Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the Timex TW5M26600 Digital Watch. Please read this manual carefully to understand the functions and proper operation of your watch. This watch is designed for durability and reliability, featuring a robust resin case and a digital display.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP

Initial Setup and Time Setting

- 1. Activate the Watch: If the display is off, press any button to activate the watch.
- 2. **Enter Set Mode:** Press and hold the **SET/RECALL** button (usually top-left) until the display flashes, indicating you are in set mode.
- 3. **Adjust Time:** Use the **START/LAP** button (top-right) to increase the value and the **STOP/RESET** button (bottom-right) to decrease.
- 4. **Navigate Fields:** Press the **MODE** button (bottom-left) to move between hours, minutes, seconds, 12/24-hour format, year, month, and day.

Save Settings: Once all settings are adjusted, press the SET/RECALL button again to exit set mode and save your changes.

Indiglo Night-Light

To activate the Indiglo night-light, press the **INDIGLO** button (usually top-right or a dedicated button). The display will illuminate for a few seconds, allowing visibility in low-light conditions.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Navigating Modes

Press the **MODE** button (bottom-left) repeatedly to cycle through the different functions of the watch. The available modes typically include:

- Time Mode (CHR): Displays current time, day, and date.
- Chronograph (TMR): Stopwatch function for measuring elapsed time.
- Timer (ALM): Countdown timer.
- Alarm (REP): Set daily alarms.

Using the Chronograph

- 1. Enter Chronograph Mode: Press MODE until "CHR" or "STOPWATCH" appears.
- 2. Start/Stop: Press START/LAP to begin timing. Press again to pause.
- 3. **Lap/Split:** While timing, press **LAP** (often the same as START/LAP or a dedicated button) to record lap times without stopping the main timer.
- 4. Reset: Press STOP/RESET to clear the chronograph to zero.

Setting and Using the Alarm

- 1. Enter Alarm Mode: Press MODE until "ALM" or "ALARM" appears.
- 2. **Set Alarm Time:** Press and hold **SET/RECALL** to enter alarm setting mode. Use**START/LAP** and **STOP/RESET** to adjust hours and minutes. Use **MODE** to switch between hours and minutes.
- 3. **Activate/Deactivate Alarm:** In Alarm Mode, press **START/LAP** to toggle the alarm ON/OFF. An alarm icon will appear when active.
- 4. **Snooze:** When the alarm sounds, press any button (except**STOP/RESET**) to activate snooze. The alarm will sound again after a few minutes.
- 5. **Stop Alarm:** Press **STOP/RESET** when the alarm sounds to turn it off completely.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your Watch

To maintain the appearance of your watch, wipe it regularly with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the resin case and strap.

Water Resistance

The Timex TW5M26600 is water-resistant up to 20 ATM (200 meters). This means it is suitable for professional marine activity and serious surface water sports, but not for diving. *Do not press any buttons while the watch is submerged in*

water. Ensure the crown (if applicable) is fully pushed in before exposing the watch to water.

Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a long-life battery. When the display becomes dim or functions become erratic, it may be time for a battery replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and maintain water resistance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|---------------------------|--|---|
| Display is blank or dim. | Low battery. | Replace the battery. |
| Buttons are unresponsive. | Watch may be in a locked mode or internal issue. | Try a soft reset (refer to manual if available, or remove/reinsert battery if comfortable). If issue persists, contact support. |
| Time is incorrect. | Time not set correctly or accidental adjustment. | Re-set the time following the "Initial Setup and Time Setting" instructions. |
| Water inside the watch. | Water resistance compromised (e.g., buttons pressed underwater, seal failure). | Immediately take the watch to a qualified technician for inspection and repair to prevent further damage. |
