1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the NTAYDZSW Steamer for Clothes. This powerful 1800W handheld steamer is designed for efficient wrinkle removal and fabric care, featuring wet/dry ironing modes, rapid 20-second heat-up, and a detachable water tank. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use to ensure safe and optimal performance.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury.

- Ensure the voltage matches your local power supply (120V for this model).
- Do not immerse the steamer in water or other liquids.
- Keep out of reach of children and pets.
- Always unplug the steamer when not in use, before filling or emptying the water tank, and before cleaning.
- Use caution when handling hot steam. Keep hands and face away from the steam nozzle.
- Do not operate the steamer with a damaged cord or plug.
- Only use distilled or de-mineralized water to prevent mineral buildup.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Fabric Brush Attachment x1
- Heat-Resistant Gloves x1
- Measuring Cup x1

4. SETUP

Follow these steps for initial setup before using your steamer:

1. **Pull out the water tank:** Locate the detachable water tank at the base of the steamer and gently pull it out.
2. **Fill water:** Open the water tank cap and fill the tank with clean, distilled, or de-mineralized water using the provided measuring cup. Do not overfill. Close the cap securely and reinsert the tank into the steamer until it clicks into place.
3. **Plug in:** Connect the power cord to a standard 120V electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your steamer offers both wet and dry ironing modes for versatile use.

5.1. Steaming (Wet Ironing)

1. Ensure the water tank is filled and the steamer is plugged in.

2. Press the power button. The indicator light will illuminate, signifying that the steamer is heating up. It will be ready in approximately 20 seconds.
3. Once heated, move the steam switch upward to release continuous steam.
4. Hold the steamer upright and move it slowly over the fabric, maintaining a slight distance to allow steam to penetrate. For best results, gently pull the fabric taut with your free hand (wearing the heat-resistant glove).
5. For stubborn wrinkles, attach the fabric brush.
6. When finished, release the steam switch and unplug the steamer.

5.2. Dry Ironing

The steamer can also be used for dry ironing, similar to a traditional iron, by not engaging the steam function.

1. Ensure the water tank is empty or removed for dry ironing.
2. Plug in the steamer and allow it to heat up.
3. Place the garment on a flat, heat-resistant surface.
4. Gently press the heated soleplate onto the fabric and move it to smooth out wrinkles.
5. When finished, unplug the steamer.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your steamer.

6.1. Cleaning

- Always unplug the steamer and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Empty any remaining water from the tank after each use.
- Wipe the exterior of the steamer with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- If mineral buildup occurs in the steam nozzle, use a cotton swab dipped in white vinegar to gently clean the openings. Rinse with a small amount of distilled water.

6.2. Storage

- Ensure the steamer is completely cool and dry before storing.
- Store the steamer in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- Wrap the power cord neatly around the base or use a cord tie.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your steamer, refer to the table below for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam or low steam output	Water tank empty; Steamer not heated; Mineral buildup in nozzle.	Refill water tank; Allow 20 seconds for heat-up; Clean nozzle with vinegar.
Water spitting or leaking	Water tank not properly seated; Overfilled water tank; Steamer not fully heated.	Ensure tank is securely clicked in; Do not overfill; Wait for full heat-up before steaming.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Steamer not turning on	Not plugged in; Power outlet issue; Damaged cord/plug.	Check power connection; Try a different outlet; Contact customer support if cord is damaged.
