1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your DYNAMIC SAUNAS Golden Designs Monaco 6-Person Near Zero EMF Far Infrared Sauna. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use to ensure proper function and longevity of your product. Retain this manual for future reference.

2. Important Safety Information

Always adhere to the following safety guidelines to prevent injury or damage to the sauna:

- Consult a physician before using the sauna, especially if you have pre-existing medical conditions, are
 pregnant, or are taking medication.
- Do not use the sauna under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Limit sauna sessions to 30-45 minutes to avoid overheating.
- Ensure adequate hydration before, during, and after sauna use.
- Keep children and pets away from the sauna during operation.
- Do not block the air vents or place flammable materials near the heaters.
- Electrical installation must be performed by a certified electrician to meet local codes and the sauna's specific requirements (two separate dedicated 20 amp 120 volt outlets, two separate 20 amp breakers).
- Never attempt to repair or modify the sauna's electrical components yourself. Contact qualified service personnel.

3. Setup and Assembly

The DYNAMIC SAUNAS Monaco sauna requires careful assembly. It is recommended that at least two adults are present for assembly.

3.1 Pre-Installation Checklist

- **Location:** Choose a dry, level indoor surface. Ensure sufficient space around the sauna for assembly and maintenance. Exterior dimensions are 73" W x 61" D x 79" H (add 6" for roof overhang).
- **Electrical Requirements:** Verify that your electrical system can provide two separate dedicated 20 amp 120 volt outlets, each on its own 20 amp breaker. Consult a certified electrician for installation if necessary.
- **Unpacking:** Carefully unpack all components and verify against the packing list. Report any damage immediately.

3.2 Assembly Steps (General)

- 1. Base Placement: Position the sauna base on the chosen level surface.
- 2. **Wall Panel Installation:** Connect the rear wall panel to the base, followed by the side panels. Ensure all locking mechanisms are securely engaged.
- 3. Bench Installation: Install the interior benches and backrests according to the provided diagrams.
- 4. Front Panel & Door: Attach the front panel and carefully install the tempered glass door.
- 5. **Roof Assembly:** Place the roof panel on top, ensuring all electrical connections for lighting and control panels are properly routed and connected.
- 6. External Roof: Install the decorative external roof.
- 7. Heater Connections: Ensure all carbon PureTech Near Zero EMF heat emitters are securely connected.
- 8. **Media System:** Install the FM/CD radio with MP3 auxiliary connection and the 15" LCD Monitor with DVD Player, connecting all necessary cables.

4. Operating Instructions

Familiarize yourself with the control panel for optimal sauna experience.

4.1 Powering On/Off

- Locate the main power switch, typically on the exterior control panel.
- Press the 'Power' button to turn on the sauna. The control panel display will illuminate.
- To power off, press the 'Power' button again or allow the timer to complete its cycle.

4.2 Temperature and Time Settings

- **Temperature:** Use the 'Temp Up' and 'Temp Down' buttons to set your desired temperature. The sauna will automatically heat to this setting.
- **Timer:** Use the 'Time Up' and 'Time Down' buttons to set the duration of your sauna session. The maximum recommended session length is 45 minutes.

4.3 Media System Operation

Your sauna is equipped with an FM/CD radio with MP3 auxiliary connection and a 15" LCD Monitor with DVD Player.

- Radio/CD/MP3: Use the media control panel to select input source (FM, CD, AUX). Adjust volume and tune stations as per standard audio equipment.
- **DVD Player:** Insert a DVD into the player connected to the LCD monitor. Use the monitor's controls or a remote (if provided) to play, pause, and navigate menus.

4.4 Chromotherapy Lighting

The sauna features interior lighting with various color options, often referred to as chromotherapy. Use the dedicated light control button on the panel to cycle through colors or select a specific mode.

5. Maintenance

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your sauna.

- Cleaning the Wood: Wipe down interior and exterior wood surfaces with a clean, damp cloth after each use. Do not use harsh chemical cleaners, as they can damage the wood and release fumes. For deeper cleaning, use a mild soap solution and wipe dry immediately.
- Glass Cleaning: Clean the tempered glass door and windows with a standard glass cleaner and a soft cloth.
- **Heater Care:** The carbon PureTech heaters require minimal maintenance. Ensure they remain free of obstructions. Do not spray water directly onto the heaters.
- Ventilation: Ensure the sauna's ventilation system is clear and unobstructed for proper air circulation.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all electrical connections and components for any signs of wear or damage. If any issues are found, discontinue use and contact customer support.

6. Troubleshooting

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your sauna.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Sauna does not power on.	No power supply; tripped breaker; loose connection.	Check power cord connection. Verify circuit breakers are not tripped. Ensure all internal connections are secure.
Sauna not heating.	Temperature setting too low; timer not set; heater malfunction.	Increase temperature setting. Set the timer for a session. If problem persists, contact support.
Media system not working.	Loose connections; incorrect input selected; media error.	Check all audio/video cable connections. Select the correct input source (FM, CD, AUX, DVD). Ensure media (CD/DVD) is clean and inserted correctly.
Unusual odors.	New wood smell; dust on heaters.	New wood smell will dissipate over time. Ensure heaters are clean. Ventilate the room.
