PLAYBACK INSTRUCTIONS

Setup

- 1. Turntable Preparation:** Ensure your turntable is clean and level. Check that the stylus (needle) is free of dust and debris.
- 2. Receiver/Amplifier Connection:** Connect your turntable to a suitable phono input on your receiver or amplifier. If your turntable does not have a built-in pre-amplifier, you will need an external phono pre-amplifier.
- 3. Speaker Setup:** Position your speakers for optimal sound dispersion in your listening area.

Operating

- 1. Remove from Sleeve:** Carefully remove the vinyl record from its inner sleeve by holding it by the edges or the label to avoid touching the grooves.
- 2. Place on Platter:** Gently place the record onto the turntable platter, aligning the center hole with the spindle.
- 3. Select Speed:** Ensure your turntable is set to the correct speed (typically 33 1/3 RPM for LPs).
- 4. Lower Tonearm:** Carefully lower the tonearm, placing the stylus into the lead-in groove of the record. Avoid dropping the tonearm, as this can damage the record or stylus.
- 5. Adjust Volume:** Once playback begins, adjust the volume on your amplifier to your desired listening level.
- 6. End of Playback:** At the end of the side, gently lift the tonearm and return it to its rest. Do not let the stylus drag across the record.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Handling:** Always handle the vinyl record by its edges or the center label. Avoid touching the playing surface (grooves) as oils from your skin can attract dust and degrade sound quality.
- Cleaning:**
 - For light dust, use a dedicated carbon fiber record brush before each play. Brush gently along the grooves, not across them.
 - For deeper cleaning, use a record cleaning solution and a microfiber cloth, following the product's instructions. Ensure the record is completely dry before playing or storing.
- Storage:** Store records vertically in their inner and outer sleeves to prevent warping. Keep them away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and extreme temperature fluctuations. A cool, dry environment is ideal.
- Stylus Care:** Regularly inspect and clean your turntable's stylus. A dirty or worn stylus can damage your records and degrade sound quality.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Skipping or Jumping	Dust/debris on record or stylus, scratched record, uneven turntable, incorrect tracking force.	Clean record and stylus. Inspect record for damage. Ensure turntable is level. Adjust tonearm tracking force according to turntable manufacturer's specifications.
Distorted Sound / Poor Audio Quality	Dirty stylus, worn stylus, incorrect tracking force, improper amplifier connection, dirty record.	Clean or replace stylus. Adjust tracking force. Verify all audio connections are secure. Clean record thoroughly.
Excessive Static	Dry environment, friction from inner sleeve.	Use an anti-static record brush. Consider anti-static inner sleeves. A humidifier can help in very dry climates.
Warped Record	Improper storage, exposure to heat.	Store records vertically in a cool, dry place. Minor warps may sometimes be mitigated with specialized flattening devices, but severe warps are often irreversible.



