INTRODUCTION

The BuzzTV IR-200 is a factory replacement remote control designed for seamless compatibility with all BuzzTV devices. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your remote control to ensure a smooth and hassle-free user experience.

SETUP

1. Battery Installation

The BuzzTV IR-200 remote requires two AAA batteries (not included). Follow these steps to install them:

1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control.
2. Press down on the tab and slide the cover downwards to open the compartment.
3. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment.
4. Slide the battery compartment cover back into place until it clicks securely.

2. Initial Use and Compatibility

The BuzzTV IR-200 remote is designed for universal compatibility with all BuzzTV devices. Once batteries are installed, the remote should function immediately with your BuzzTV device without additional pairing steps. Point the remote directly at your BuzzTV device and begin operation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The IR-200 remote features an ergonomic design with clearly labeled buttons for intuitive control of your BuzzTV device. Refer to the diagram below for a visual guide to the remote's layout and button functions.

Button Functions:

- **Power Button (/)**: Turns the BuzzTV device on or off.
- **Volume Up/Down (VOL+ / VOL-)**: Adjusts the audio volume.
- **Channel Up/Down (CH+ / CH-)**: Changes the channel.
- **Navigation Pad (Up, Down, Left, Right, OK)**: Navigates menus and confirms selections.
- **Back (↶)**: Returns to the previous screen or menu.
- **Home (△)**: Returns to the main home screen.

- **Numeric Keypad (0-9)**: For direct channel entry or other numerical inputs.
- **Page Up/Down (PG↓ / PG↑)**: Navigates through pages in lists or guides.
- **Dedicated App Buttons (e.g., LIVE TV, VOD, TV SERIES, PVR, GUIDE, FAVS, SEARCH, SERVER, CATEGORY)**: Provides quick access to specific functions or applications within the BuzzTV interface.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Remote

To maintain the remote's appearance and functionality:

- Wipe the remote with a soft, dry cloth.
- For stubborn dirt, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive materials, as these can damage the remote's surface or internal components.

Battery Replacement

Replace batteries when the remote's responsiveness decreases or it stops functioning. Always replace both batteries at the same time with new AAA batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries or different types of batteries.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Remote not responding:**
 - Check if the batteries are inserted correctly with the correct polarity.
 - Replace the batteries with new ones.
 - Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and your BuzzTV device.
 - Make sure you are within the effective range of the remote control.
- **Buttons are sticky or unresponsive:**
 - Clean the remote control as described in the Maintenance section.
 - Ensure no liquids have spilled onto the remote.
- **Remote controls other devices:**
 - The IR-200 is an infrared remote. Ensure it is pointed directly at your BuzzTV device to avoid interfering with other IR-controlled electronics.

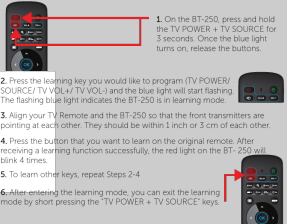

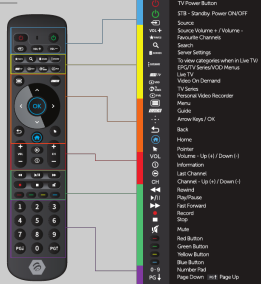
1. Connect E5 Set-top box TV Box to the power supply.
2. Connect E5 to your TV with an HDMI Cable or AV Cable.
3. For a wired connection, plug in an Ethernet cable from the TV box to your modem or router. For wireless, choose your Wi-Fi network and enter your Wi-Fi password.
4. LED Light: Blue ON - Red OFF - Green INTERNET CONNECTION

4 Troubleshooting

Warning: Under no circumstances should you try to repair the E5 unit by yourself, as this will invalidate the warranty. Do not attempt to repair a defective product. Have had success, please first check with the troubleshooting checklist. If you are unable to remedy a problem by following this guide, contact your dealer for help.

Problem	Solution
No sound	• Check the audio output interface is connected to the power and the TV box. • Check the volume of the external connection is set on the power.
No Picture	• Check the HDMI cable or AV cable. • Check the TV is powered on.
No sound or distorted sound	• Adjust the volume. • Check that the speakers are connected correctly.
The TV box does not respond to the remote control	• Verify the power connection to the power line of the TV box. • Check the battery of the TV box. • Reset the battery of the TV box. • Check the power line. • Check the power line.
No sound (distorted)	• The audio output may not be supported by the TV box. • Check the volume.
The contents of the TV box are not correct	• The USB or Flash drive format is not compatible with the box. • Turn off the TV box, wait 30 seconds and turn on again.
