1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using your Bedsure GentleSoft Heated Blanket Electric Throw. Retain this manual for future reference.

- Do not use with infants, children, incapacitated individuals, or persons insensitive to heat.
- Do not use if the blanket is wet.
- Do not use with pets.
- Avoid sharp folds in the blanket; this can damage the heating elements.
- Always unplug the blanket when not in use.
- Do not use pins or other metallic objects with this blanket.
- This blanket is designed for standard 120V AC wall outlets at 60Hz.
- The blanket features a default 3-hour auto shut-off for overheat protection.
- Only use the provided controller with this blanket. Using other controllers may cause damage or safety hazards.

The Bedsure GentleSoft Heated Blanket is ETL and FCC certified, ensuring safer performance through rigorous testing.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Bedsure GentleSoft Heated Blanket Electric Throw provides customizable warmth with its soft ribbed flannel and sherpa construction.

Components

- 1 x Bedsure GentleSoft Heated Blanket (50" x 60" for Throw size)
- 1 x Digital Controller with power cord

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Unpack the Blanket:** Carefully remove the heated blanket and controller from its packaging. Inspect for any signs of damage.
2. **Position the Blanket:** Lay the blanket flat on a bed, sofa, or other desired surface. Ensure there are no wrinkles or folds that could concentrate heat.
3. **Connect the Controller:** Locate the connector on the blanket and the corresponding plug on the controller cord. Firmly push the controller plug into the blanket connector until it clicks securely into place.
4. **Plug into Power:** Plug the power cord from the controller into a standard 120V AC, 60Hz wall outlet.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The digital controller allows you to customize your warmth experience.

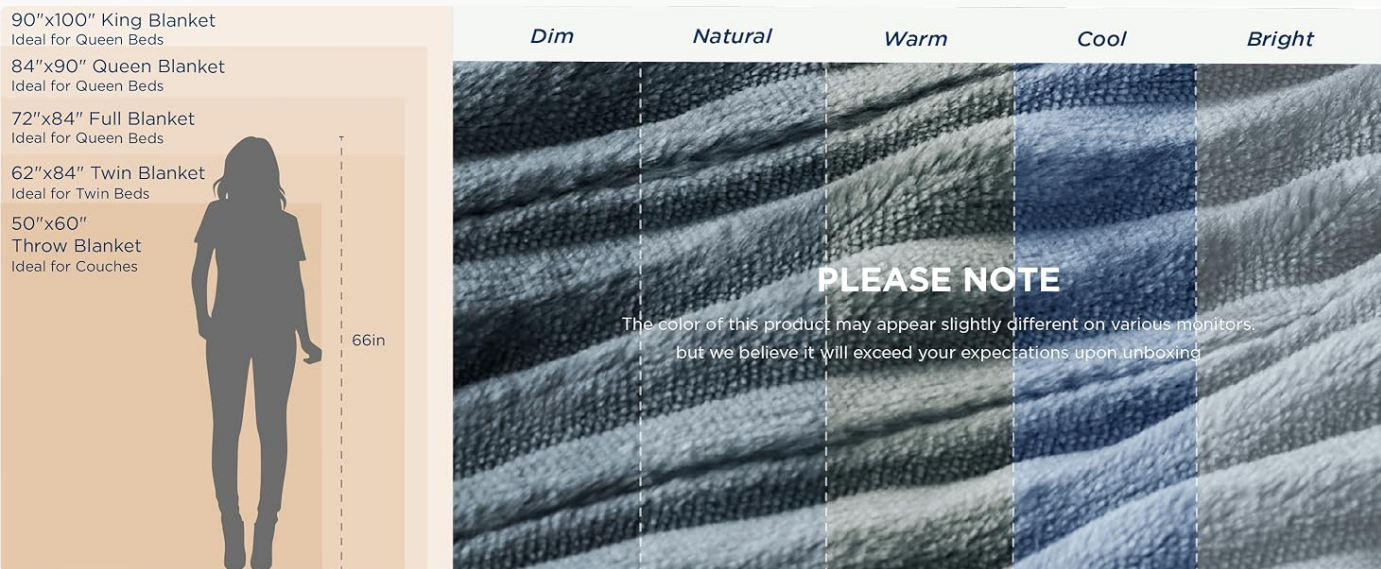


Image: A detailed view of the Bedsure digital controller, highlighting buttons for power, heat level adjustment (6 levels), and timer settings (4 options).

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the power button (**O/I**) to turn the blanket on or off. The digital display will illuminate when on.
2. **Adjust Heat Level:** Use the "+" and "-" buttons to select your desired heat level from 1 to 6. Level 1 is the lowest heat, and Level 6 is the highest.
3. **Set Timer:** Press the timer button (**Clock icon**) to cycle through the available time settings. The blanket offers 4 time settings, with a default auto shut-off after 3 hours.

The blanket is designed for fast and consistent heating, reaching desired temperatures efficiently.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your heated blanket.

Washing Instructions

1. **Disconnect:** Always disconnect the controller from the blanket and unplug the power cord from the wall outlet before cleaning.
2. **Machine Wash:** The blanket is machine washable. Use a gentle cycle with cold water. Do not bleach.
3. **Drying:** Tumble dry on low heat or air dry. Ensure the blanket is completely dry before reconnecting the controller and using it again. Avoid ironing.

The blanket uses a unique dyeing technique to prevent fading during washing.

Storage

When storing the blanket, avoid tight folding or creasing, as this can damage the internal heating wires. Store it loosely folded in a cool, dry place.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Bedsure GentleSoft Heated Blanket, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Blanket does not heat.	Power cord not securely plugged in. Controller not connected properly. Wall outlet not functioning.	Ensure all connections are firm. Test the outlet with another device.
Blanket heats unevenly.	Blanket is folded or bunched. Damaged heating wire.	Lay the blanket flat and smooth out any folds. If the issue persists, discontinue use and contact customer support.
Controller display is off or flashing.	Power interruption. Internal error.	Unplug the blanket from the wall outlet for 5 minutes, then plug it back in. If the issue continues, contact customer support.
