## 1. Introduction

---

This instruction manual provides essential information for the proper use and maintenance of your BRUNO Compact Mill Coffee Maker Server Set. This server set is designed exclusively as a replacement part for the BRUNO Compact Mill Coffee Maker. Please read this manual thoroughly before use and keep it for future reference.

### Important Note:

- This server set is specifically for the BRUNO Compact Mill Coffee Maker. It is not compatible with other BRUNO products or coffee makers from different brands.
- This product is intended for replacement in case of damage, loss, or deterioration of your original server.

## 2. Product Overview

---

The BRUNO Compact Mill Coffee Maker Server Set is a glass carafe with a lid and handle, designed to collect and serve brewed coffee from the compatible BRUNO coffee maker. It features measurement markings for convenience.

### 3. Setup

---

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the server set from its packaging. Inspect for any damage that may have occurred during transit.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the server set thoroughly with warm water and mild dish soap. Rinse completely and dry. Refer to the 'Maintenance and Cleaning' section for detailed instructions.
3. **Placement:** Position the clean server set securely on the heating plate of your BRUNO Compact Mill Coffee Maker, ensuring it is correctly aligned to receive brewed coffee.

### 4. Operating Instructions

---

This server set functions as a receptacle for brewed coffee. Its operation is directly linked to the

BRUNO Compact Mill Coffee Maker.

1. **Brewing:** Ensure the server set is correctly placed on the coffee maker's heating plate before starting the brewing cycle. The coffee maker will dispense brewed coffee directly into the server.
2. **Serving:** Once brewing is complete, carefully remove the server from the heating plate using the handle. The handle is designed for safe pouring.
3. **Lid Usage:** The lid helps retain heat and aroma. Place the lid on the server after brewing and when not pouring.
4. **Measurement Markings:** Use the markings on the side of the glass carafe to gauge the volume of coffee.

**Caution:**

- The glass carafe may become hot during and after brewing. Always use the handle.
- Avoid sudden temperature changes, such as placing a hot carafe on a cold surface or adding cold water to a hot carafe, as this may cause the glass to crack.

## 5. Maintenance and Cleaning

---

Regular cleaning ensures hygiene and prolongs the life of your server set.

1. **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, empty any remaining coffee. Wash the server set (carafe and lid) with warm water and a mild, non-abrasive dish soap. Use a soft sponge or cloth to prevent scratching the glass.
2. **Rinsing:** Rinse all parts thoroughly with clean water to remove any soap residue.
3. **Drying:** Allow the server set to air dry completely or dry with a soft, lint-free cloth.
4. **Stain Removal:** For coffee stains, a mixture of baking soda and water or a specialized coffee cleaner can be used. Follow the cleaner's instructions and rinse thoroughly.

**Do Not:**

- Use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or metal brushes, as these can scratch the glass or plastic.
- Place the server set in a dishwasher unless explicitly stated as dishwasher-safe (consult your coffee maker's main manual if unsure). Hand washing is generally recommended for longevity.
- Submerge the entire handle assembly in water for extended periods if it contains any non-waterproof components.

## 6. Troubleshooting

---

This section addresses common concerns related to the server set.

- **Leakage:** Ensure the server is correctly seated on the coffee maker's heating plate and that the lid is properly aligned if it's causing drips. If the server itself is cracked, it must be replaced.
- **Glass Breakage:** Glass is fragile. Avoid dropping the server or subjecting it to impacts. Do not use if cracked or chipped, as it may shatter.
- **Incompatibility:** If the server does not fit your coffee maker, verify that you own the BRUNO

Compact Mill Coffee Maker. This server is not universal.

- **Coffee Not Dispensing:** If coffee is not flowing into the server, check the main BRUNO Compact Mill Coffee Maker manual for troubleshooting steps related to the brewing process. The server itself does not control coffee flow.
