Your guide to assembly, operation, and maintenance.

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your EROMMY 10'x13' Hardtop Gazebo. Designed for outdoor use, this gazebo features a durable galvanized steel roof, a wooden-look aluminum frame, and integrated netting and curtains for enhanced comfort and functionality. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly or use.

Key Features:

- **Galvanized Steel Roof:** Fade-resistant, rust-resistant, and designed to withstand heavy snow and wind. The double-top design promotes ventilation and reduces wind speed.
- **Wooden Grain Aluminum Frame:** Strong, rustproof aluminum frame with a wooden appearance, offering durability without the maintenance of real wood. Features 4.7 in. x 4.7 in. triangular stand poles for enhanced stability.
- **Water Gutter Design:** Professional drainage system directs water from the roof edge through the poles to the ground, preventing splashing and enhancing snow load capacity.
- **Zippered Curtains & Netting:** Includes 180G M2 polyester fabric curtains (CPAI-84 certified) and four-sided zippered mosquito netting for privacy and insect protection. Binding belts are included for securing layers.
- **Double Top and Hook Design:** Ventilated double-layer canopy allows airflow. Features two J-shaped hooks for lights and one U-shaped hook for fans.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Adherence to these safety guidelines is crucial for safe assembly and long-term enjoyment of your gazebo.

- Always assemble this gazebo on a flat, stable surface.
- Keep children and pets away from the gazebo during assembly or disassembly.
- Do not leave the gazebo unattended during high winds or heavy rain. Secure curtains and netting during adverse weather.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the roof to prevent damage or collapse.
- Be cautious of hot surfaces, especially the steel roof, after prolonged exposure to sunlight.
- Ensure all fasteners are tightened securely before and after assembly. Regularly check for loose connections.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly requires careful attention to detail and the cooperation of multiple individuals. It is recommended to have at least **4 people** for installation. A ladder and power drill will be helpful. The estimated assembly time is approximately 7-10 hours.

Tools Required:

- Hammer
- Screwdriver
- Ladder
- Electric Screw Driver
- Wrench
- Gloves

Assembly Steps Overview:

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully unpack all boxes and verify that all parts are present and undamaged against the provided parts list. Report any missing or damaged parts immediately.
2. **Assemble the Frame:** Construct the main aluminum frame, ensuring all connections are secure. The wooden-look posts are designed for stability.
3. **Install Roof Panels:** Attach the galvanized steel roof panels. Note that some panels may require careful alignment. The double-tier design allows for proper ventilation.
4. **Attach Curtains and Netting:** Install the dual-track system for the insect netting and privacy curtains. The netting and curtains feature zippers for easy closure.
5. **Secure to Ground:** Utilize the pre-drilled holes in the stand poles to anchor the gazebo to a concrete or hard wooden floor using suitable stakes or expansion screws. This is crucial for stability, especially in windy conditions.

Assembly Tip: Some users have found it helpful to use double-sided tape for roof 'triangle' parts to keep them together when sliding into the frame. Ensure all plastic protective films are removed from panels during

assembly.

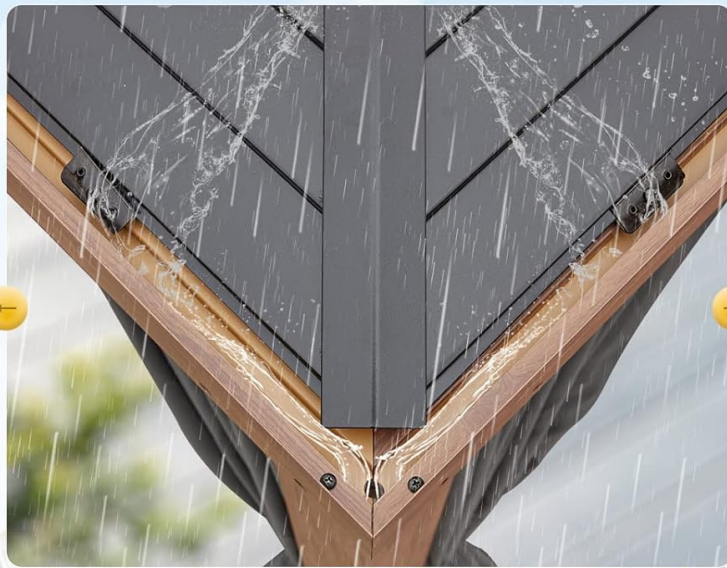
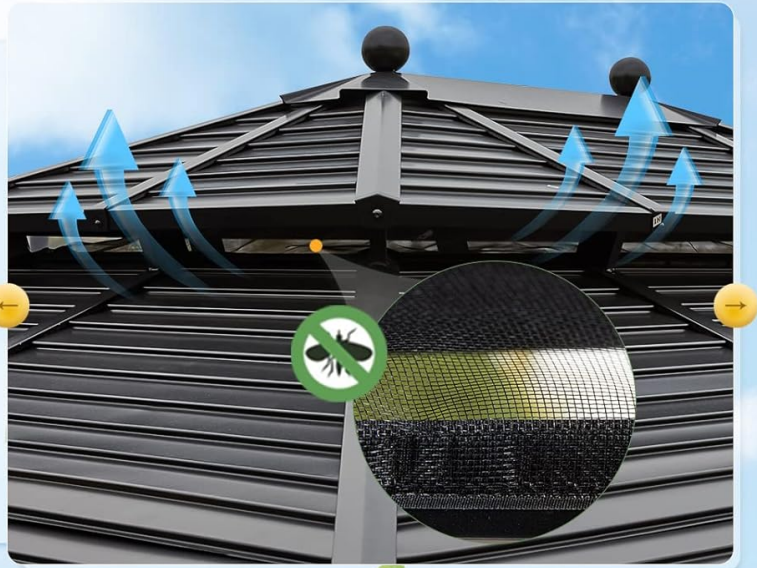

