1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Thank you for choosing the OLEVS GW-G6898 Men's Quartz Watch. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your timepiece. Please read it carefully to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your watch.

2. SETUP AND INITIAL USE

2.1 Unboxing and Inspection

- Carefully remove the watch from its packaging.
- Inspect the watch for any visible damage or protective films. Remove any plastic films from the crystal, case back, or strap.

2.2 Setting the Time and Date

Your OLEVS GW-G6898 watch features a crown for adjusting the time and date. The crown has two positions when pulled out.

- Setting the Date:** Gently pull the crown out to the **first position**. Turn the crown **clockwise** to adjust the date. Turn the crown **counter-clockwise** to adjust the day of the week. Adjust until the correct date and day are displayed.
- Setting the Time:** Pull the crown out to the **second position**. Turn the crown in either direction to move the hour and minute hands. Set the time to the desired hour, ensuring the AM/PM is correct (the date will change at midnight).
- Once the time and date are set, push the crown back into its original **closed position** to start the watch and ensure water resistance.

3. OPERATING YOUR WATCH

3.1 Luminous Display

The OLEVS GW-G6898 features an HD luminous display on its hands and hour markers. This material absorbs light during the day and emits a glow in low-light conditions, allowing for easy readability at night.

3.2 Water Resistance

This watch is water-resistant up to 30 meters (3 ATM or 100 feet). This means it is suitable for daily use, such as splashes, rain, and brief immersion in water. It is **not recommended** for swimming, diving, or prolonged water activities. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in to maintain water resistance.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

4.1 Cleaning Your Watch

- Wipe the watch case and crystal with a soft, dry cloth regularly to remove dust and fingerprints.
- For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water and gently wipe. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

4.2 Leather Strap Care

- Avoid prolonged exposure of the leather strap to direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and moisture, as this can cause discoloration or damage.
- If the strap gets wet, dry it immediately with a soft cloth and allow it to air dry completely before wearing.
- Clean the leather strap with a specialized leather cleaner or a slightly damp cloth.

4.3 Battery Replacement

The OLEVS GW-G6898 is powered by a quartz movement, which uses a battery. When the watch stops or the second hand begins to jump erratically (indicating low battery), it's time for a battery replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and maintain water resistance.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Running:** Check if the crown is fully pushed in. If it is, the battery may need replacement.
- **Time/Date Not Setting:** Ensure the crown is pulled out to the correct position (first for date, second for time). If the issue persists, consult a watch technician.
- **Condensation Inside Crystal:** This may indicate a loss of water resistance. Avoid further contact with water and have the watch inspected by a professional immediately to prevent damage to the movement.
