## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Brook Wingman XE 2 Converter is a versatile wireless controller adapter designed to bridge compatibility between various gaming controllers and consoles. It allows users to utilize their preferred controllers, including PS5, PS4, PS3, Switch Pro, Xbox Series X/S/One/Elite 2, and USB wired Xbox controllers, across PlayStation (PS4, PS3), Nintendo Switch, and PC (Direct-Input) platforms. This converter enhances the gaming experience by offering features such as adjustable turbo levels and button remapping, ensuring a lag-free connection.

## 4. SETUP GUIDE

---

### 4.1 First-Time Setup and Firmware Update

Before initial use, it is crucial to ensure your Wingman XE 2 firmware is updated to the latest version. Visit the official Brook website for the most current firmware and update instructions. After updating, connect the converter to your gaming console via its USB port. The device will then be registered and ready for use.

### 4.2 Connecting to Consoles

The Wingman XE 2 supports connection to PlayStation 4, PlayStation 3, Nintendo Switch, and PC. Simply plug the converter into an available USB port on your desired console.

### 4.3 Connecting Controllers

The Wingman XE 2 supports a wide range of controllers, both wired and wireless. Each converter can pair with one device at a time.

#### Wired Connection:

For wired controllers (e.g., Xbox Series X/S/One/Elite1&2 on PS4, PS3, Switch, PC), simply connect the controller's USB cable to the female USB port on the Wingman XE 2 converter. The constant blue indicator on the converter signifies a successful connection.

#### Wireless Connection:

For wireless controllers (e.g., PS5/PS4/PS3, Switch Pro, XB Series X/S/One/Elite 2), connect the controller to the Wingman XE 2 via its USB cable initially. Once the blue indicator on the converter is constantly on, you can remove the USB cable from the controller. The controller is now wirelessly connected.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 5.1 Adjustable Turbo Levels

The Wingman XE 2 allows you to set adjustable turbo levels for rapid button presses. There are 5 available turbo frequencies: 5, 10, 15, 20, and 25 clicks per second. This feature is useful for games requiring quick, repetitive inputs.

## 5.2 Remap Function

The remap function allows you to customize button assignments on your controller. This enables you to configure the buttons in a way that suits your personal gaming style, potentially simplifying complex maneuvers into single button presses.

The Wingman XE 2 boasts extensive controller compatibility, supporting over 125 different wireless and wired controllers. This includes, but is not limited to, PS5, PS4, PS3, Switch Pro, Xbox Series X/S/One, and Xbox Elite 1 & 2 controllers.

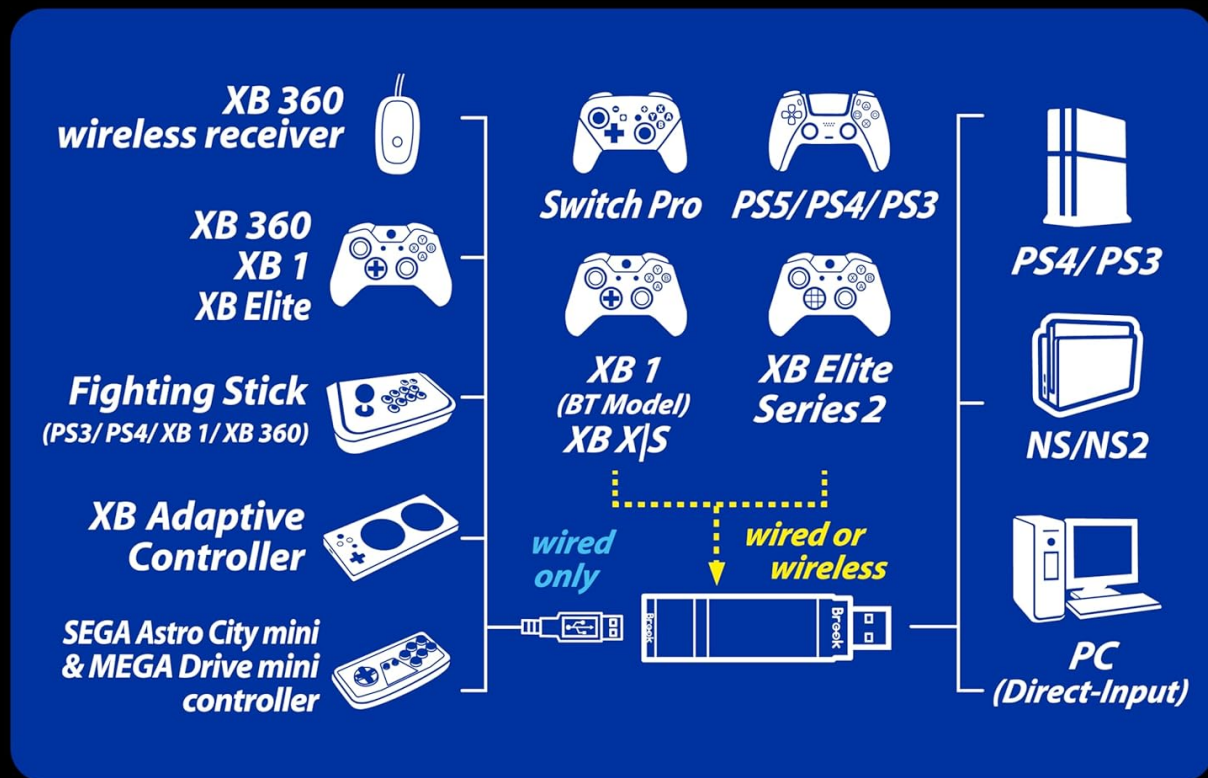


Image: Detailed diagram illustrating various supported controllers and their connection types.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Connection Issues:** If the converter is not recognized or a controller frequently disconnects, ensure the Wingman XE 2 is securely plugged into the console's USB port. Try a different USB port if available.
- **Controller Not Responding:** Verify that the controller is fully charged (if wireless) and properly paired with the converter. Re-pair the controller if necessary.
- **Feature Malfunction (Turbo/Remap):** Ensure you are following the correct button combinations for setting up or canceling these features as outlined in the operating instructions.
- **Performance Issues:** Ensure your Wingman XE 2 has the latest firmware installed. Firmware updates often include performance improvements and bug fixes.



## 8. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the converter. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the converter in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use.
- **Handling:** Handle the converter with care to prevent physical damage to the USB connector or the device itself.


