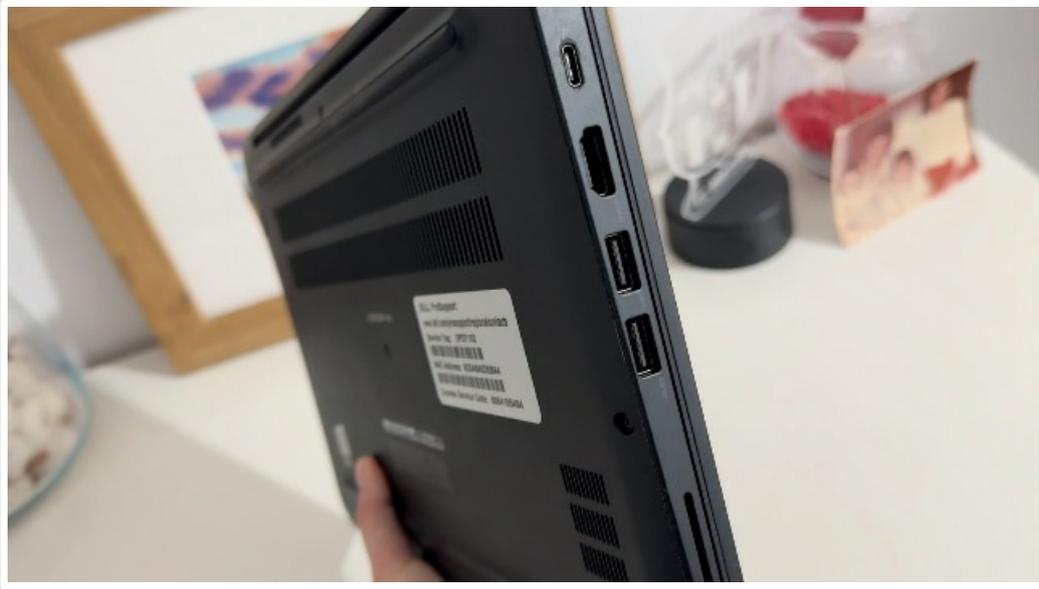


Image: Bottom view of the Dell Latitude 7490, showing ventilation grilles and product labels.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Laptop does not power on.	Ensure the AC adapter is securely connected to both the laptop and a working power outlet. Check if the power outlet is functional. Try a different power outlet if available.
Screen is blank or black.	Press the Fn + F2 (or corresponding brightness key) to increase brightness. Connect an external monitor to check if the display output works. Restart the laptop.
Wi-Fi connection issues.	Check if Wi-Fi is enabled (often Fn + PrtSc or similar key). Restart your router and modem. Ensure drivers are updated.
Slow performance.	Close unnecessary applications. Check for background processes using Task Manager. Ensure sufficient free storage space. Run a malware scan.

Problem	Possible Solution
Battery not charging.	Verify the AC adapter connection. Ensure the adapter is the correct one for your laptop. Check for any physical damage to the charging port or adapter.
