RORIOS Men's Automatic Mechanical Self-Winding Watch

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the RORIOS Men's Automatic Mechanical Self-Winding Watch. This manual provides essential instructions for the proper setup, operation, maintenance, and care of your timepiece. Please read it carefully to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your watch.

Setup

1. Initial Winding

Your RORIOS watch is an automatic mechanical timepiece and does not require a battery. It is powered by the motion of your wrist. For initial use or if the watch has stopped due to inactivity, it needs to be manually wound.

- Gently pull out the crown (the knob on the side of the watch) to position 1.
- Rotate the crown clockwise approximately 15-20 times. This provides the initial power reserve.
- Push the crown back into its original position.

After manual winding, the watch should start ticking. Regular wear (at least 8-10 hours a day) will keep the watch powered through your arm movements.

2. Setting Time, Date, Month, and Day

The watch features a calendar, month, and day display. Refer to the image below for dial feature identification.

- **Setting Time:** Pull the crown out to position 2 (farthest out). Rotate the crown to adjust the hour and minute hands. Once the correct time is set, push the crown back to position 0.
- **Setting Date:** Pull the crown out to position 1. Rotate the crown counter-clockwise to adjust the date. Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this can damage the movement.
- **Setting Month and Day:** The watch features small push-buttons on the side of the case, typically near the crown or on the opposite side. Use a small, non-sharp tool (like a toothpick) to gently press these buttons to advance the month and day displays. Consult the specific markings on your watch for which button controls which display.

3. Adjusting the Leather Strap

The watch comes with a high-quality leather strap and a pin buckle design for easy adjustment.

- To adjust the length, simply move the pin of the buckle to the desired hole on the strap that fits your wrist comfortably.
- Ensure the strap is snug but not too tight, allowing for proper blood circulation and comfort.

Operating Your Watch

1. Automatic Mechanical Movement

Your RORIOS watch is equipped with an automatic mechanical movement. This means it is powered by the natural motion of your wrist. As you wear the watch, an internal rotor winds the mainspring, storing energy. If the watch is not worn for an extended period, it will stop. Simply manually wind it as described in the 'Initial Winding' section or wear it for several hours to restart it.

2. Luminous Function

The watch features luminous pointers that absorb light and glow in low-light conditions, making it easy to read the time at night.

3. Water Resistance

This watch is designed for daily life water resistance. This means it can withstand splashes, rain, and hand-washing. It is not suitable for swimming, showering, or diving.

- Do not operate the crown or push-buttons while the watch is wet.
- Avoid exposing the watch to hot water or steam, as this can compromise the water-resistant seals.

Maintenance

1. Cleaning

- Wipe the watch case and crystal with a soft, dry cloth regularly to remove dust and fingerprints.
- For the leather strap, avoid excessive moisture. If it gets wet, allow it to air dry naturally, away from direct heat or sunlight.
- Do not use chemical cleaners, solvents, or abrasive materials on your watch.

2. Storage

- When not wearing the watch, store it in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Keep the watch away from strong magnetic fields, as these can affect the accuracy of mechanical movements.

Troubleshooting

- **Watch Stops Working:** This is common for automatic mechanical watches if not worn for a period. Manually wind the watch by rotating the crown clockwise 15-20 times, then wear it regularly.
- **Inaccurate Timekeeping:** Mechanical watches can be affected by strong shocks or magnetic fields. If accuracy issues persist after proper winding, contact customer support.
- **Luminous Pointers Not Glowing:** Ensure the watch has been exposed to sufficient light (natural or artificial) to charge the luminous material. The glow intensity and duration depend on the exposure time and light source.
- **Water Inside the Watch:** If you notice condensation or water inside the watch, immediately stop using it and contact customer support. Do not attempt to open the watch yourself.
