1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions carefully before operating the appliance to prevent personal injury or property damage. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure the appliance is connected to a properly grounded electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords or ungrounded adapters.
- **Placement:** Place the refrigerator on a firm, level surface away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and moisture. Allow adequate ventilation space around the unit.
- **Initial Setup:** After receiving the package, it is recommended to let the refrigerator stand upright for at least 24 hours before plugging it in. This allows the refrigerant to settle.
- **Ventilation:** Do not block any ventilation openings in the appliance enclosure or in the structure for building-in.
- **Flammable Materials:** Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this appliance.
- Children: Supervise children to ensure they do not play with the appliance.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The KRIB BLING 3.5 Cu.Ft Compact Refrigerator is designed for efficient cooling and freezing in various settings such as offices, dorms, apartments, or bars. It features a dual-door design, offering separate compartments for refrigeration and freezing.

- **Removable Glass Shelves:** Two detachable glass shelves in the refrigerator compartment, adjustable to different heights for flexible storage.
- Low Noise Operation: Engineered for quiet performance, typically below 37 dB.
- 360° Cycle Refrigeration: Ensures consistent cooling throughout the unit.
- Adjustable Leveling Feet: For stability on uneven surfaces.
- Included Accessories: Ice cube tray and ice spoon.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

3.1 Unboxing and Placement

- 1. Carefully remove the refrigerator from its packaging. It is recommended to have assistance due to its weight.
- 2. Place the refrigerator in its desired location. Ensure there is adequate space around the unit for proper ventilation (at least 4 inches on sides and back, 8 inches on top).
- 3. Allow the refrigerator to stand upright for a minimum of 24 hours before plugging it into a power outlet. This allows the compressor oils and refrigerants to settle, preventing potential damage.

3.2 Leveling the Appliance

The refrigerator is equipped with adjustable leveling feet. To ensure proper operation and door alignment, level the appliance by turning the feet clockwise or counter-clockwise until the unit is stable and level on the floor.

3.3 Initial Power-On

After the 24-hour waiting period, plug the refrigerator into a dedicated 120V AC outlet. For initial maximum cooling effect, set the thermostat level to 7.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Temperature Control

The refrigerator features a 7-level mechanical thermostat control located inside the fresh food compartment. Turn the dial to adjust the temperature. Setting 1 is the warmest, and Setting 7 is the coldest. For optimal food preservation, select a setting that suits your needs.

4.2 Storage Optimization

The refrigerator is equipped with two removable glass shelves. These shelves can be adjusted to different heights or removed entirely to accommodate taller items. The door also features racks for beverages and smaller items.

4.3 Quiet Operation

This refrigerator is designed with a low-noise compressor, ensuring minimal disturbance in your living or working space. The operating noise level is typically below 37 dB.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

5.1 Interior Cleaning

To clean the interior, unplug the appliance. Remove all food items and shelves. Wash the interior surfaces with a solution of mild detergent and warm water. Rinse thoroughly and dry with a soft cloth. The removable glass shelves can be washed with soap and water.

5.2 Exterior Cleaning

Clean the exterior surfaces with a soft cloth dampened with mild detergent and water. For stainless steel finishes, use a specialized stainless steel cleaner. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that may damage the finish.

5.3 Defrosting

The refrigerator features an automatic defrost system for the fresh food compartment. The freezer compartment may require manual defrosting if ice buildup becomes excessive. Unplug the unit, remove all contents, and allow the ice to melt naturally. Do not use sharp objects to remove ice.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your refrigerator, please refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- **Appliance Not Operating:** Check if the power cord is securely plugged into the outlet. Verify that the circuit breaker has not tripped.
- **Temperature Too Warm:** Ensure the thermostat setting is appropriate for your needs. Avoid frequent door openings. Check if the door is sealing properly.
- **Unusual Noises:** Minor noises are normal during operation. Ensure the appliance is level and not touching any walls or cabinets.
- Excessive Ice Buildup in Freezer: This may indicate the need for manual defrosting or that the door seal is compromised.
