# PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Lenco LS-600WA is a belt-drive record player featuring a built-in amplifier and two external stereo speakers. It is equipped with a high-quality Audio-Technica AT-VM95E moving magnetic cartridge.

# **Key Components:**

- Platter: Supports the record during playback.
- Tonearm: Holds the cartridge and stylus.
- Cartridge (AT-VM95E): Converts groove vibrations into electrical signals.
- Counterweight: Balances the tonearm and adjusts tracking force.
- Anti-skating weight: Prevents the tonearm from drifting inwards.
- Speed Selector: Switches between 33 and 45 RPM.
- Dust Cover: Protects the platter and tonearm from dust.
- External Speakers: Provide stereo audio output.

### **SETUP INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Unpacking: Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
- 2. **Placement:** Place the record player on a stable, level surface away from direct sunlight, heat sources, or excessive vibration. Position the speakers on either side of the record player for optimal stereo separation.
- 3. Platter Installation: Place the platter onto the spindle.
- 4. Belt Installation: Locate the drive belt and carefully loop it around the motor pulley and the inner rim of the platter.
- 5. **Dust Cover:** Attach the dust cover to the hinges at the back of the record player.
- 6. Counterweight Adjustment:
  - Slide the counterweight onto the rear of the tonearm.
  - Balance the tonearm so it floats horizontally.
  - Rotate the counterweight to achieve the recommended tracking force (refer to cartridge specifications, typically 1.8g - 2.2g for AT-VM95E).
- 7. **Anti-skating Adjustment:** Attach the anti-skating weight to the tonearm's anti-skating post. The recommended setting usually matches the tracking force.
- 8. Speaker Connection: Connect the included external speakers to the speaker output terminals on the rear of the

record player using the provided speaker wires. Ensure correct polarity (+ to + and - to -).

9. Power Connection: Connect the mains adapter to the record player's power input and then plug it into a wall outlet.

### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Power On: Press the power button (usually combined with mode selection) to turn on the record player.
- 2. **Select Speed:** Choose the appropriate speed (33 or 45 RPM) using the speed selector button, matching the record you intend to play.
- 3. **Place Record:** Carefully place a record on the platter. If playing a 45 RPM single, use the included adapter if necessary.
- 4. **Lift Tonearm:** Use the tonearm lift lever to raise the tonearm.
- 5. **Position Tonearm:** Gently move the tonearm over the desired starting groove of the record.
- 6. **Lower Tonearm:** Slowly lower the tonearm using the lift lever. The stylus will descend onto the record, and playback will begin.

- 7. **Adjust Volume:** Use the volume control knob to adjust the audio output level from the speakers.
- 8. **Pause/Stop:** To pause playback, use the tonearm lift lever to raise the tonearm. To stop, lift the tonearm, return it to its rest, and power off the unit.




Image: Control panel for speed selection and volume.

## Cleaning the Stylus:

- Regularly clean the stylus using a soft brush designed for stylus cleaning. Brush gently from back to front.
- · Avoid touching the stylus with your fingers.

### Cleaning the Record Player:

- Wipe the dust cover and cabinet with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Keep the dust cover closed when not in use to prevent dust accumulation.

### **Record Care:**

- Handle records by their edges to avoid fingerprints.
- Store records vertically in their sleeves to prevent warping.
- Clean records with a dedicated record cleaning brush or solution.

### **T**ROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power adapter not connected; outlet not active.	Ensure power adapter is securely connected and the outlet is functional.
No sound	Speakers not connected; volume too low; stylus damaged.	Check speaker connections; increase volume; inspect stylus for damage.
Distorted sound	Dirty stylus; incorrect tracking force; damaged record.	Clean stylus; re-adjust tracking force; try a different record.
Skipping record	Incorrect tracking force; anti-skating not set; dirty/damaged record.	Adjust tracking force and anti-skating; clean record; check for scratches.
Incorrect speed	Wrong speed selected.	Select the correct speed (33 or 45 RPM) for the record.
