Its robust construction features a strong rubberized exterior and reinforced grommets to ensure durability and prevent fraying, making it suitable for daily use and travel.



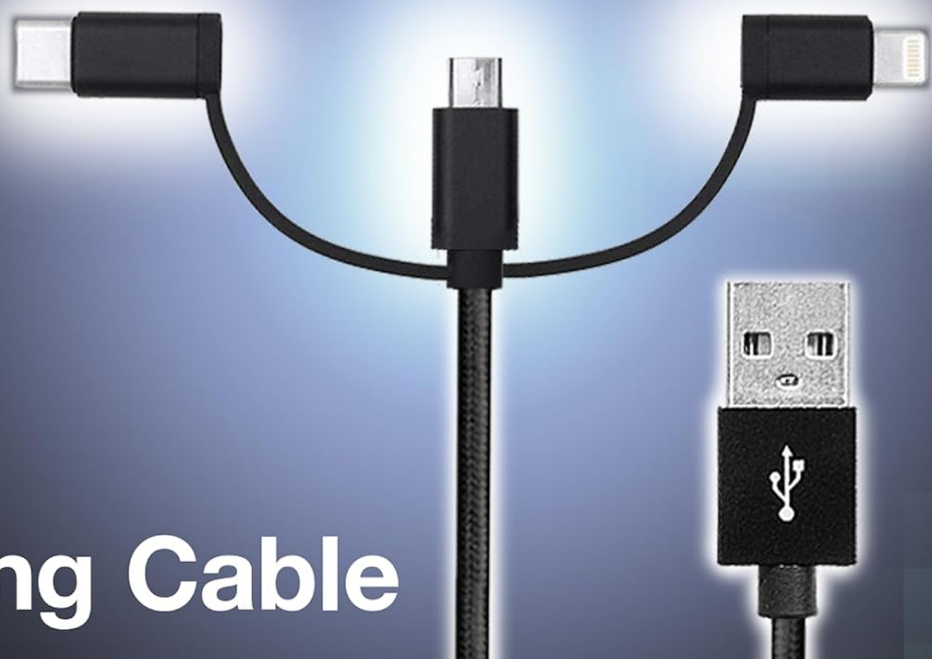

2. GETTING STARTED

- **Handling:** Always grasp the connector head when plugging or unplugging the cable, rather than pulling on the cable

itself. This prevents strain on the connection points.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your AllCharge 3-in-1 Cable, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device not charging	Incorrect connector used, loose connection, faulty power source, dirty port.	Ensure the correct connector is fully inserted. Try a different USB port or power adapter. Clean the device's charging port carefully.
Slow charging speed	Low-power USB port, device drawing high power, background apps.	Use a higher-wattage power adapter. Close unnecessary applications on your device.
Data transfer not working	Loose connection, device settings, incompatible port.	Ensure the cable is securely connected to both the device and computer. Check your device's USB connection settings (e.g., 'File Transfer' mode). Try a different USB port on your computer.
Cable appears damaged	Physical stress, wear and tear.	Discontinue use immediately to prevent potential damage to your devices. Replace the cable.
