INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the WiiM Voice Remote, designed to enhance your control over WiiM Mini and Pro Audio Streamers. It features push-to-talk voice commands and four customizable music preset buttons for convenient access to your favorite audio content.

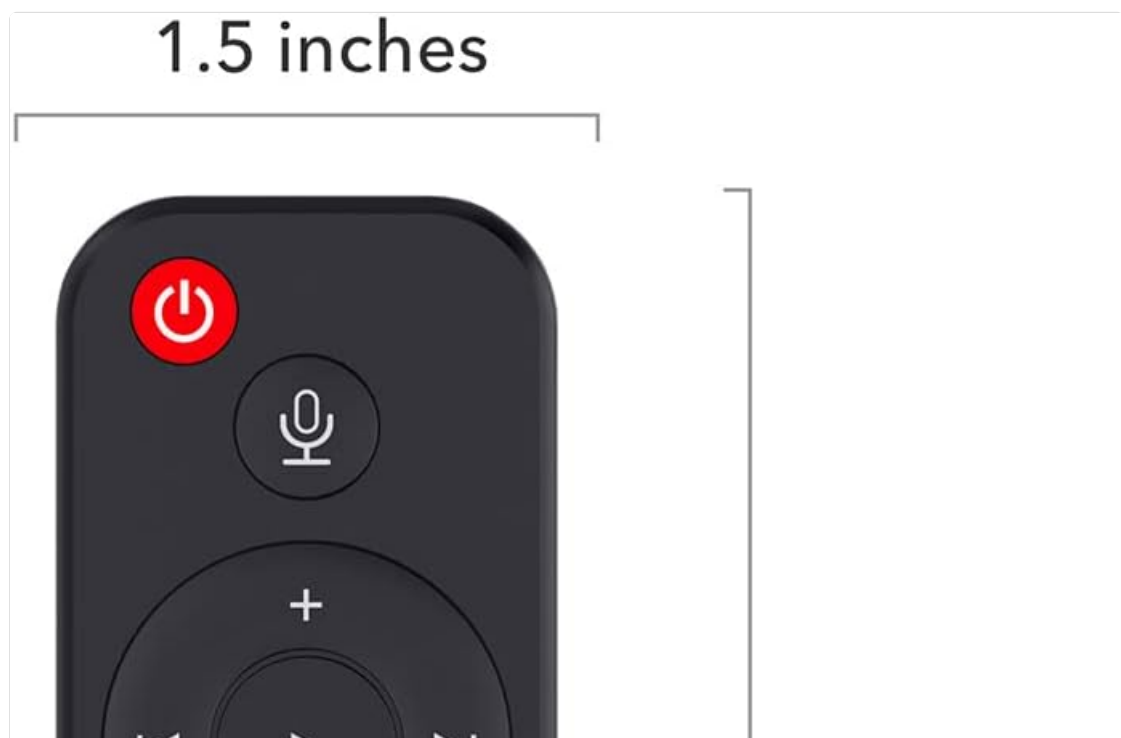




Figure 2: The WiiM Voice Remote with approximate dimensions of 1.5 inches width and 6.2 inches length, illustrating its compact size.

