## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure adequate ventilation.
- Keep a fire extinguisher or water source nearby.
- Allow the fire pit to cool completely before moving or storing.
- Only use recommended fuels (wood or pellets).
- Do not use gasoline, kerosene, or other flammable liquids to start or rekindle a fire.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Solo Stove Mesa XL is a compact, portable tabletop fire pit designed for outdoor use. It features a smokeless design and can be fueled by either wood or pellets. Constructed from durable 304 stainless steel, it includes a stand for stability and a nylon carry bag for portability.

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

---

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all items from the packaging.
2. **Assemble Stand:** The Mesa Stand is designed for easy assembly. Ensure it is securely locked into place to provide a stable base for the fire pit.
3. **Position Fire Pit:** Place the Mesa XL fire pit onto the assembled stand. Ensure the fire pit is centered and stable.
4. **Select Location:** Choose a flat, level, non-combustible outdoor surface away from any overhead obstructions, buildings, or flammable materials.

### Fueling Options: Wood or Pellets

# Easily Burn Pellets or Wood

## 1. Add Fuel:

- **For Wood:** Place small, dry pieces of wood into the fire pit. Ensure wood pieces are small enough to fit entirely within the fire pit to promote efficient burning and minimize sparks.
- **For Pellets:** Fill the fire pit with wood pellets up to the internal vent holes. The Mesa XL includes a built-in pellet adapter for this purpose.

2. **Ignite Fire:** Use a fire starter (e.g., a fire starter briquette or natural kindling) to ignite the fuel. Place the fire starter on top of the fuel and light it carefully.

3. **Enjoy the Fire:** The Mesa XL's signature 360° airflow design promotes a smokeless burn once the fire is established and the unit heats up.

4. **Adding More Fuel:** As the fire burns down, carefully add more small pieces of wood or pellets as needed to maintain the flame.
5. **Heat Radius:** The Mesa XL provides a localized heat radius of approximately 2-3 feet, ideal for tabletop ambiance and warmth.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cool Down:** Always allow the fire pit to cool completely before attempting any cleaning or maintenance.
- **Ash Removal:** Once cool, carefully empty any ash and unburnt fuel. Dispose of ash responsibly.
- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the exterior with a damp cloth. For stubborn stains, a mild stainless steel cleaner can be used. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads that could scratch the surface.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the Mesa XL in its nylon carry bag in a dry, protected area to prevent weather damage and prolong its lifespan.
- **Material:** The fire pit is constructed from durable 304 stainless steel, designed for longevity.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Excessive Smoke	Wet or unseasoned wood; too much fuel; insufficient airflow.	Use only dry, seasoned wood or quality pellets. Do not overfill. Ensure air intake holes are clear. Allow the fire pit to heat up for the secondary burn to engage.
Difficulty Starting Fire	Insufficient kindling; wet fuel; poor fire starter.	Use ample dry kindling and a reliable fire starter. Ensure fuel is dry.
Fire Goes Out Quickly	Lack of fuel; small fuel pieces burning too fast.	Add more fuel as needed. For wood, ensure pieces are appropriately sized for a longer burn.
