

4. SETUP GUIDE

4.1 Physical Setup

Follow these steps to set up your projector:

1. **Placement:** Place the projector on a stable, flat surface or mount it on a ceiling/tripod. Ensure it is positioned

directly in front of your projection screen or wall for the best image quality.

2. **Power Connection:** Connect the power cable to the projector's power input and then to a power outlet.
3. **Power On:** Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn on the device.

4.2 Connecting Devices

- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** Connect external speakers or headphones for enhanced audio.
- **AV Port:** Connect older devices like DVD players or set-top boxes using an AV cable.
- **VGA Port:** Connect computers or laptops with a VGA output.



Image: The projector in use for efficient meetings and teaching, highlighting HDMI/TF/USB connectivity.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Android 9.0 Operating System

Your Livato Spark Projector runs on Android 9.0, providing a smart and intuitive interface:

- Navigate the home screen using the remote control.
- Access pre-installed apps like YouTube, Netflix, and Prime Video.
- Download additional applications from the Google Play Store.

5.2 Wireless Connectivity (WiFi & Bluetooth)

Connect wirelessly for seamless content sharing:

- **WiFi:** Go to Settings > Network > Wi-Fi to connect to your 2.4G or 5G wireless network.
- **Bluetooth:** Enable Bluetooth in Settings to pair with Bluetooth-enabled devices like speakers or headphones.
- **Miracast:** Use the Miracast feature to wirelessly mirror the screen of your smartphone, tablet, or laptop.

5.3 Image Adjustment (Keystone & Focus)


Achieve a clear and perfectly shaped image:

- **Focus Adjustment:** Use the focus ring near the lens to sharpen the image until it is clear.
- **Keystone Correction:** The projector supports both digital and manual keystone correction. Use the remote control or the physical adjustment on the projector to correct trapezoidal distortion, ensuring a rectangular image even if the projector is not perfectly aligned with the screen.

5.4 Projection Size and Distance

The optimal projection size depends on the distance between the projector and the screen:

- The Livato Spark can project a screen size from 36 inches to 150 inches.
- Refer to the projection chart in the specifications section for recommended distances for various screen sizes.




Image: Projection distance guide for optimal viewing experience.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your projector, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning the Lens:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses. Do not use abrasive cleaners or cloths that could scratch the lens.
- **Cleaning the Exterior:** Wipe the projector's exterior with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, but ensure no moisture enters the device.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the projector's ventilation vents are clear and unobstructed to prevent overheating. Do not place the projector on soft surfaces that might block airflow.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the projector in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Livato Spark Projector, refer to the common problems and solutions below:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No Power	Power cable not connected; Power outlet faulty; Projector in standby mode.	Ensure power cable is securely connected. Try a different power outlet. Press the power button on the projector or remote.
No Image	Input source not selected; Cable connection loose/incorrect; Lens cap on.	Select the correct input source (HDMI, USB, etc.). Check all cable connections. Remove the lens cap.
Blurry Image	Focus not adjusted; Keystone not corrected; Projector too close/far from screen.	Adjust the focus ring. Use keystone correction. Adjust projection distance.
No Sound	Volume too low; Muted; External audio device not connected/selected.	Increase volume. Unmute. Check external speaker connection or select internal speaker.
WiFi/Bluetooth Connectivity Issues	Incorrect password; Out of range; Interference.	Verify password. Move closer to router/device. Reduce interference from other electronics.
