INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Gabba Goods Metallix Lyrix Wireless Bluetooth Over-Ear Headphones. Please read this manual thoroughly before using your headphones to ensure proper functionality and to maximize your listening experience.

1. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Gabba Goods Metallix Lyrix Wireless Bluetooth Over-Ear Headphones
- Charging Cable
- 3.5mm Audio Cable (for wired connection)

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the controls and ports on your headphones.

Control Buttons:

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to power on/off. Short press to play/pause music or answer/end calls.
- **Volume Up / Next Track Button:** Short press to increase volume. Long press to skip to the next track.
- **Volume Down / Previous Track Button:** Short press to decrease volume. Long press to go to the previous track.

Ports:

- **Microphone:** Integrated for hands-free calling.

- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** For wired connection using the included audio cable.
- **Charging Port:** For connecting the charging cable.

3. SETUP

3.1. Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge your headphones. Connect the provided charging cable to the charging port on the headphones and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter). The LED indicator will show charging status and turn off or change color when fully charged.

A full charge provides approximately 4 hours of continuous music playback.

3.2. Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button until the LED indicator lights up and you hear an audible prompt.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until the LED indicator turns off and you hear an audible prompt.

3.3. Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headphones are powered off.
2. Press and hold the Power button for approximately 5-7 seconds until the LED indicator flashes red and blue alternately, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, PC), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "Gabba Goods Metallix Lyrix" from the list of found devices.
5. Once paired, the LED indicator will flash blue slowly, and you will hear a confirmation tone.
6. If prompted for a password, enter "0000".

The headphones will automatically attempt to reconnect to the last paired device when powered on.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Short press the Power button.
- **Next Track:** Long press the Volume Up / Next Track button.
- **Previous Track:** Long press the Volume Down / Previous Track button.
- **Volume Up:** Short press the Volume Up / Next Track button.
- **Volume Down:** Short press the Volume Down / Previous Track button.

4.2. Call Management

- **Answer/End Call:** Short press the Power button.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Power button for 2 seconds.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-press the Power button.

4.3. Wired Mode (3.5mm Audio Cable)

To use the headphones in wired mode, connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the headphone's audio jack and the other end to your audio source. The Bluetooth function will automatically disable when the audio cable is connected. This mode does not require battery power.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the headphones. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the headphones in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. The foldable design allows for compact storage.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the headphones frequently. Charge them regularly, even if not used for extended periods.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headphones fully.
Cannot pair with device.	Headphones not in pairing mode; Bluetooth off on device; device too far.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing red/blue). Turn on Bluetooth on your device. Move device closer to headphones.
No sound in Bluetooth mode.	Volume too low; device not connected; incorrect audio output selected.	Increase headphone and device volume. Ensure headphones are successfully paired and connected. Check device's audio output settings.
No sound in wired mode.	Cable not fully inserted; cable faulty; device volume low.	Ensure 3.5mm cable is fully inserted into both headphone and device. Try a different 3.5mm cable. Increase device volume.
Poor sound quality.	Low battery; interference; source audio quality.	Charge headphones. Move away from other wireless devices. Use high-quality audio files.
