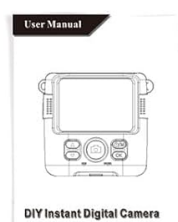

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

The ESOXOFFORE Kids Instant Print Camera offers a range of features designed for an engaging user experience:

- **Instant Print Function:** Print black and white photos directly from the camera in approximately one second.
- **High-Resolution Video:** Record videos in 1080P quality.
- **Digital Zoom:** Features up to 16X digital zoom for capturing distant subjects.
- **Creative Filters & Stickers:** Includes 15 scene filters and 16 sticker options to enhance photos.
- **Time-Lapse Photography:** Set a 3-second time-lapse for delayed shots.
- **Continuous Shooting:** Capture multiple photos in quick succession.
- **Built-in Games:** Enjoy 4 pre-installed puzzle games.
- **MP3 Playback:** Supports MP3 audio playback.
- **Type-C Charging:** Fast and convenient charging via a Type-C port.
- **Durable Design:** Constructed with high-quality soft plastic and a shockproof shell for enhanced

protection.

- **2.4-inch Screen:** A clear display for viewing photos and videos.

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Camera

Before first use, fully charge the camera. Connect the provided USB Type-C cable to the camera's charging port and a compatible USB power adapter (not included). The charging indicator will show the charging status. A full charge typically provides 2-3 hours of continuous use.

4.2 Installing the SD Card

The camera comes with a 32GB SD card for storing color photos and videos. Locate the SD card slot, usually on the side or bottom of the camera. Insert the SD card with the metal contacts facing the correct direction until it clicks into place.

4.3 Installing Print Paper

Follow these steps to install the thermal print paper:

1. Gently push up the part with the lens to open the paper slot.
2. Insert a new roll of thermal printing paper into the slot. Ensure the paper feeds out from the top of the roll, facing towards the printing mechanism.
3. Close the camera body securely until it clicks.

Pay attention to the direction of the paper installation. If put it in wrong direction, it can not print with image.

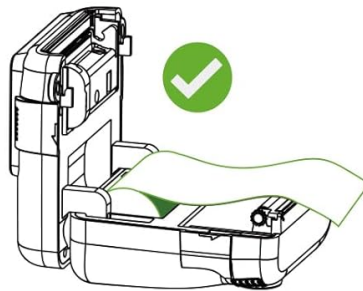


Image 4.1: Correct paper installation. Ensure the paper direction is accurate for proper printing.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Power On/Off

Press and hold the power button (usually marked with a power symbol) to turn the camera on or off.

5.2 Taking Photos

In photo mode, frame your shot using the screen. Press the shutter button (often a large, central button) to capture an image. The camera will instantly print a black and white version, while a color version is saved to the SD card.

5.3 Video Recording

Switch to video mode using the mode button. Press the shutter button to start recording and press it again to stop. Videos are saved to the SD card.

5.4 Digital Zoom

Use the zoom buttons (often marked with '+' and '-') to adjust the 16X digital zoom level before taking a photo or recording a video.

5.5 Applying Filters and Stickers

Navigate through the camera's menu to access the 15 scene filters and 16 sticker frames. Select your desired effect before capturing a photo.

5.6 Time-Lapse Function

Activate the time-lapse feature (e.g., 3-second delay) from the settings menu to allow time to pose before the photo is taken.

5.7 Playing Games

Access the games menu to select and play from the 4 pre-installed puzzle games.

5.8 Printing Options

The camera offers different print density modes (Low, Medium, High) which can be adjusted in the settings for desired print quality.

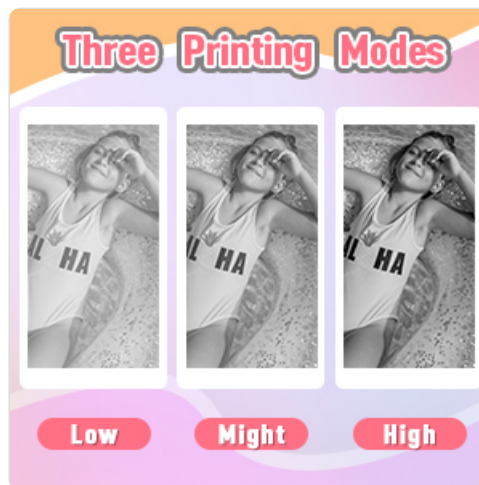


Image 5.5: Adjusting print density for optimal results.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning the Camera

Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the camera body. For the lens, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.

6.2 Storing the Camera

Store the camera in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Remove the SD card if the camera will not be used for an extended period.

6.3 Print Paper Care

Use only thermal print paper compatible with this camera. Store paper rolls in a dry place. The included paper is BPA-free and non-toxic.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your camera, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Camera Not Turning On:** Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the camera to a power source using the Type-C cable.
- **No Image on Print:** Check if the print paper is installed correctly (refer to Section 4.3). Ensure the paper is thermal paper and not inserted backward.
- **Blurry Prints:** Ensure the lens is clean. Check print density settings (Section 5.8) and adjust to 'High' if needed.
- **"Overheat" Error:** If printing many photos consecutively, the camera may temporarily overheat. Allow it to cool down for a few minutes before resuming printing.
- **SD Card Error:** Ensure the SD card is properly inserted. Try reformatting the SD card (this will erase all data, so back up important files first).
- **Camera Freezes:** Press and hold the power button for 10 seconds to force a restart.

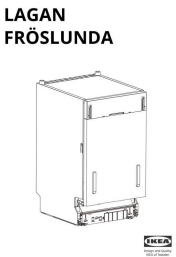
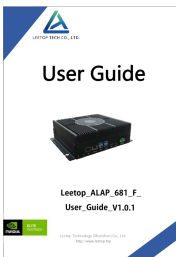

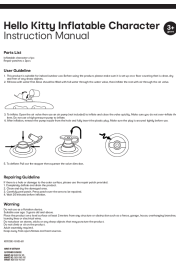

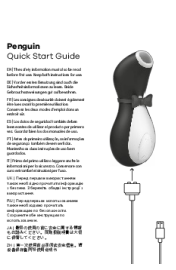
10. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION
