Godox AD400Pro Outdoor Flash Strobe Light Instruction Manual

MODEL: YHGD-AD400Pro

1. Product Overview

The Godox AD400Pro is an all-in-one outdoor flash strobe light, offering 400W of power with 2.4G TTL capabilities. It features a fast recycle time of 0.01-1s and 1/8000s High-Speed Sync (HSS), making it suitable for studio and portable use. This speedlite includes a battery and is compatible with Canon, Sony, Nikon, Fuji, Olympus, and Panasonic cameras.

3. Setup

3.1 Battery Activation

To activate the battery after a long period of non-use (e.g., one month), it may enter hibernation mode. To reactivate, press the battery activation key several times until the battery indicator lights up, then recharge normally. The activation key is located next to the battery indicator.

3.2 Mounting Accessories

The AD400Pro flash body features a Godox mount for direct attachment of compatible accessories. A Bowens mount adapter ring is included, allowing compatibility with a wider range of Bowens mount modifiers such as softboxes and reflectors. Ensure the adapter ring is securely attached before mounting accessories.



1. Press the battery activation key several times
The battery activation key is next to the battery indicator.
(Noted: Press the right part of the battery activation key)



2. Activate the battery
When the battery light comes on, the battery is activated.

4. Operating Instructions

4.1 Power and Recycling Time

The AD400Pro delivers 400Ws of flash power (Guide Number 72). The 21.6V 2600mAh lithium battery provides approximately 380 full-power flashes with a rapid recycle time of 0.01 to 0.9 seconds. Flash power is adjustable in 9 steps from 1/128 to 1/1. The unit also features a power indicator and auto sleep mode to conserve battery life.

4.2 TTL and HSS Functions

The AD400Pro fully supports TTL (Through-The-Lens) functionality, including Master/Slave modes, flash exposure compensation, 1/8000s High-Speed Sync (HSS), first/second-curtain sync, and multi-flash modes. It also includes a

30Ws modeling lamp and C.Fn custom functions. The flash maintains a stable 5600K color temperature. It is compatible with various camera systems (Canon, Sony, Nikon, Olympus, Fuji, Panasonic) and can be triggered by Godox X3/Xpro II/X2T triggers.

4.3 Wireless Control

The AD400Pro integrates with the Godox 2.4G Wireless X System, allowing it to be triggered and controlled wirelessly by compatible Godox X-series triggers (e.g., X3, Xpro II, X2T). This enables remote adjustment of flash settings and coordination with other Godox flash units.

5. Product Maintenance

5.1 Battery Care

To ensure optimal performance and extend battery life, avoid completely draining the battery before recharging. If the battery has not been used for an extended period (e.g., one month), it may enter hibernation mode. To reactivate, press the battery activation key several times until the battery indicator lights up, then recharge normally. Periodically charge the battery or power up the flash to prevent over-discharge.

6. Troubleshooting

No specific troubleshooting section is provided in the product details. For common issues, please refer to the general instruction manual included in the package or contact Godox customer support.



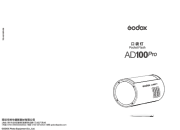