Button Functions

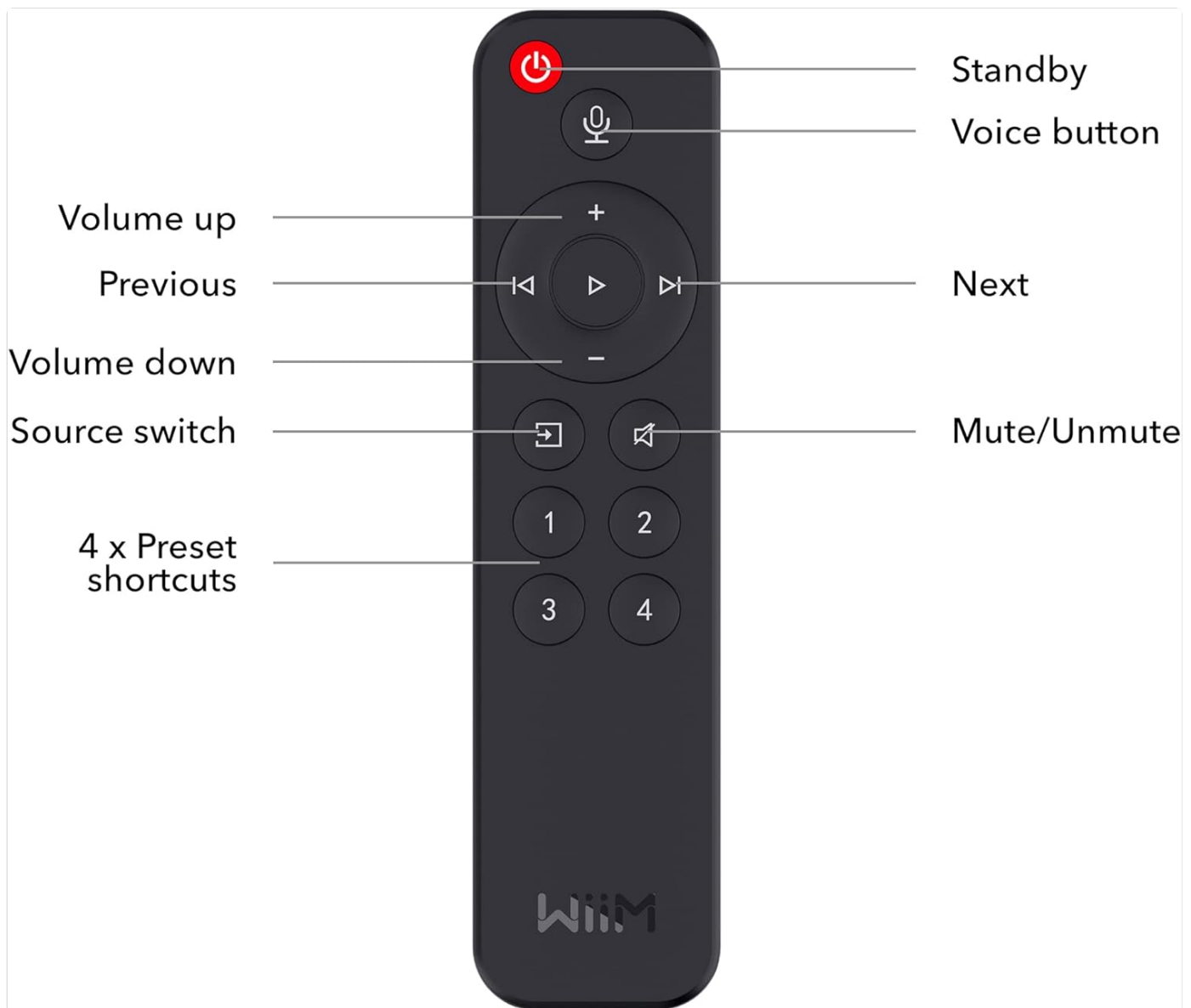


Figure 4: A detailed diagram labeling each button on the WiiM Voice Remote and its corresponding function.

- **Power Button:** Controls standby mode for your connected WiiM device.
- **Voice Button (Microphone Icon):** Activates push-to-talk voice commands for searching and controlling via Alexa.
- **Volume Up (+):** Increases the audio volume.
- **Volume Down (-):** Decreases the audio volume.
- **Previous Track (◀◀):** Skips to the previous song or content.
- **Play/Pause (▶):** Toggles playback (play/pause).
- **Next Track (▶▶):** Skips to the next song or content.
- **Source Switch (Arrow Icon):** Changes the audio input source.
- **Mute/Unmute (Speaker Icon):** Toggles audio mute.
- **Preset Buttons (1, 2, 3, 4):** Customizable buttons for one-tap access to favorite music, playlists, or radio stations.

SETUP

Setting up your WiiM Voice Remote is a straightforward process through the WiiM Home app.

1. **Insert Batteries:** Ensure 2 AAA batteries (not included) are inserted into the remote.
2. **Open WiiM Home App:** Launch the WiiM Home application on your smartphone or tablet.
3. **Pairing:** Within the app, follow the on-screen instructions to easily pair the remote with your WiiM Mini or Pro

device. The app will guide you through the connection process.

4. **Voice Control Setup:** To use voice control with Alexa, ensure your WiiM device is connected to Alexa via the WiiM Home app. No additional built-in Alexa device is required for the remote's voice functionality.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once paired, the WiiM Voice Remote provides convenient control over your audio experience.

- **Playback Control:** Use the central navigation buttons to play, pause, skip to the previous track, or skip to the next track.
- **Volume Control:** Adjust the volume using the '+' and '-' buttons. The mute button allows for instant audio silencing.
- **Voice Commands:** Press and hold the Voice button (microphone icon) to activate Alexa and issue voice commands for searching music, controlling playback, or other smart home functions. Release the button when finished speaking.
- **Customizable Presets:** The four numbered preset buttons (1, 2, 3, 4) can be customized via the WiiM Home app to instantly launch your favorite songs, playlists, radio stations, podcasts, or even control other devices.
- **Source Switching:** Use the Source Switch button to cycle through available audio input sources on your WiiM device.

MAINTENANCE

Battery Replacement

The WiiM Voice Remote requires 2 AAA batteries. When the remote's performance degrades or it stops responding, it's time to replace the batteries.

1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote.
2. Slide the cover open.
3. Remove the old batteries and insert two new AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

Dispose of used batteries responsibly according to local regulations.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your WiiM Voice Remote, try the following steps:

- **Remote Not Responding:**
 - Check if the batteries are correctly inserted and have sufficient charge. Replace if necessary.
 - Ensure the remote is within range of your WiiM Mini or Pro device.
 - Re-pair the remote with your WiiM device via the WiiM Home app.

- **Voice Commands Not Working:**

- Verify that your WiiM device is properly connected to Alexa through the WiiM Home app.
- Ensure you are pressing and holding the Voice button while speaking.
- Check your internet connection for the WiiM device, as Alexa requires online access.

- **Preset Buttons Not Functioning:**

- Confirm that the preset buttons have been configured in the WiiM Home app.
- Check the availability of the content linked to the preset (e.g., if a streaming service is active).
