1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Logitech M220 Silent Wireless Mouse offers a compact, ambidextrous design with advanced optical tracking for precise navigation. It features an 18-month battery life and plug-and-play connectivity, making it compatible with various operating systems including PC, Mac, and Linux laptops.

2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Install the Battery:**

Open the battery compartment cover on the underside of the mouse. Insert one AA battery, ensuring correct polarity (+/-). Close the cover securely.

2. Connect the USB Receiver:

Locate the USB nano receiver, usually stored inside the battery compartment. Plug the receiver into an available USB port on your computer. The mouse should connect automatically.

3. Power On the Mouse:

Slide the On/Off switch on the bottom of the mouse to the 'On' position. The mouse is now ready for use.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Logitech M220 mouse is designed for intuitive and comfortable use. Its ambidextrous shape ensures a natural fit for both left and right hands.

- **Left-Click Button:** Use for selecting items, opening files, or activating functions.
- **Right-Click Button:** Use for accessing context menus or secondary functions.
- **Scroll Wheel:** Roll up or down to navigate through documents and web pages. The scroll wheel also functions as a middle-click button for additional actions in some applications.

4. MAINTENANCE

- **Battery Replacement:** When the mouse becomes unresponsive or the cursor movement is erratic, it may be time to replace the AA battery. Follow the battery installation steps in Section 2.
- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the surface of the mouse. For the optical sensor, use a dry cotton swab to remove any dust or debris. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, turn off the mouse using the On/Off switch to conserve battery life. The USB receiver can be stored inside the battery compartment for safekeeping.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Mouse Not Responding:**
 - Ensure the mouse is turned on.
 - Check if the battery is correctly installed and has sufficient charge. Replace if necessary.
 - Verify the USB receiver is securely plugged into a working USB port on your computer.
 - Try plugging the USB receiver into a different USB port.
 - Restart your computer.
- **Erratic Cursor Movement:**
 - Clean the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse.
 - Ensure you are using the mouse on a suitable surface. Highly reflective or transparent surfaces may affect tracking.
- **Connectivity Issues:**

- Ensure the mouse is within the 33-foot (10-meter) operating range of the USB receiver.
- Avoid placing the receiver near other wireless devices or large metal objects that could cause interference.
