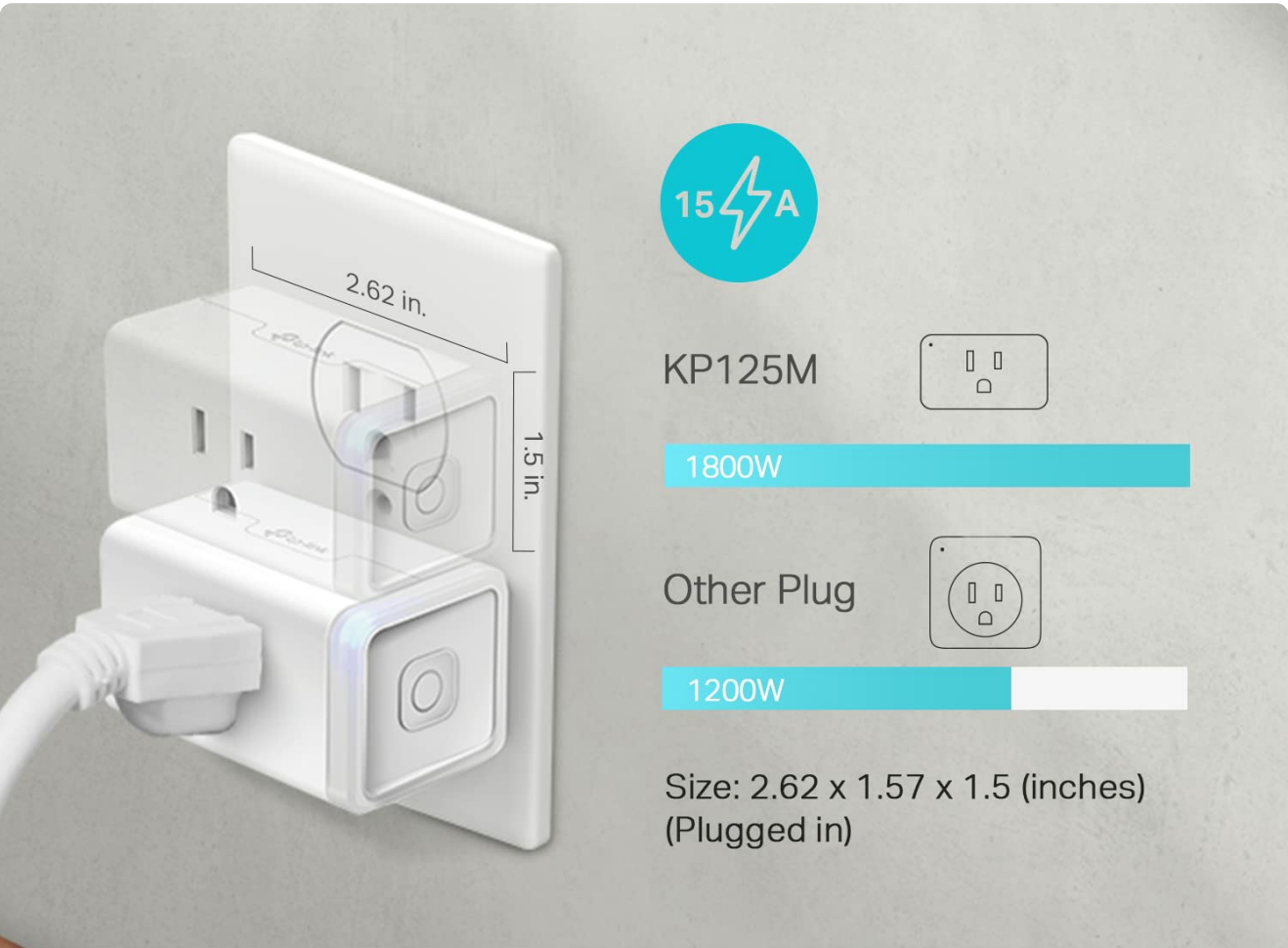


Image: Kasa Matter Smart Plug KP125M 4-Pack packaging, showing four white smart plugs and the product box.

