Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Coby Portable CD Player with MP3 Playback and FM Radio. This device is designed for on-the-go audio entertainment, offering clear sound and versatile playback options. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper operation and to maximize your listening experience.

Safety Information

To ensure safe operation and prevent damage, please observe the following precautions:

- Do not expose the unit to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, or high humidity.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the unit to strong impacts.
- Do not disassemble the unit. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.
- Keep the unit away from water and other liquids.
- Use only the specified power source (2 AA batteries or compatible power adapter, sold separately).
- Listening at high volume levels for extended periods can cause hearing damage.

Product Overview

Key Features:

- 60-Second Anti-Skip Protection: Ensures uninterrupted playback during movement.
- MP3 Playback: Supports MP3 audio files on CD-R/RW discs.
- FM Radio: Built-in FM tuner for listening to radio stations.
- Foldable Headphones: Compact and adjustable for convenience.
- Clear Sound and Super Bass: Enhanced audio quality for an immersive experience.
- User-Friendly Interface: Simple controls for easy operation.



Setup

Follow these steps to set up your CD player for first use.

1. Power Source Installation

The CD player operates on two (2) AA batteries (not included) or via a compatible power adapter (sold separately) connected to the USB port.

- 1. Open the battery compartment cover located on the bottom of the unit.
- 2. Insert two new AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+ and -).
- 3. Close the battery compartment cover securely.
- 4. Alternatively, connect a compatible USB power adapter (sold separately) to the unit's USB port for continuous power.

2. Connecting Headphones

- 1. Unfold the included headphones.
- 2. Insert the 3.5mm audio jack of the headphones into the "PHONE" jack on the side of the CD player.

Operating Instructions

1. Playing a CD

- 1. Gently press the "OPEN" button or slide the latch to open the CD compartment lid.
- 2. Place a CD (audio CD or MP3 CD) onto the spindle with the label side facing up.
- 3. Close the CD compartment lid firmly until it clicks.
- 4. Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** button (>) to start playback.
- 5. The display will show the track number and elapsed time.
- 6. To pause, press PLAY/PAUSE again. Press again to resume.
- 7. To skip to the next track, press the **NEXT** button ().
- 8. To go back to the beginning of the current track or previous track, press the PREVIOUS button ().
- 9. To fast forward or rewind within a track, press and hold the **NEXT** or **PREVIOUS** button.
- 10. To stop playback, press the **STOP** button ().

2. Adjusting Volume

1. Use the **VOLUME** + and **VOLUME** - buttons (or rotary dial, if present) on the side of the unit to adjust the listening volume.

3. Using FM Radio

- 1. With the unit powered on, press the **MODE** button to switch to FM Radio mode.
- 2. The display will show the FM frequency.

- 3. Use the **NEXT** and **PREVIOUS** buttons to tune to different radio stations.
- 4. For automatic scanning and saving of stations, refer to the specific instructions for the **PROG** button (if available) in the quick start guide.

4. Connecting to External Speakers (Optional)

You can connect your CD player to external speakers using a 3.5mm AUX cable (not included).

- 1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm AUX cable to the "LINE OUT" or "AUX OUT" jack on the CD player (if available, otherwise use the headphone jack).
- 2. Connect the other end to the "AUX IN" or "LINE IN" jack on your external speakers.
- 3. Ensure the external speakers are powered on and set to the correct input.

Maintenance

Proper care will extend the life of your CD player.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the unit. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. For the lens, use a specialized CD lens cleaner.
- **Disc Care:** Handle CDs by their edges. Keep them clean and free of scratches. Store discs in their cases when not in use.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, remove the batteries to prevent leakage. Store the unit in a cool, dry place away from dust.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your CD player, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not power on.	Batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted. Power adapter not connected or faulty.	Replace batteries, ensuring correct polarity. Check power adapter connection.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from headphones.	Headphones not properly connected. Volume too low. Faulty headphones.	Ensure headphones are fully plugged in. Increase volume. Test with another pair of headphones.
CD skips or stops playing.	CD is dirty or scratched. Unit is subjected to strong vibrations.	Clean the CD with a soft cloth. Ensure the unit is on a stable surface or minimize movement.
Cannot play MP3 files.	Disc is not an MP3 CD. MP3 files are corrupted or not properly formatted.	Ensure the disc contains valid MP3 files. Try another MP3 CD.
FM radio reception is poor.	Weak signal. Interference.	Adjust the unit's position. Extend the headphone cable (which acts as an antenna). Move away from other electronic devices.
