## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Podofo Android Car Stereo GPS system. Designed specifically for Peugeot 208 and 2008 models manufactured between 2012 and 2018, this unit features a 10-inch touchscreen, Android operating system, GPS navigation, Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, and FM RDS radio capabilities. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use to ensure proper functionality and safety.

## 3. COMPATIBILITY & DIMENSIONS

This car stereo is compatible with Peugeot 208 and 2008 models from 2012 to 2018. Please ensure your vehicle's central console matches the shape and dimensions shown in the product images before installation.

### Unit Dimensions:

- Width (top): 270 mm
- Width (bottom): 280 mm
- Height: 160 mm

## 4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation of this car stereo system requires technical knowledge. It is highly recommended to seek professional assistance for installation to avoid damage to the unit or your vehicle. If you choose to install it yourself, proceed with caution and follow these general guidelines:

1. **Preparation:** Disconnect the vehicle's battery before starting any electrical work.
2. **Remove Original Unit:** Carefully remove the existing car stereo and trim panels from your vehicle's dashboard. Refer to your vehicle's service manual for specific instructions.
3. **Connect Wiring:** Connect the provided power cable, CANBUS decoder, GPS antenna, radio antenna cable, camera input cable, audio/video cable, and USB cables to the corresponding ports on the new car stereo and your vehicle's wiring harness. Ensure all connections are secure.
4. **Test Functionality:** Before fully reassembling the dashboard, temporarily connect the battery and test the basic functions of the stereo (power on/off, radio, display).
5. **Secure Unit:** Mount the new car stereo securely into the dashboard opening using the provided installation tools and brackets.
6. **Reassemble:** Reinstall all trim panels and reconnect the vehicle's battery.

The included CANBUS decoder ensures proper communication between the car stereo and your vehicle's systems, such as steering wheel controls.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 5.1 Basic Functions

- **Power On/Off:** Press and hold the power button on the unit or use the vehicle's ignition.
- **Touchscreen:** The 10-inch capacitive touchscreen allows for intuitive control of all functions. Tap, swipe, and pinch to navigate menus and applications.
- **Android System:** The unit runs on an Android operating system, providing access to various applications and customization options.

### 5.2 Connectivity

- **Bluetooth 4.2:** Pair your smartphone via Bluetooth for hands-free calling and audio streaming. Access the Bluetooth menu on the stereo to search for devices and connect. The built-in microphone ensures clear call quality.

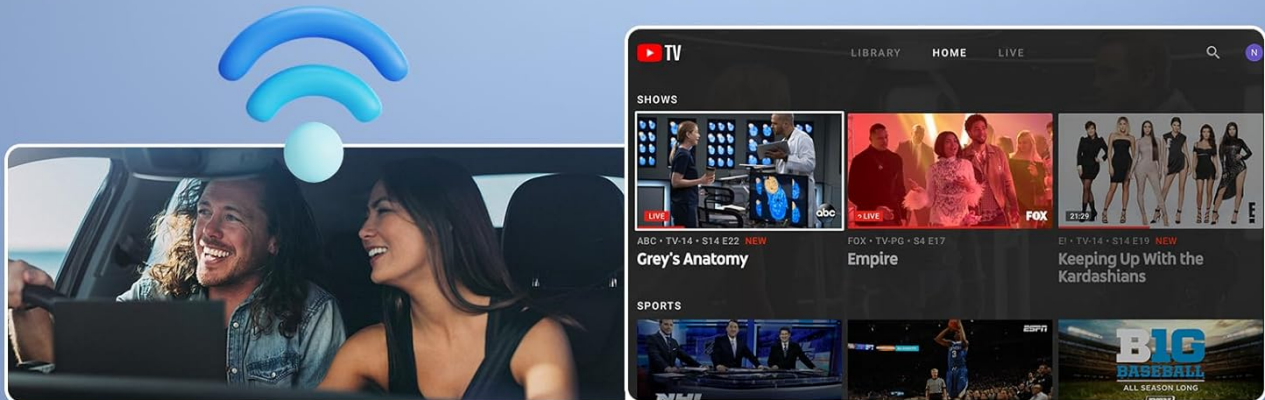


Image 5.1: Bluetooth for music and phone calls, and Wi-Fi connection.

- **Wi-Fi:** Connect the unit to a Wi-Fi hotspot (e.g., from your smartphone) to access online features, download apps, and use online navigation. Go to Settings > Network & Internet > Wi-Fi to connect.
- **Mirror Link:** This feature allows you to mirror your smartphone's screen onto the car stereo display. Connect your phone via a USB cable. iOS devices (under IOS 16.5) support one-way projection, while Android devices (8.0-13.0) support two-way connection.

- **USB:** The unit features dual rear USB ports. Connect USB drives (4-32GB) to play media files.

