YIYIBYUS A26 Rolling Garment Rack with 2-Tier Basket

Instruction Manual

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The YIYIBYUS A26 Rolling Garment Rack is a versatile storage solution designed for organizing clothes and accessories. It features a sturdy metal frame, a hanging rod, and two mesh baskets, all supported by omnidirectional wheels for easy mobility. Two of the wheels are lockable for stability.

Key Features:

- **Durable Construction:** Made from sturdy metal with a corrosion-free coating.
- **Two-Tier Storage Baskets:** Raised baskets for convenient storage of handbags, boxes, or folded items.
- **Mobile Design:** Equipped with four omnidirectional wheels, two of which are lockable for secure placement.
- **Multifunctional Use:** Combines a hanging rod with shelving for comprehensive garment and accessory organization.
- **Ample Space:** Provides hanging space for various clothing items including pants, shirts, coats, and dresses.

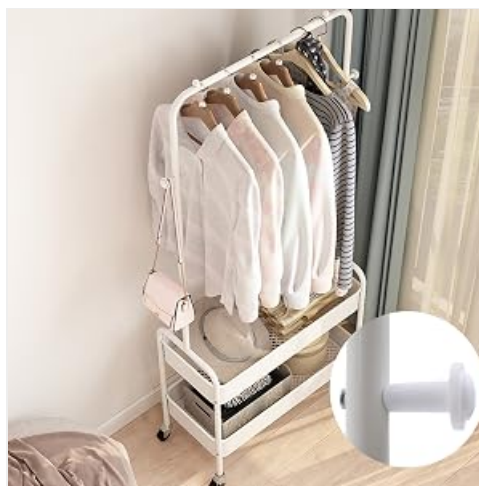


Image 1.1: Overview of the YIYIBYUS A26 Garment Rack highlighting its sturdy frame, easy rolling, flexible organization, and versatile design.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read all instructions carefully before assembly and use.
- Keep small parts away from children during assembly to prevent choking hazards.
- Ensure all connections are securely tightened before placing items on the rack.
- Do not overload the rack. Distribute weight evenly to maintain stability.
- Use the wheel locks when the rack is in a stationary position to prevent accidental movement.
- Avoid placing the rack on uneven surfaces.
- Do not climb on or hang from the rack.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all components listed below are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

- Main Frame Components (Vertical Poles, Horizontal Bars)
- Hanging Rod
- 2 x Mesh Storage Baskets
- 4 x Wheels (2 with locks)
- Side Hooks (if applicable)
- Assembly Hardware (Screws, Wrench)

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to assemble your YIYIBYUS A26 Garment Rack. It is recommended to assemble on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.

1. **Attach Wheels:** Insert the four wheels into the designated holes at the bottom of the main frame. Ensure two lockable wheels are positioned at the same end for easier access. Tighten securely with the provided wrench if necessary.

2. **Assemble Frame:** Connect the vertical poles to the base frame. Ensure they are firmly seated.
3. **Install Baskets:** Slide the two mesh storage baskets into their respective positions on the frame. Ensure they are level and securely attached.

4. **Attach Hanging Rod:** Secure the hanging rod to the top of the vertical poles. Ensure it is centered and stable.
5. **Install Side Hooks (Optional):** If included, attach the side hooks to the designated holes on the vertical poles.

6. **Final Check:** Verify that all parts are correctly assembled and all connections are tight.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Hanging Rod:

- Hang clothes such as shirts, jackets, dresses, and pants directly on the rod using hangers.
- Distribute the weight of clothing evenly across the rod to prevent tipping or bending.

Utilizing the Storage Baskets:

- The two mesh baskets are suitable for storing folded garments, shoes, handbags, storage boxes, or other accessories.
- Place heavier items on the bottom basket for better stability.

Moving and Securing the Rack:

- To move the rack, unlock the two lockable wheels by pushing their levers upwards.
- Gently push or pull the rack to its desired location.
- Once in position, lock the wheels by pushing their levers downwards to prevent unintended movement.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the metal frame and baskets with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as needed to maintain stability.
- **Wheel Care:** Keep the wheels free of dust and debris to ensure smooth rolling.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Rack is Unstable/Wobbly:

- Ensure all screws and connections are fully tightened.
- Verify that the rack is placed on a flat, level surface.
- Check if weight is evenly distributed on the hanging rod and baskets.