SETUP GUIDE

Before You Begin

Ensure your Wi-Fi network is 2.4GHz. The Kasa Smart Plug KP125M requires a 2.4GHz Wi-Fi connection for initial setup and operation. For Matter compatibility, ensure your smart home hub (e.g., Apple HomePod, Amazon Echo, Google Nest Hub) is updated to the latest firmware.

Step 1: Download the Kasa App

Download the Kasa Smart app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store. This app is essential for initial setup and managing your smart plugs.

Step 2: Plug In Your Smart Plug

Plug your Kasa Matter Smart Plug into an available electrical outlet. The LED indicator on the plug will begin to blink, indicating it is ready for setup.

Step 3: Connect to Wi-Fi and Pair



Open the Kasa Smart app and follow the on-screen instructions to add your new device. The app will guide you through connecting the plug to your 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network and pairing it with your Kasa account.

Matter Setup

The Kasa Matter Smart Plug KP125M supports Matter for enhanced interoperability. You can set up the plug using the Kasa Smart app via Bluetooth onboarding, or by scanning the Matter code with any Matter-compatible app such as Apple Home, Amazon Alexa, or Google Home. This allows for seamless integration into your existing smart home ecosystem.

OPERATING YOUR SMART PLUG

Basic Control

Once set up, you can turn the connected device on or off directly from the Kasa Smart app. You can also manually toggle the power using the physical button on the side of the smart plug.

Voice Control

Integrate your Kasa Smart Plug with voice assistants like Amazon Alexa, Google Assistant, or Apple Siri (via HomeKit) for hands-free control. Simply link your Kasa account within your preferred smart home app and use commands such as "Hey Siri, turn on the light," "Ok Google, turn on the light," or "Alexa, turn on the light."



Voice Control

Use simple voice commands to control your devices hands-free.