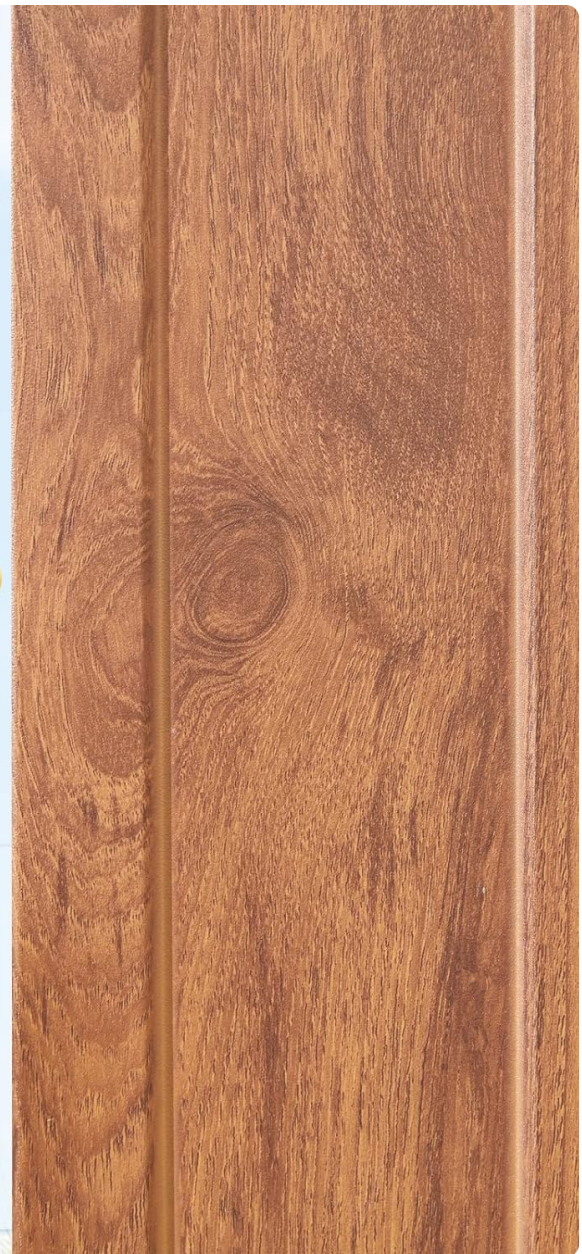


Figure 5: Construction of the wooden finish aluminum frame.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Curtains and Netting:

- The gazebo features a dual-track system allowing independent operation of the mosquito netting and privacy curtains.
- To close, simply pull the desired layer (netting or curtain) along its track and zip it securely.
- To open, unzip and use the provided binding belts to tie back the netting or curtains to the gazebo posts.
- During high winds, it is recommended to secure all curtains and netting to prevent damage.

Ceiling Hooks:

- The interior roof is equipped with two J-shaped hooks and one U-shaped hook. These are designed to

support lightweight items such as decorative lights, lanterns, or small fans.

- Ensure any hung items do not exceed the weight capacity of the hooks to prevent damage or injury.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the lifespan and preserve the appearance of your EROMMY gazebo.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the frame and roof panels with a mild soap solution and water. Rinse thoroughly and dry to prevent water spots. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Curtains and Netting:** The fabric is 180G M2 polyester. It can be spot cleaned with mild soap and water. For deeper cleaning, follow care instructions on the fabric tags. Ensure they are completely dry before storing or zipping up for extended periods to prevent mildew.
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Tighten any loose fasteners to maintain structural integrity.
- **Winter Care:** While the galvanized steel roof is designed for snow, it is advisable to clear heavy snow accumulation to prevent excessive stress on the structure. If possible, store curtains and netting indoors during winter months to prolong their life.
- **Drainage System:** Regularly inspect the water gutter system for blockages (leaves, debris) and clear them to ensure proper water flow.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Gazebo feels unstable or wobbly:** Ensure all ground anchors are properly installed and tightened. Verify that the gazebo is on a flat, level surface. Re-tighten all frame bolts and screws.
- **Water leakage from the roof:** Check that all roof panels are correctly installed and overlapping. Inspect the water gutter system for blockages and clear any debris.
- **Curtain or netting zippers are stuck or broken:** Apply a silicone-based lubricant to the zipper teeth. If a zipper is broken, contact customer support for replacement parts.
- **Curtains blow excessively in the wind:** Ensure curtains are properly secured with binding belts or fully zipped. Consider adding weights to the bottom hems of the curtains for added stability in windy conditions.
- **Difficulty during assembly:** Refer to the detailed assembly instructions. Ensure all parts are correctly identified. It is highly recommended to have 3-4 people for assembly, especially for the roof sections.
