sand, mud, or wet conditions.
- **Soft Start System:** The vehicle features a soft start design to prevent sudden acceleration, ensuring a safer experience for young children.
- **Remote Control Priority:** In manual operation, the parental remote control has priority, allowing adults to override child input for safety.
- **ASTM Certified:** This electric vehicle is ASTM-certified, meeting recognized safety standards.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The TOBBI 12V Electric Fire Truck Ride-On Car is designed to provide an engaging and realistic driving experience for children. It features a range of interactive elements and safety measures.

- Flashing LED lights for enhanced visibility and play.

3. SETUP

Assembly:

Assembly of the TOBBI Fire Truck Ride-On Car is required. Please refer to the detailed assembly instructions provided in the separate assembly manual included with your product. Ensure all parts are securely fastened before initial use.

Initial Battery Charging:

1. Locate the charging port on the vehicle.
2. Connect the charger to the charging port and then plug it into a standard wall outlet.

3. Allow the battery to charge for the recommended duration (typically 8-12 hours for the first charge) as specified in the assembly manual. Do not overcharge.
4. A full charge provides approximately 60-81 minutes of continuous use.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Driving Modes:

The fire truck offers two distinct driving modes:

- **Child Manual Driving Mode:** The child operates the vehicle using the steering wheel and accelerator pedal. This mode typically has two speed settings.
- **Parental Remote Control Mode:** An adult can control the vehicle's movement (forward, reverse, left, right) and speed using the 2.4GHz remote control. This mode offers three speed settings for parental guidance and safety.

Using the Remote Control:

The 2.4GHz remote control allows parents to safely guide the vehicle. Refer to the remote control section in your assembly manual for pairing instructions. The remote typically features buttons for forward/reverse, left/right steering, and speed selection.

Siren, Lights, and Media Functions:

- **Walkie-Talkie/Speaker:** Utilize the integrated speaker for interactive play, simulating a walkie-talkie function.

5. MAINTENANCE

Battery Care and Charging:

- Always use the original charger provided with the vehicle.
- Charge the battery after each use. Do not allow the battery to fully discharge for extended periods.
- If the vehicle will not be used for a long time, charge the battery at least once a month to prolong its lifespan.
- Avoid charging in extreme temperatures.

Cleaning:

- Wipe the vehicle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Avoid spraying water directly onto electrical components.

Storage:

- Store the vehicle in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- When storing, ensure the battery is fully charged.
- The retractable handle and small wheels allow for easy movement and storage when the vehicle is not in use.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicle does not move or power on.	Battery is low or not connected. Power switch is off. Loose wiring.	Ensure battery is fully charged and properly connected. Turn the power switch ON. Check all wiring connections as per the assembly manual.
Remote control not working.	Remote control batteries are dead. Remote is not paired with the vehicle.	Replace remote control batteries. Follow pairing instructions in the manual to re-sync the remote.
Siren, horn, or music functions are not working.	Loose internal wiring for audio components.	Check internal wiring connections, particularly for sound components. If unsure, contact customer support.
Vehicle turns more easily in one direction than the other.	Steering mechanism imbalance or defect.	Inspect the steering linkage for any obstructions or damage. If the issue persists, contact customer support for assistance.