Energy Monitoring

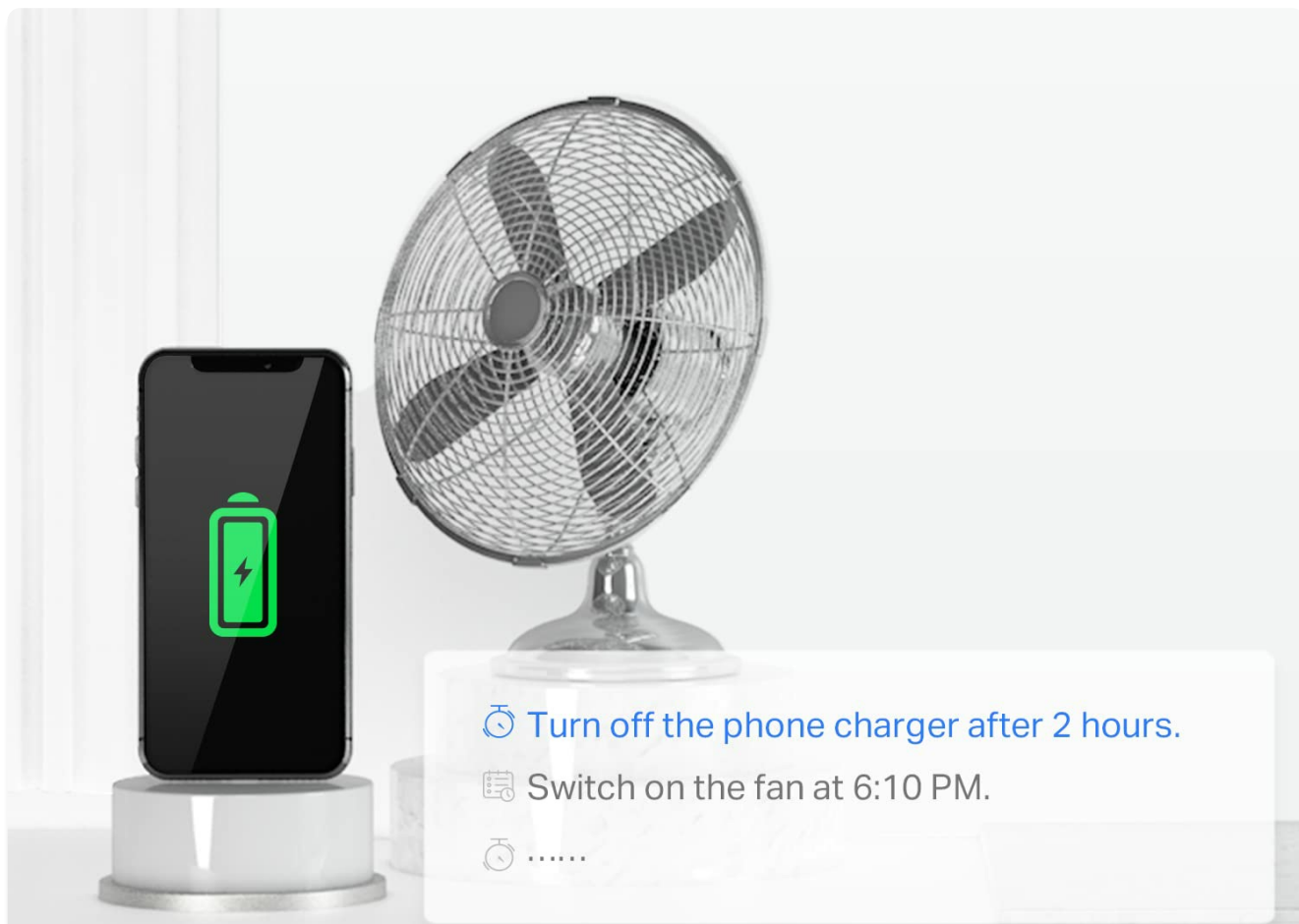

Scheduling and Timers

Set schedules to automatically turn devices on or off at specific times. You can also use the timer function to turn off a device after a set duration, or create countdown timers for specific tasks.

Away Mode

Activate "Away Mode" in the Kasa app to randomly turn connected lights or appliances on and off, simulating occupancy to deter potential intruders when you are away from home.

Local Area Network (LAN) Control

Thanks to Matter, your Kasa Smart Plug can communicate directly with other Matter-certified devices on your local network. This means that even if your internet connection is down, you can still control your smart plug and other compatible devices within your home network.

MAINTENANCE

The Kasa Matter Smart Plug KP125M requires minimal maintenance. Keep the device clean by wiping it with a dry,

soft cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials. Ensure the plug is disconnected from the power outlet before cleaning. Avoid exposing the device to excessive moisture or extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

- **Plug not connecting to Wi-Fi:** Ensure your Wi-Fi network is 2.4GHz. Move the plug closer to your Wi-Fi router. Restart your router and the smart plug. Verify your Wi-Fi password is correct.
- **Voice control not working:** Ensure your Kasa account is correctly linked to your voice assistant (Alexa, Google Assistant, Siri). Check your internet connection. Verify the device name in the Kasa app matches the name you are using for voice commands.
- **Energy monitoring data is incorrect or missing:** Ensure the plug is securely inserted into the outlet and the device is properly connected to the plug. Check for any app updates.
- **Plug is unresponsive:** Try unplugging the smart plug from the wall outlet for 10 seconds and then plugging it back in. If the issue persists, consider resetting the plug to factory defaults (refer to the Quick Start Guide for specific instructions) and re-setting it up.

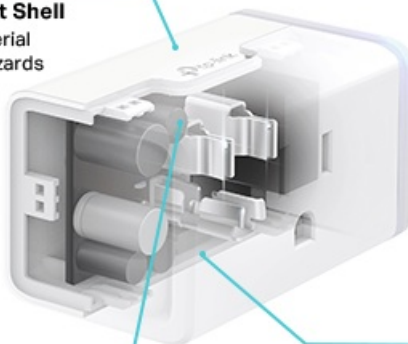


