## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Eno INITIAL 50 INOX gas griddle. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new appliance. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the griddle and keep it for future reference.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury.

- This appliance is designed for outdoor cooking and grilling. Do not use indoors.
- Ensure proper ventilation when operating the griddle.
- Keep children and pets away from the hot griddle.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use oven mitts or heat-resistant gloves.
- Ensure the griddle is placed on a stable, non-combustible surface.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or sharp objects on the enameled cast iron plate.
- Disconnect the gas supply when the griddle is not in use or during cleaning.
- Regularly check gas connections for leaks using a soapy water solution.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

- Control Knobs for Gas Burners

## SETUP

---

### 1. Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials. Inspect the griddle for any damage during transit. Retain packaging for future storage or transport if needed.

### 2. Placement

Place the griddle on a flat, stable, and heat-resistant surface outdoors. Ensure there is adequate clearance from combustible materials (walls, furniture, etc.).

### 3. Gas Connection

Connect the griddle to a suitable gas supply (e.g., propane tank) using a certified gas hose and regulator (not included). Ensure all connections are tight. Perform a leak test by applying a soapy water solution to all gas connections. Bubbles indicate a leak. If a leak is detected, turn off the gas supply immediately and tighten connections or replace faulty parts.

### 4. Initial Cleaning

Before first use, wipe down the enameled cast iron plate with a damp cloth to remove any manufacturing residues. Dry thoroughly.

## OPERATING

---

### 1. Ignition

1. Ensure the gas supply is open.
2. Push in and turn a control knob counter-clockwise to the HIGH position.
3. Press the ignition button (if available) or use a long lighter to ignite the burner.
4. Once lit, release the control knob. Repeat for the second burner if desired.

### 2. Temperature Control

Adjust the control knobs between HIGH and LOW settings to achieve the desired cooking temperature. The enameled cast iron plate retains heat very well, allowing for consistent cooking.

### 3. Cooking Tips

- Preheat the griddle for 5-10 minutes before adding food for even cooking.
- Use a small amount of cooking oil on the griddle surface.
- The griddle is ideal for cooking a variety of foods, including meats, vegetables, eggs, and pancakes.

### 4. Shutting Down

When finished cooking, turn the control knobs to the OFF position. Close the gas supply valve on the gas tank.

## MAINTENANCE

### 1. Daily Cleaning

- After each use, while the griddle is still warm (but not hot), scrape off food residues using a griddle scraper.
- Wipe the surface with a damp cloth. For stubborn residues, use a mild soap solution and rinse thoroughly.
- Empty and clean the grease collection tray regularly.

## 2. Deep Cleaning

Periodically, perform a deeper clean. Ensure the griddle is completely cool and the gas supply is disconnected. Clean the stainless steel body with a non-abrasive cleaner designed for stainless steel. The enameled cast iron plate is not dishwasher safe.

## 3. Storage

Store the griddle in a dry, protected area when not in use, especially during colder months, to prevent damage from elements. Consider using a protective cover.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Burner does not ignite.	No gas supply; Clogged burner; Faulty igniter.	Check gas tank and connections; Clean burner ports; Use a long lighter to ignite manually.
Uneven heating.	Partially clogged burner; Griddle not level.	Clean burner ports; Ensure griddle is on a flat surface.
Excessive smoke.	Too much oil; Food residue buildup.	Reduce oil; Clean griddle surface thoroughly.



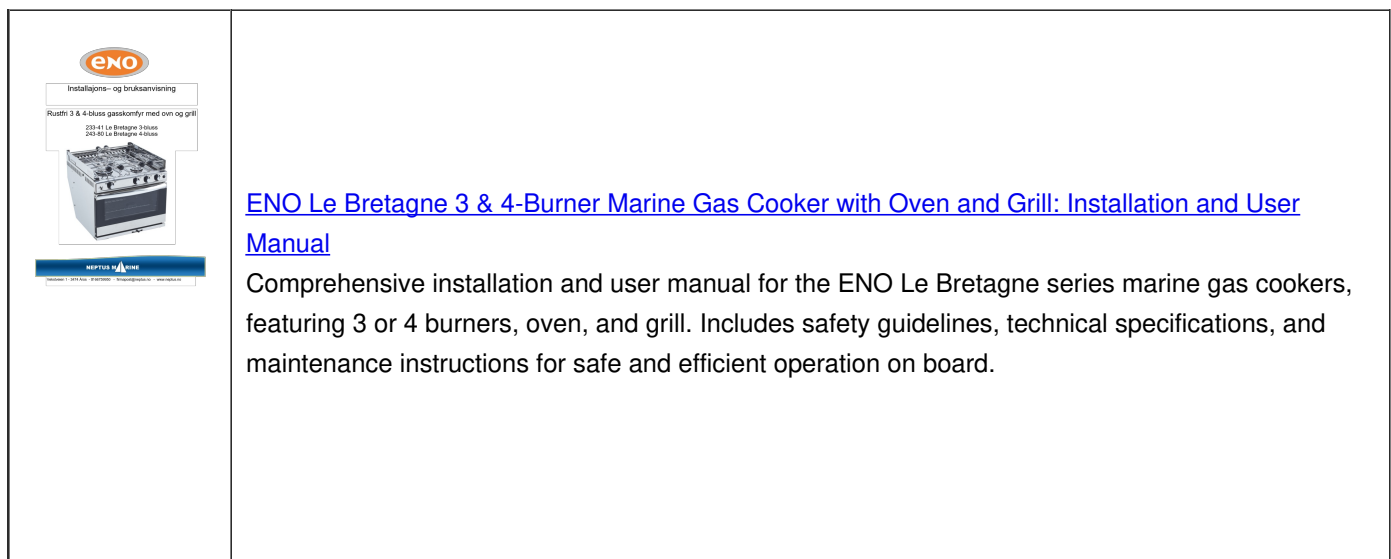
