1. INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your SOMMER Y7011V001 3-Button Wall Push Button Station. Please read this manual thoroughly before attempting to install or operate the device to ensure safe and efficient use. This wall station is designed for use with compatible SOMMER Synoris and Duo Vision garage door openers, including EVO+ and PRO+ models.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The SOMMER Y7011V001 is a wired wall-mounted control unit for garage door openers. It features three distinct buttons for various functions. Its compact design allows for convenient placement within your garage or home.

Key Features:

- Three-button interface for multiple control options.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation of the SOMMER Y7011V001 wall station typically involves connecting it to your compatible garage door opener's control terminals. It is recommended to consult your garage door opener's main instruction manual for specific wiring diagrams and safety precautions.

1. **Safety First:** Disconnect power to your garage door opener at the circuit breaker before beginning any installation work.
2. **Mounting Location:** Choose a convenient and safe location for the wall station, typically near the garage entry door, out of reach of small children (at least 5 feet from the floor).
3. **Wiring:** Run low-voltage wiring from the wall station's mounting location to the garage door opener unit. Connect the wires to the designated terminals on both the wall station and the garage door opener. Refer to your opener's manual for correct terminal identification. Ensure all connections are secure.
4. **Mounting:** Secure the wall station to the wall using appropriate screws and anchors (not included, as per "As Pictured" for included components).
5. **Restore Power:** Once installation is complete and all connections are verified, restore power to the garage door opener.
6. **Test Operation:** Test all functions of the wall station to ensure proper communication with the garage door opener.

If you are unsure about any part of the installation process, it is advisable to contact a qualified electrician or garage door technician.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The SOMMER Y7011V001 wall station provides convenient control over your garage door opener. The functions of the three buttons are typically as follows, though specific functionality may vary slightly based on your garage door opener model:

- **Main Button (Largest):** Press this button to open or close the garage door. If the door is in motion, pressing it again will stop the door.
- **Light Button (Symbol: Lightbulb):** Press this button to turn the garage door opener's light on or off. The light may also activate automatically when the door is operated.
- **Lock Button (Symbol: Padlock):** Press and hold this button to activate or deactivate the vacation lock feature. When activated, all remote controls will be disabled, preventing unauthorized access. The main button on the wall station will still function.

Always ensure the garage door path is clear before operating the door. Keep children and pets away from the moving door.

5. MAINTENANCE

The SOMMER Y7011V001 wall station requires minimal maintenance to ensure long-term performance.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically wipe the surface of the wall station with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and grime. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents, as these can damage the finish or internal components.
- **Connections:** Occasionally check the wiring connections at both the wall station and the garage door opener to ensure they remain secure.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Ensure the wall station is not exposed to excessive moisture or extreme temperatures, which could affect its operation.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your SOMMER Y7011V001 wall station, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wall station does not operate the garage door.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No power to the opener.• Loose or incorrect wiring.• Opener's vacation lock feature is active.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check circuit breaker for the garage door opener.• Verify all wiring connections are secure and correct according to the opener's manual.• Deactivate the vacation lock feature by pressing and holding the lock button on the wall station.
Light button does not turn on/off the opener light.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Light bulb is faulty or missing.• Wiring issue specific to the light function.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Replace the light bulb in the garage door opener.• Check wiring connections for the light function.
Remote controls are not working, but the wall station does.	Vacation lock feature is active.	Deactivate the vacation lock feature by pressing and holding the lock button on the wall station.
