IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using the Houselife HL-01 Pet Grooming Vacuum Kit. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Ensure the power supply matches the voltage specified on the appliance.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- Keep the appliance away from water or other liquids. Do not immerse.
- This appliance is for pet grooming only. Do not use on humans or for other purposes.
- Supervise children and pets when the appliance is in use.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or performing maintenance.
- Do not block air vents during operation.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Houselife HL-01 is designed to provide a comprehensive and mess-free pet grooming experience. It features a powerful vacuum system to collect pet hair directly into a 2.5L dust cup, minimizing cleanup.

Main Unit Features:

- **Power Button:** Turns the unit on/off and adjusts suction levels.
- **Dust Cup:** 2.5L capacity for collected hair, with an easy-empty mechanism.
- **Hose Connection Port:** For attaching the flexible hose.
- **Air Vents:** Located on the sides/rear for motor cooling.

Grooming Tools:

- **Grooming Clippers:** For trimming pet hair to desired lengths. Includes multiple guide combs.
- **Deshedding Brush:** Effectively removes loose undercoat hair.
- **Slicker Brush:** Detangles and smooths the topcoat.
- **Crevice Nozzle:** For cleaning pet hair from furniture, carpets, or tight spaces.
- **Cleaning Brush:** For general cleanup of the unit and tools.

SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Connect Hose:** Insert one end of the flexible hose into the hose connection port on the main unit until it clicks securely into place.
3. **Attach Tool:** Select the desired grooming tool (e.g., deshedding brush) and attach it to the other end of the flexible hose. Ensure it is firmly seated.
4. **Power Connection:** Connect the power adapter to the main unit's power input port, then plug the adapter into a suitable electrical outlet.
5. **Preparation:** Ensure the dust cup is empty and properly secured before first use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

General Operation:

1. **Power On:** Press the power button on the main unit to turn it on. The unit will start at the lowest suction setting.
2. **Adjust Suction:** Press the power button repeatedly to cycle through the available suction levels (Low, Medium, High). Select the appropriate level for your pet's coat and comfort.
3. **Grooming:** Gently apply the chosen grooming tool to your pet's coat. The vacuum will automatically collect loose hair.
4. **Power Off:** After grooming, press the power button until the unit turns off. Unplug the power adapter.

Using Specific Tools:

- **Grooming Clippers:** Attach the desired guide comb for the desired hair length. Move the clippers smoothly against the direction of hair growth. Ensure the vacuum is on to collect trimmed hair.
- **Deshedding Brush:** Use gentle, long strokes in the direction of hair growth. This tool is effective for removing loose undercoat.
- **Slicker Brush:** Ideal for daily brushing to remove tangles and smooth the topcoat. Brush gently to avoid skin irritation.
- **Crevice Nozzle:** Detach any grooming tool and attach the crevice nozzle directly to the hose. Use it to vacuum pet hair from upholstery, car seats, or hard-to-reach areas.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your Houselife HL-01.

1. Emptying the Dust Cup:

- Ensure the unit is off and unplugged.
- Press the dust cup release button (usually located near the handle).
- Hold the dust cup over a trash bin and press the bottom release button to open the flap and empty the contents.
- Close the flap and reattach the dust cup to the main unit until it clicks.

2. Cleaning Filters:

- The unit contains multiple filters (e.g., HEPA filter, sponge filter). Refer to the filter compartment for location.
- Remove filters and gently tap them to dislodge accumulated dust and hair.
- If washable, rinse under cool running water. Ensure filters are completely dry before reinserting. Do not use detergents.
- Replace filters every 3-6 months, or as needed, depending on usage.

3. Cleaning Grooming Tools:

- After each use, remove any hair caught in the brushes or clippers. Use the provided cleaning brush.
- Wipe tools with a damp cloth if necessary. Do not immerse electronic components in water.
- For clippers, apply a small amount of clipper oil to the blades regularly to maintain sharpness and smooth operation.

4. **Storage:** Store the unit and accessories in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on.	No power supply; Power adapter not connected properly.	Ensure the power adapter is securely plugged into both the unit and the wall outlet. Check if the outlet is functional.
Low suction power.	Dust cup full; Filters clogged; Hose or tool blocked.	Empty the dust cup. Clean or replace filters. Check the hose and grooming tools for blockages and remove them.
Hair not being collected by vacuum during grooming.	Tool not properly attached; Suction too low; Blockage.	Ensure the grooming tool is securely attached to the hose. Increase suction power. Check for blockages in the tool or hose.
Unit is making unusual noise.	Blockage in hose or motor; Dust cup or filters improperly installed.	Turn off and unplug the unit. Check for and remove any blockages. Reinstall the dust cup and filters correctly. If the noise persists, contact customer support.
