INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Honeywell Keyless Entry Door Lock, Model 8635000. Please read these instructions carefully before installation and use to ensure proper function and security.

INSTALLATION AND SETUP

The Honeywell Keyless Entry Door Lock is designed for easy installation. A Phillips screwdriver is typically the only tool required. Ensure your door is prepared according to standard deadbolt installation requirements.

1. **Prepare the Door:** Ensure the door bore hole and backset are compatible with the lock.
2. **Install the Latch:** Insert the latch into the door edge and secure it with screws.
3. **Install Exterior Assembly:** Place the exterior keypad assembly onto the door, ensuring the spindle passes through the latch.
4. **Install Interior Mounting Plate:** Secure the interior mounting plate to the exterior assembly using the provided screws.
5. **Connect Cables and Install Interior Assembly:** Connect the cable from the exterior assembly to the interior assembly. Mount the interior assembly onto the mounting plate and secure it.
6. **Insert Batteries:** Open the battery cover on the interior assembly and insert 4 AA batteries (not included).
7. **Perform Door Handing Process:** The lock features an auto-handing sensor. Follow the instructions in the full manual to ensure the lock correctly identifies if your door is right or left-handed.

2. Enter your personalized 4-8 digit user code.
3. The deadbolt will retract, allowing you to open the door.

Vacation Mode

Activate Vacation Mode to disable all lock functions, conserving battery life and enhancing security when you are away. Refer to the full manual for specific steps to enable and disable this mode.

PROGRAMMING USER CODES

The lock supports up to 50 unique user codes, allowing multiple individuals to access your property. Each code can be 4 to 8 digits long.

Adding a User Code

1. Enter the Master Programming Code (default is usually 12345678, but verify in the full manual).
2. Press the 'Program' button (often indicated by a gear icon or similar).
3. Enter the new 4-8 digit user code you wish to add.
4. Press the 'Lock' button to confirm.

Deleting a User Code

To delete a specific user code, you will typically need to enter the Master Programming Code, followed by a sequence to delete a user code, and then the specific user code to be removed. Consult the full manual for the exact sequence.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your lock.

Battery Replacement

The lock features a low battery indicator. When the batteries are low, the indicator light will flash, or the lock may emit an audible alert. Replace all four AA batteries promptly to avoid loss of function. Use only new, high-quality alkaline batteries.

Cleaning

Clean the lock's exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or chemical sprays, as these can damage the finish and electronic components.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your lock, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Keypad Not Responding:** Check the batteries. If the batteries are dead, the keypad will not illuminate or respond. Replace them.
- **Lockout Protection:** After multiple incorrect code entries, the lock will enter a lockout mode for a short period to prevent unauthorized access. Wait for the lockout period to expire before trying again.
- **Deadbolt Not Extending/Retracting:** Ensure the door is properly aligned and not binding. Check for any obstructions in the door frame or strike plate.
- **Physical Key Not Working:** Ensure you are using the correct backup entry key. If the key still does not work, the cylinder may need inspection by a qualified locksmith.
