1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This Drip Stop Assembly is a replacement spare part designed to prevent dripping from the coffee outlet of compatible Philips coffee machines. It ensures that coffee flow stops immediately after brewing, maintaining a clean brewing area.

Please note that this part is supplied as a spare part and does not include commercial packaging or a retail box. You will receive the part exactly as depicted in product images.

2. COMPATIBILITY

This Drip Stop Assembly (Part Number: 996500032687) is compatible with the following Philips coffee machine models:

- Philips HD7544
- Philips HD7546
- Philips HD7547
- Philips RI754

Before installation, verify your coffee machine's model number to ensure proper fit and function.

3. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully to install the new Drip Stop Assembly:

1. **Safety First:** Always unplug your Philips coffee machine from the power outlet before performing any maintenance or part replacement.
2. **Locate the Drip Stop:** Identify the existing drip stop mechanism, typically located at the bottom of the filter basket holder or within the coffee outlet area.

- 3. Remove the Old Drip Stop (if applicable):** Gently pull or unclip the old drip stop assembly. It may require a slight twist or firm pull depending on your specific machine model. Be careful not to damage surrounding components.

- 4. Install the New Drip Stop:** Align the new Drip Stop Assembly (996500032687) with the corresponding slot or attachment points. Push it firmly into place until it clicks or feels securely seated. Ensure it moves freely and correctly when tested manually.

- 5. Test Functionality:** After installation, plug the coffee machine back in. Perform a test run with water (without coffee) to ensure the drip stop functions correctly, preventing drips when the carafe is removed.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning of the Drip Stop Assembly is essential to maintain its effectiveness and prolong its lifespan.

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, rinse the drip stop assembly under warm running water to remove any coffee residue.
- **Weekly Cleaning:** For a more thorough clean, remove the drip stop assembly (refer to installation steps in Section 3) and wash it with mild dish soap and warm water. Use a small brush if necessary to remove stubborn residue. Rinse thoroughly to ensure no soap remains.
- **Drying:** Allow the assembly to air dry completely before re-installing it into the coffee machine.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Issue: Coffee machine still drips after installing the new drip stop.**

Solution:

- Ensure the drip stop assembly is correctly and fully seated in its position. Refer to Section 3 for installation steps.
- Check for any coffee grounds or debris lodged in the mechanism that might prevent it from closing completely. Clean thoroughly as per Section 4.
- Verify that the part is indeed compatible with your specific Philips coffee machine model.

- **Issue: The new drip stop assembly does not fit my coffee machine.**

Solution:

- Double-check your coffee machine's model number against the compatibility list in Section 2.
- Ensure you are attempting to install the part in the correct orientation and location.
