1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, use, and maintenance of your KADAX Elegant Tall Planter. 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- When moving the planter, especially when filled, exercise caution and lift from the base to avoid strain or damage.
- The planter is weather-resistant, but extreme temperatures or prolonged exposure to harsh conditions may affect its lifespan.

3. COMPONENTS

Your KADAX Elegant Tall Planter typically includes the following parts:

- **Outer Planter Shell:** The main decorative body of the planter.
- **Inner Pot/Insert:** A removable pot designed to hold soil and plants, fitting inside the outer shell. This allows for easier planting and reduces the amount of soil needed.

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your planter:

consider drainage.

3. **Insert Inner Pot:** Place the inner pot securely into the outer planter shell. It should fit snugly.
4. **Add Drainage (Optional):** For outdoor use or plants requiring excellent drainage, you may add a layer of gravel or drainage material at the bottom of the inner pot before adding soil. The inner pot is designed to minimize soil usage.
5. **Fill with Soil:** Fill the inner pot with appropriate potting soil for your chosen plants. Leave sufficient space at the top for watering.
6. **Planting:** Carefully plant your desired plant(s) into the soil.
7. **Watering:** Water the plant thoroughly after planting.

- **Placement:** The planter is suitable for both indoor and outdoor environments. For outdoor use, its weather-resistant plastic ensures durability against various elements.
- **Repotting:** The removable inner pot simplifies the process of repotting or changing plants. Simply lift the inner pot out of the outer shell.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your KADAX planter, follow these maintenance tips:

- **Cleaning:** Clean the planter regularly with a soft cloth and mild soap solution. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the plastic.
- **Drainage Holes:** Periodically check the drainage holes in the inner pot to ensure they are not clogged with soil,

which can lead to waterlogging.

- **Weather Resistance:** While resistant to weather, consider bringing indoor planters inside during extreme winter conditions to prevent potential cracking due to freezing and thawing cycles if water is present.
- **Storage:** If storing the planter, clean it thoroughly and store in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight to prevent material degradation over time.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Planter appears unstable.	Uneven surface; insufficient soil/plant weight.	Ensure placement on a flat, level surface. If empty, add some ballast or soil to the inner pot for stability.
Water accumulates at the bottom of the outer shell.	Inner pot drainage holes are clogged or overwatering.	Remove inner pot and clear any debris from drainage holes. Reduce watering frequency or volume.
Discoloration or fading of the planter.	Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight or harsh chemicals.	Move the planter to a shaded area if possible. Use only mild soap and water for cleaning.
