1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The HALO Elite4B Outdoor Griddle is a versatile 4-burner propane gas grill designed for outdoor cooking. It features an 8-zone, 720 sq. in. (36" W x 20" D) wind-proof cooking surface, offering precise temperature control for a variety of dishes. The griddle includes a hinged lid, a built-in warming rack, and adjustable caster wheels for portability. This griddle is engineered for durability and ease of use, making it suitable for backyard cookouts, tailgate parties, and campsite feasts.

2. KEY FEATURES

- **No Cold Spots:** Enjoy precise temperature control and wall-to-wall even cooking across eight zones with this 4-burner griddle.
- **Wind-Proof Cooking Surface:** The proprietary inset 720 sq. in. (36" W x 20" D) griddle plate design provides wind protection.

- **Cooking Versatility:** Hinged lid allows for cooking open or closed, enabling steaming, melting, or heat retention.
- **Portability:** Fueled by a 20 lb propane tank and featuring a built-in bubble level and adjustable caster wheels for easy movement.
- **Quality Construction:** Made with hot-rolled steel griddle plate, heat-resistant 430 stainless steel, and high-temperature powder-coated steel.

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Before first use, ensure all packaging materials are removed and the griddle is placed on a stable, level surface. Connect the propane tank as per the manufacturer's guidelines.

3.1. Assembling Side Tables and Grease Trap

The griddle features side tables that can be folded down for storage or extended for use. The grease trap is located at the back of the griddle and is designed for easy removal and cleaning.

3.2. Leveling the Griddle

Use the built-in bubble level to ensure the griddle is perfectly level for even cooking and proper grease drainage. Adjust the caster wheels as needed.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Lighting the Burners

To light a burner, turn the control knob to the "Light" position and press the igniter button. Verify the flame through the sight glass. The griddle features individual controls for each burner, allowing for precise temperature management across its eight cooking zones.

4.2. Cooking with the Hinged Lid

The hinged lid can be used in both open and closed positions. Use it open for traditional griddle cooking, or close it to steam, melt cheese, or retain heat, especially in windy conditions.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1. Cleaning the Griddle Plate

After each use, allow the griddle to cool slightly. Scrape off any food residue using a griddle scraper or the integrated utensil squeegee into the rear grease catchment. For thorough cleaning, warm water and a mild detergent can be used, followed by re-seasoning.

5.2. Seasoning the Griddle

Regular seasoning is crucial for maintaining a non-stick surface and preventing rust. Apply a thin layer of high-smoke point oil (e.g., flaxseed, grapeseed, or vegetable oil) to the griddle surface and heat until it smokes. Repeat this process several times for optimal seasoning.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your HALO Elite4B Outdoor Griddle, consider the following common solutions:

- **Burners not lighting:** Check propane tank connection and ensure it has sufficient fuel. Verify igniter is clicking and producing a spark.
- **Uneven heating:** Ensure the griddle is level using the built-in bubble level. Clean burners and griddle surface to remove any blockages.

- **Food sticking:** Re-season the griddle surface thoroughly. Ensure adequate oil is used during cooking.
- **Low flame:** Check for kinks in the gas hose or a low propane tank.