## 5.3 Navigation

The integrated GPS module provides accurate navigation. The unit comes pre-installed with the Here WeGo app, allowing you to download offline maps for various countries. You can also use online navigation apps by connecting to Wi-Fi.

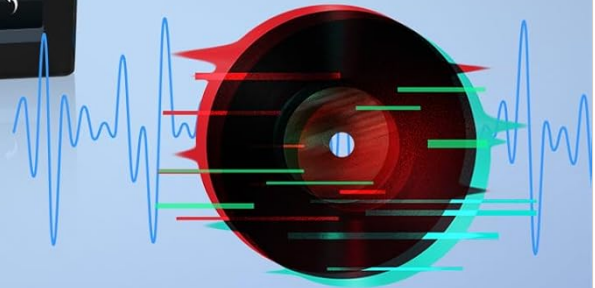
## 5.4 Multimedia

- **FM RDS Radio:** Tune into your favorite radio stations. The RDS function displays station information where available.

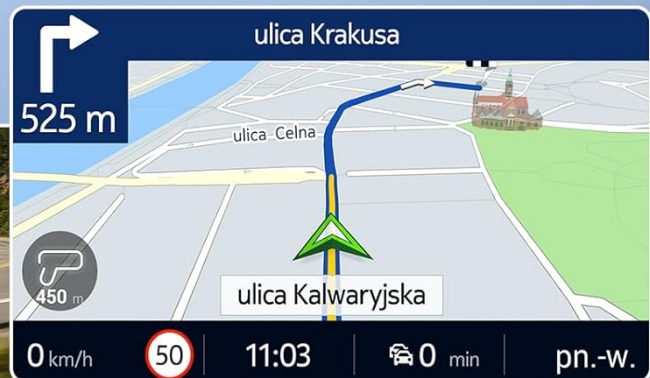


Image 5.3: FM Radio and GPS Navigation interfaces.

## 5.5 Split Screen Function

The split-screen function allows you to view two applications simultaneously. In the activity view, drag an application to the left or right side of the screen to activate split-screen mode. Note that not all applications support this feature.

## 5.6 Steering Wheel Control

The unit supports your vehicle's original steering wheel controls via the CANBUS connection. This allows you to control volume, track changes, and other functions without taking your hands off the wheel. Configuration may be required in the system settings.

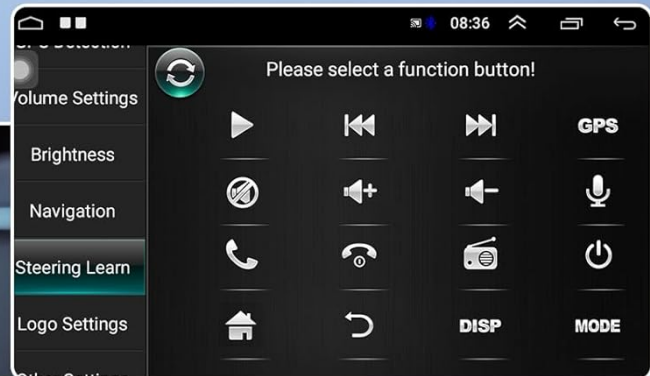


Image 5.4: HD Rear Camera input and Steering Wheel Control settings.

### 5.7 Rear Camera Input

The car stereo supports an external rear camera (not included). Connect a compatible camera to the dedicated input for automatic display when reversing. The system supports wide-angle, night vision, and waterproof cameras.

### 5.8 External Device Support

The unit can be expanded with external USB dongles (not included) for additional functionalities such as DAB+ digital radio, DVR (Digital Video Recorder), OBDII diagnostics, and Carplay/Android Auto.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

---

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Podofo car stereo, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the touchscreen and unit exterior. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaner. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.
- **Software Updates:** Periodically check for software updates through the system settings or the manufacturer's website. Keeping the software updated can improve performance and add new features.
- **Avoid Extreme Temperatures:** Do not expose the unit to extreme heat or cold for extended periods, as this can affect its electronic components.
- **Cable Connections:** Ensure all cables are securely connected. Loose connections can lead to intermittent issues.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your car stereo, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Check the power cable connection and the vehicle's fuse box. Ensure the unit is properly installed and receiving power.
- **No Sound:** Verify speaker connections. Check volume settings on the unit and ensure mute is not activated. Test different audio sources.
- **Touchscreen Unresponsive:** Try restarting the unit. If the issue persists, a factory reset might be necessary (note: this will erase personal data).
- **GPS Signal Lost:** Ensure the GPS antenna is properly installed and has a clear view of the sky. Check GPS settings in the system.
- **Bluetooth Connection Issues:** Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on both the stereo and your phone. Delete previous pairings and try reconnecting.
- **Wi-Fi Connection Problems:** Verify your Wi-Fi hotspot is active and providing internet access. Re-enter the Wi-Fi password if necessary.
- **Slow Performance:** Close unnecessary background applications. Clear cache data if available in system settings. Consider a factory reset if performance remains poor.
