1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the IKEA Omar Galvanized Shelf. This shelving unit is designed for versatile storage in various environments, offering easy assembly and clear visibility of contents. This manual provides essential information for safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new shelf.

Key Features:

- Easy to assemble system.
- Galvanized finish for durability.
- Adjustable shelves for flexible storage.

2. Safety Information

WARNING: Failure to follow these safety instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- **Maximum Load Capacity:** Do not exceed a maximum load of 46 kg (101 lbs) per shelf. Overloading can cause the shelf to collapse, leading to injury or damage.
- **Stability:** Ensure correct assembly and placement on a stable, level surface to guarantee stability. If necessary, secure the unit to a wall using appropriate fasteners (not included) to prevent tipping, especially in areas with children or pets.
- **Assembly:** Always follow the assembly instructions carefully. Do not modify the product in any way not specified by the manufacturer.
- **Children:** Keep small parts away from children during assembly.

3. Package Contents

Please refer to the packaging for a complete list of all components. Before beginning assembly, ensure all parts are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact your retailer for assistance.

4. Setup and Assembly Instructions

Assembly of the IKEA Omar shelf is designed to be straightforward. It is recommended to assemble the unit with two people for ease and safety.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all parts and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches.

2. **Assemble Posts:** Connect the post sections together. The posts typically consist of multiple segments that screw or slide into each other.
3. **Attach Feet:** Secure the adjustable feet to the bottom of the posts. These feet help level the unit on uneven floors.
4. **Install Shelf Clips:** Determine the desired height for your first shelf. Snap the plastic clips onto the posts at the same height for all four corners. Ensure they are securely in place and at an even level.
5. **Place First Shelf:** Carefully lower the shelf onto the installed clips. Press down firmly on all corners to ensure the shelf is seated correctly and securely.
6. **Repeat for Remaining Shelves:** Install clips and place subsequent shelves at your desired heights. The shelves are adjustable, allowing you to customize the spacing.
7. **Final Check:** Once all shelves are in place, gently rock the unit to ensure it is stable. Adjust the feet if necessary to eliminate any wobbling.




Figure 4.2: Dimensional drawing providing key measurements for the shelf, including overall height, width, depth, and shelf spacing.

5. Operating Instructions

The IKEA Omar shelf is designed for general storage purposes in various rooms such as hallways, kitchens, and bathrooms.

- **Placement:** Position the shelf on a flat, stable surface. Avoid placing it in areas with excessive moisture or direct heat unless specifically designed for such conditions.
- **Loading:** Distribute weight evenly across each shelf. Do not concentrate heavy items in one area. Always adhere to the maximum load capacity of 46 kg per shelf.
- **Accessibility:** The open design allows for easy visibility and access to stored items.

6. Maintenance and Care

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your galvanized shelf, follow these simple care instructions:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the shelf with a dry cloth to remove dust and light dirt. For more stubborn marks, use a damp cloth with a mild detergent, then dry thoroughly.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or chemical solvents, as these can damage the galvanized finish.
- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check all connections and fasteners to ensure they remain tight and secure.

7. Troubleshooting

- **Shelf is Unstable/Wobbly:**

Solution: Ensure the shelf is placed on a level surface. Adjust the feet at the bottom of the posts to compensate for unevenness. Verify that all shelf clips are securely seated and that the shelves are fully lowered onto them. If necessary, consider securing the unit to a wall.

- **Shelf Collapses/Bends:**

Solution: Immediately remove items from the shelf. This indicates that the maximum load capacity of 46 kg per shelf has been exceeded. Redistribute items or reduce the total weight. Inspect for any damaged components.

- **Difficulty Assembling:**

Solution: Review the assembly instructions carefully. Ensure all parts are oriented correctly. Sometimes, a gentle tap with a rubber mallet (not included) can help seat components, but avoid excessive force.




