INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your YOTUO IDD029-2 External CD/DVD Drive. Please read these instructions carefully before using the device to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Plug and Play:** Simple connection via USB or Type-C port, with automatic driver installation.
- **Portable Design:** Slim, sleek, and minimalist with a recessed cable design for easy organization and transport. Weighs approximately 0.4 kg and is 1.8 cm thick.
- **High-Speed Performance:** Features dual USB 3.0 and Type-C ports. Offers a maximum DVD reading speed of 8x and a maximum CD reading speed of 24x, supporting data transfer speeds up to 5Gbps.
- **Wide Compatibility:** Supports Windows XP/2003/Vista/7/8/10/11, Linux, and all versions of Mac OS systems.
- **Durable Construction:** Made from high-quality flame-retardant PC material, providing shock resistance and durability. Incorporates a high-performance original magnetic core for stable, high-speed reading with anti-interference and low impedance.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Connect the Drive:** Plug the integrated USB 3.0 or USB-C cable into an available port on your computer (laptop or desktop). For desktop computers, connect to a USB port on the back of the tower to ensure sufficient power.
2. **Automatic Driver Installation:** Wait for your operating system to automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. This process usually takes a few moments.
3. **Insert a Disc:** Press the eject button on the front of the drive to open the disc tray. Place your CD or DVD onto the spindle, ensuring it is seated correctly. Gently push the tray back into the drive until it clicks into place.
4. **Access the Drive:** Once the disc is inserted, your computer should recognize the drive and its contents. You can typically access it through 'This PC' or 'Finder' (on Mac).

PLUG AND PLAY

No need to install software or plug-ins, and no need for an power supply unit, connect to your computer. Enjoy your time instantly!

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Reading Discs

After inserting a disc and your computer recognizing it, you can open the disc's contents through your operating system's file explorer. For playing media (music, movies), you may need compatible software (e.g., VLC Media Player) installed on your computer.

Writing/Burning Discs

To burn data to a blank CD-R/RW or DVD-R/RW, ensure you have appropriate burning software installed on your computer. Follow the software's instructions to select files and initiate the burning process. The drive supports CD writing at up to 24x and DVD writing at up to 8x.

Compatibility Notes

The drive is compatible with a wide range of operating systems including Windows (XP/2003/Vista/7/8/10/11),

Linux, and all versions of Mac OS. However, it is **not supported** by TVs, car players, Chromebooks, Surface Pro, Ubuntu, tablets, or mobile phones.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the drive. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Disc Care:** Always handle discs by their edges to avoid fingerprints and scratches. Store discs in their cases when not in use.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the drive in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. The recessed cable design helps keep the cable organized and protected.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Drive Not Recognized:** Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the drive and your

computer. Try a different USB port or a different computer to rule out port or computer issues. For desktops, use a rear USB port.

- **Disc Not Reading/Writing:** Check if the disc is clean and free from scratches or damage. Ensure the disc is correctly placed in the tray. Verify that you have the necessary software installed for playing or burning discs.
- **Power Issues:** If the drive is not receiving enough power (especially with older USB 2.0 ports or some front USB ports on desktops), try connecting it to a different USB 3.0 or USB-C port, or a powered USB hub if available.
- **Slow Performance:** Ensure you are using a USB 3.0 or USB-C port for optimal data transfer speeds. Close any unnecessary applications running in the background.