Wheels Not Rolling Smoothly:

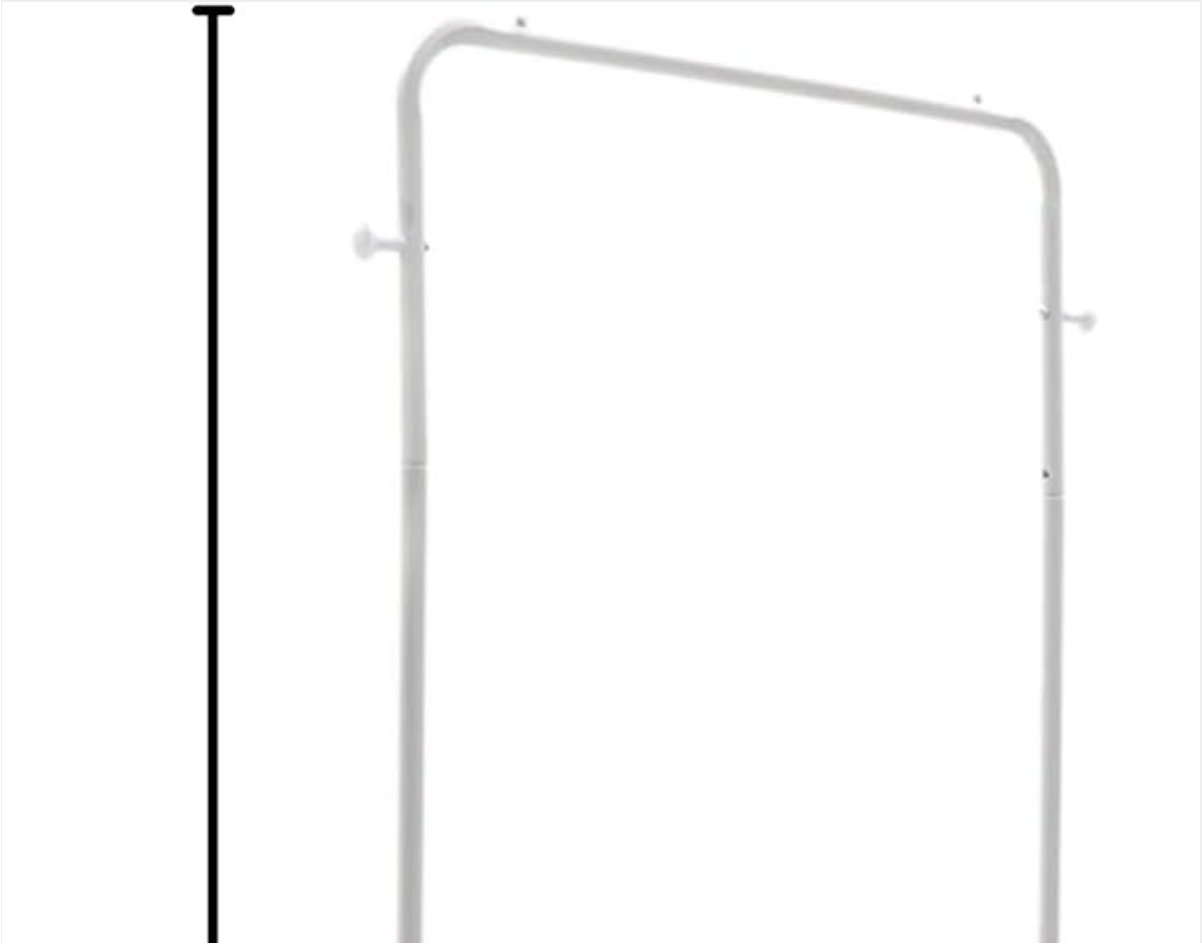
- Check if the wheel locks are disengaged (lever pushed upwards).
- Remove any hair, dust, or debris that may be caught in the wheel mechanisms.

Missing Parts:

- Refer to the "Package Contents" section and contact customer support if any parts are missing upon arrival.
