kalado KCA02 Air Purifier Filter Instruction Manual

Model: KCA02 | H13 True HEPA Filter

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The kalado KCA02 H13 True HEPA filter is designed for use with compatible kalado air purifiers. This high-efficiency filter captures fine particles, dust, pollen, pet dander, and other airborne pollutants, contributing to cleaner and fresher indoor air. It is recommended to replace the filter regularly to maintain optimal air purification performance.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to properly install your new kalado KCA02 filter:

- 1. Power Off:** Ensure your kalado air purifier is turned off and unplugged from the power outlet before beginning the installation process.

- Access Filter Compartment:** Locate and open the filter compartment cover on your air purifier. Refer to your air purifier's specific manual for instructions on how to access the filter compartment.
- Remove Old Filter:** Carefully remove the used filter. It may be dusty, so handle it with care to avoid spreading trapped particles. Dispose of the old filter according to local regulations.
- Unpack New Filter:** Remove the new kalado KCA02 H13 True HEPA filter from its protective plastic packaging. *Do not operate the air purifier with the filter still in its plastic bag.*
- Insert New Filter:** Insert the new filter into the compartment, ensuring it is oriented correctly. There may be an arrow or specific alignment guides. Gently push until it is securely in place.
- Close Compartment:** Close the filter compartment cover securely.
- Power On:** Plug the air purifier back into the power outlet and turn it on.
- Reset Filter Indicator (if applicable):** If your air purifier has a filter replacement indicator, follow the instructions in your air purifier's manual to reset it.

OPERATING CONSIDERATIONS

Once installed, the kalado KCA02 filter operates as part of your air purifier system. No direct operation of the filter itself is required. Ensure your air purifier is running according to its own operational guidelines for optimal air filtration.

- For best results, operate your air purifier continuously in areas where air quality improvement is desired.
- Keep the air purifier away from walls or furniture that might obstruct airflow.
- Ensure the air purifier's intake and output vents are clear of obstructions.

MAINTENANCE

The kalado KCA02 H13 True HEPA filter is a disposable component and cannot be washed or cleaned. Regular replacement is crucial for maintaining air purifier efficiency.

- **Filter Lifespan:** The typical lifespan of the KCA02 filter is 6-8 months, depending on air quality and usage frequency. In environments with higher pollution levels or continuous use, more frequent replacement may be necessary.
- **Replacement Indicator:** Many kalado air purifiers feature a filter replacement indicator light. Replace the filter when this indicator illuminates.
- **Visual Inspection:** Even without an indicator, visually inspect the filter periodically. If the filter appears heavily discolored or clogged with dust and debris, it is time for replacement.
- **Odor:** If you notice a persistent stale or musty odor coming from the air purifier, it may indicate that the filter needs to be replaced.

To purchase replacement filters, search for "kalado KCA02 filter" or refer to the product page where you purchased your air purifier.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If your air purifier is not performing as expected after filter replacement, consider the following:

- **Airflow Reduced:**
 - Ensure the new filter is fully unwrapped from its plastic packaging.
 - Verify the filter is installed correctly and securely in its compartment.
 - Check for any obstructions around the air purifier's intake or output vents.

- **Filter Indicator Still On:**

- Refer to your air purifier's manual for specific instructions on how to reset the filter replacement indicator after installing a new filter. This often involves pressing and holding a button for a few seconds.

- **Unusual Odor:**

- Ensure the filter is genuine kalado KCA02 and not a counterfeit.
- Verify the filter was removed from all packaging before installation.
- If the odor persists, contact kalado customer support or the retailer.

For issues not related to the filter, consult your kalado air purifier's main instruction manual or contact kalado customer support.
