INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides comprehensive instructions for the operation and maintenance of your Silvercrest DAB+ Radio. Please read this manual carefully before using the device to ensure proper functionality and to prevent damage. Keep this manual for future reference.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not expose the device to rain, moisture, or extreme temperatures.
- Avoid placing the device near heat sources such as radiators or stoves.
- Do not open the device casing. Repairs should only be performed by qualified personnel.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the device.
- Disconnect the power plug during thunderstorms or when not in use for extended periods.
- Clean the device only with a dry, soft cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Controls and Connections:

- **Display:** Shows time, date, radio station information, and menu options.
- **Control Buttons (Top Panel):** For navigation, mode selection, volume, alarm settings, and snooze.
- **USB OUT (5V/1A):** USB port for charging compatible external devices.
- **DC IN (5.3V/2A):** Power input port for connecting the power adapter.
- **ANT:** Connection point for the external antenna.

SETUP

1. **Connect Antenna:** Connect the provided antenna cable to the ANT port on the rear of the radio. Extend the antenna fully for optimal reception.

2. **Connect Power:** Insert the power adapter cable into the DC IN (5.3V/2A) port on the rear of the radio. Plug the power adapter into a standard wall outlet.
3. **Initial Power On:** The radio will power on automatically or require a press of the power button. The display will light up.
4. **Automatic Time/Date Sync:** Upon first power-on, the radio will attempt to synchronize the time and date automatically via DAB+ signal. Ensure good reception for this feature.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off

- Press the **Power** button to turn the radio on or off.

Mode Selection (DAB+/FM)

- Press the **Mode** button to switch between DAB+ and FM radio modes.

DAB+ Radio Operation

1. **First Time Scan:** When in DAB+ mode for the first time, the radio will automatically perform a full scan for available stations. This may take a few minutes.
2. **Manual Scan:** To perform a manual scan, navigate to the DAB+ menu and select "Full Scan" or "Auto Scan".
3. **Selecting Stations:** Use the **Tune/Select** knob or **Up/Down** buttons to browse through the list of available DAB+ stations. Press **Select** to confirm your choice.
4. **Saving Presets:** To save a station as a preset, tune to the desired station, then press and hold the **Preset** button. Use the **Tune/Select** knob or **Up/Down** buttons to choose a preset number (e.g., P1-P10), then press **Select** to confirm.
5. **Recalling Presets:** Briefly press the **Preset** button, then use the **Tune/Select** knob or **Up/Down** buttons to select the desired preset number, and press **Select**.

FM Radio Operation

1. **Auto Scan:** In FM mode, press and hold the **Scan** button to automatically scan and save strong FM stations.
2. **Manual Tuning:** Briefly press the **Tune/Select** knob or **Up/Down** buttons to fine-tune the frequency step by step. Press and hold to quickly scan for the next available station.
3. **Saving Presets:** Similar to DAB+, tune to the desired FM station, then press and hold the **Preset** button. Choose a preset number and press **Select**.
4. **Recalling Presets:** Briefly press the **Preset** button, then select the desired preset number and press **Select**.

Alarm Function

1. **Setting Alarm:** Press the **Alarm** button. Use the **Up/Down** buttons or **Tune/Select** knob to set the alarm time (hour and minute). Press **Select** to confirm each setting.
2. **Alarm Source:** Choose between Buzzer, DAB+, or FM as the alarm sound source.
3. **Alarm Volume:** Adjust the desired alarm volume.
4. **Activating/Deactivating Alarm:** After setting, ensure the alarm is activated (indicated by an alarm

icon on the display). Press the **Alarm** button repeatedly to toggle between Alarm 1, Alarm 2, or Off.

- 5. **Snooze:** When the alarm sounds, press the large **Snooze** button to temporarily silence it for a set period (e.g., 9 minutes).
- 6. **Stop Alarm:** To stop the alarm completely, press the **Power** button or the **Alarm** button.

Sleep Timer Function

- Press the **Sleep** button repeatedly to cycle through available sleep timer durations (e.g., 15, 30, 45, 60, 90 minutes, or Off). The radio will automatically turn off after the selected duration.

USB Charging Port

- The USB OUT (5V/1A) port on the rear of the radio can be used to charge small electronic devices such as smartphones or MP3 players. Connect your device's USB charging cable to this port.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the exterior of the radio. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents.
- **Storage:** If storing the radio for an extended period, disconnect it from the power outlet and store it in a cool, dry place.
- **Antenna Care:** Handle the antenna gently to avoid bending or breaking it.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power adapter not connected or faulty outlet.	Check power adapter connection. Try a different power outlet.
Poor radio reception (DAB+/FM)	Antenna not extended or poor signal area.	Fully extend the antenna. Reposition the radio for better signal. Perform a new scan.
No sound	Volume too low or muted.	Increase volume. Check if the radio is muted.
Alarm does not sound	Alarm not activated or set incorrectly.	Verify alarm time and activation status. Ensure alarm volume is audible.
Display is blank or frozen	Temporary software glitch.	Disconnect power for a few seconds, then reconnect to reset the device.
