1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the GDLF Outdoor Storage Cabinet. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new storage solution. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

This outdoor storage cabinet is designed to provide a reliable and durable solution for organizing your gardening tools, outdoor equipment, and other essentials. Its robust construction ensures protection against various weather conditions.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always follow all assembly instructions carefully.
- Ensure all parts are securely fastened before use.
- Do not overload the shelves or the cabinet. Refer to specifications for weight limits.
- Keep children and pets away from the assembly area.
- Use appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) during assembly, such as gloves.
- Place the cabinet on a level, stable surface to prevent tipping.
- The door features a lockable handle (lock not included). For security, it is recommended to use a padlock.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

- Cabinet Panels (Sides, Back, Doors, Top, Bottom)
- Internal Shelving Components
- Hardware (Screws, Hinges, Handles, Latches)
- Adjustable Feet
- Instruction Manual

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the GDLF Outdoor Storage Cabinet is designed to be straightforward with pre-drilled panels and an optimized design. It is recommended to have at least two people for assembly.

4.1. Preparation

1. Choose a clear, flat, and stable area for assembly.
2. Unpack all components and lay them out, checking against the package contents list.
3. Gather necessary tools: Phillips head screwdriver (cordless recommended), hammer, measuring tape.

4.2. Assembly Steps

1. **Assemble the Base:** Connect the bottom panels and side frames. Ensure all connections are secure.
2. **Attach Side Panels:** Securely attach the pre-drilled side panels to the base and frame.
3. **Install Back Panels:** Fasten the back panels to the assembled frame.
4. **Install Internal Shelving:** The left side of the cabinet features a shelving configuration. Install the shelves according to the pre-drilled holes. The right side is designed for taller items.
5. **Attach Doors:** Mount the doors using the provided hinges. Ensure they swing freely and align properly.
6. **Install Handles and Latch:** Attach the door handles and the deadbolt latch mechanism. Note that a padlock for the latch is not included.
7. **Secure the Roof:** Place and secure the waterproof roof panel.
8. **Adjust Feet:** The cabinet features height-adjustable feet. Adjust them to ensure the cabinet is level and stable on uneven surfaces.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The GDLF Outdoor Storage Cabinet is designed for versatile storage of various outdoor items.

5.1. Storage Capacity

- The **right side** of the cabinet is specifically designed for storing long-handled tools such as shovels, rakes,

and brooms.

- The **left side** features multiple shelves, ideal for smaller items like gardening gloves, hand tools, plant pots, and fertilizers.

5.2. Security

The cabinet doors are equipped with a deadbolt latch mechanism. For enhanced security, a padlock (not included) can be used to lock the doors, preventing unauthorized access and keeping your tools safe.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help preserve the appearance and extend the lifespan of your GDLF Outdoor Storage Cabinet.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the exterior and interior surfaces with a damp cloth and mild soap as needed. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could damage the wood or metal finish.
- **Wood Care:** The cabinet is made from fir wood. While treated for outdoor use, periodic application of a wood sealant or stain can further protect it from weathering and maintain its appearance.
- **Metal Components:** The black metal parts are rust-resistant iron. Inspect hinges and latches periodically for any signs of wear or rust. Lubricate moving parts if necessary.
- **Waterproof Roof:** The roof is designed to be waterproof. Ensure it remains free of debris (leaves, snow) to allow for proper water runoff.
- **Seasonal Checks:** Before and after periods of extreme weather (e.g., heavy rain, snow, prolonged sun),

inspect the cabinet for any signs of damage or loosening of fasteners. Tighten screws as required.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your GDLF Outdoor Storage Cabinet, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Doors do not close properly:**
 - Check if the cabinet is on a level surface. Adjust the height-adjustable feet as needed.
 - Inspect hinges for proper alignment and tightness. Adjust or tighten screws if loose.
 - Ensure no items inside the cabinet are obstructing the doors.
- **Cabinet feels unstable:**
 - Verify the cabinet is placed on a firm, level ground.
 - Adjust the height-adjustable feet to stabilize the unit.
 - Check all assembly screws and fasteners to ensure they are tight.
- **Water leakage:**
 - Ensure the roof is properly installed and sealed.
 - Check for any cracks or gaps in the panels. Apply appropriate sealant if necessary.
 - Confirm the cabinet is not leaning, which could affect water runoff.
