INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Califone BH-202 Bluetooth Wireless Headset. This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your new headset. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of the product.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not expose the headset to extreme temperatures, humidity, or liquids.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the headset to strong impacts.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the headset. This will void the warranty.
- Clean the headset with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- Listen at moderate volume levels to prevent hearing damage.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Califone BH-202 is a versatile over-ear headset designed for both wireless Bluetooth and wired audio connections. It features comfortable ear cushions, an adjustable headband, and intuitive on-ear controls.

Controls and Indicators

The headset features user-friendly buttons and an LED indicator on the ear cups for easy control and status updates.

- **Power Button:** Used to turn the headset on/off and initiate Bluetooth pairing.
- **Volume Up/Next Track Button:** Press briefly to increase volume; press and hold to skip to the next track.
- **Volume Down/Previous Track Button:** Press briefly to decrease volume; press and hold to go to the previous track.
- **Multi-function Button (Play/Pause/Call):** Press briefly to play/pause audio or answer/end calls. Press and hold to reject an incoming call.
- **LED Indicator:** Displays charging status (red for charging, off when fully charged) and Bluetooth pairing status (flashing blue/red for pairing mode, slow blue flash for connected).
- **Micro-USB Port:** For charging the headset.
- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** For wired connection using the Aux-T cable.
- **Microphone:** Integrated for hands-free calls.

SETUP

1. Charging the Headset

Before first use, fully charge the headset.

1. Connect the micro-USB charging cable to the micro-USB port on the headset.
2. Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter).
3. The LED indicator will glow **red** during charging.
4. The LED indicator will turn **off** once charging is complete.

2. Bluetooth Pairing

To connect the headset wirelessly to your device:

1. Ensure the headset is turned off.
2. Press and hold the **Power Button** for approximately 5-7 seconds until the LED indicator flashes **blue and red** alternately. This indicates pairing mode.
3. On your Bluetooth-enabled device (smartphone, tablet, computer), go to the Bluetooth settings and enable Bluetooth.
4. Search for available devices. Select "**Califone BH-202**" from the list.
5. Once paired, the LED indicator will flash **blue slowly**. You will also hear an audible confirmation.
6. If prompted for a password, enter "0000".

3. Wired Connection (Aux-T Cable)

For devices without Bluetooth or when battery is low, use the provided 3.5mm Aux-T cable.

1. Plug one end of the 3.5mm Aux-T cable into the 3.5mm audio jack on the headset.
2. Plug the other end of the cable into the audio output jack of your device.
3. The headset will automatically switch to wired mode. Bluetooth functionality will be disabled.
4. Note: Volume control may be managed by the connected device or via the cord volume control if present on the Aux-T cable.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the **Power Button** for approximately 3 seconds until the LED flashes blue and you hear a power-on tone.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the **Power Button** for approximately 3 seconds until the LED flashes red and you hear a power-off tone.

Volume Control

- **Increase Volume:** Press the **Volume Up Button** briefly.
- **Decrease Volume:** Press the **Volume Down Button** briefly.

Playback Control (Bluetooth Mode)

- **Play/Pause:** Press the **Multi-function Button** briefly.

- **Next Track:** Press and hold the **Volume Up Button**.
- **Previous Track:** Press and hold the **Volume Down Button**.

Call Management (Bluetooth Mode)

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the **Multi-function Button** briefly during an incoming call or to end an active call.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the **Multi-function Button** for approximately 2 seconds during an incoming call.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-press the **Multi-function Button**.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the headset with a soft, slightly damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the headset regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headset does not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headset fully using the micro-USB cable.
Cannot pair with Bluetooth device.	Headset not in pairing mode; device's Bluetooth is off; too far from device.	Ensure headset is in pairing mode (flashing blue/red LED). Turn on Bluetooth on your device. Move headset closer to device (within 10 meters).
No sound in Bluetooth mode.	Volume too low; headset not connected; incorrect audio output selected on device.	Increase headset and device volume. Re-pair the headset. Check device's audio output settings.
No sound in wired mode.	Cable not fully inserted; incorrect audio output selected on device; faulty cable.	Ensure 3.5mm cable is fully inserted into both headset and device. Check device's audio output settings. Try a different 3.5mm cable if available.
Microphone not working.	Incorrect input device selected on computer/device; microphone muted.	Check audio input settings on your connected device. Ensure microphone is not muted in software.
