INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the TECHSHARE Ice Cube Trays with Lid and Bin. This product is designed to provide a convenient and efficient way to make and store ice cubes for various beverages. Crafted from BPA-free, non-toxic, and odorless materials, these trays ensure safe and reusable ice production. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use to ensure proper setup and operation.

1. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all items from the packaging. Verify that you have two ice cube trays, one lid with an integrated press plate, one storage bin, and one ice scoop.
- 2. Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash all components (ice trays, lid, bin, and scoop) thoroughly by hand with warm water and mild dish soap. Rinse completely and allow to air dry. **Do NOT use a dishwasher for cleaning.**
- 3. Assembly:** The product comes pre-assembled. No additional assembly is required.

2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Fill Ice Trays:** Fill each ice cube tray with water up to the indicated water level line. Avoid overfilling to prevent cubes from sticking together.
2. **Place in Freezer:** Carefully place the filled ice trays into your freezer. For best results, ensure they are placed on a flat surface.
3. **Freezing Time:** Allow approximately 4 hours for the ice cubes to freeze completely. Freezing time may vary depending on your freezer's temperature.
4. **Release Ice Cubes:**
 - Place a frozen ice tray upside down onto the storage bin.
 - Align the lid (with the press plate facing down) over the inverted ice tray.
 - Gently press down on the lid. The spikes on the press plate will push the ice cubes out of the silicone bottom of the tray and into the storage bin below.
5. **Store Ice:** Once released, the ice cubes will collect in the storage bin. Use the provided scoop to serve. The lid can be placed on the storage bin to keep ice fresh and prevent freezer odors.

3. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Hand wash all components with warm water and mild soap after each use or as needed. Rinse thoroughly to remove any soap residue.

- **Drying:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before storing or refilling to prevent ice from sticking and to maintain hygiene.
- **Storage:** The ice trays and bin are designed to be stackable, allowing for efficient storage in your freezer or cabinet when not in use.
- **Important:** Do not use abrasive cleaners or scrubbers, as these can damage the surfaces. This product is not dishwasher safe.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution

Ice cubes are difficult to release.	• Trays were overfilled. • Not enough pressure applied to the lid. • Ice is not fully frozen.	• Ensure water is filled only to the indicated line. • Apply firm, even pressure to the lid's press plate. • Allow more time for freezing (e.g., 4+ hours).
Ice cubes have an unusual taste or odor.	• Incomplete initial cleaning. • Absorption of freezer odors.	• Thoroughly wash all components with warm soapy water and rinse well before first use. • Ensure the storage bin is covered with the lid to protect ice from freezer odors.
Ice takes too long to freeze.	• Freezer temperature is too high. • Trays are placed in a warm spot in the freezer.	• Check and adjust your freezer's temperature setting. • Place trays in the coldest part of the freezer.

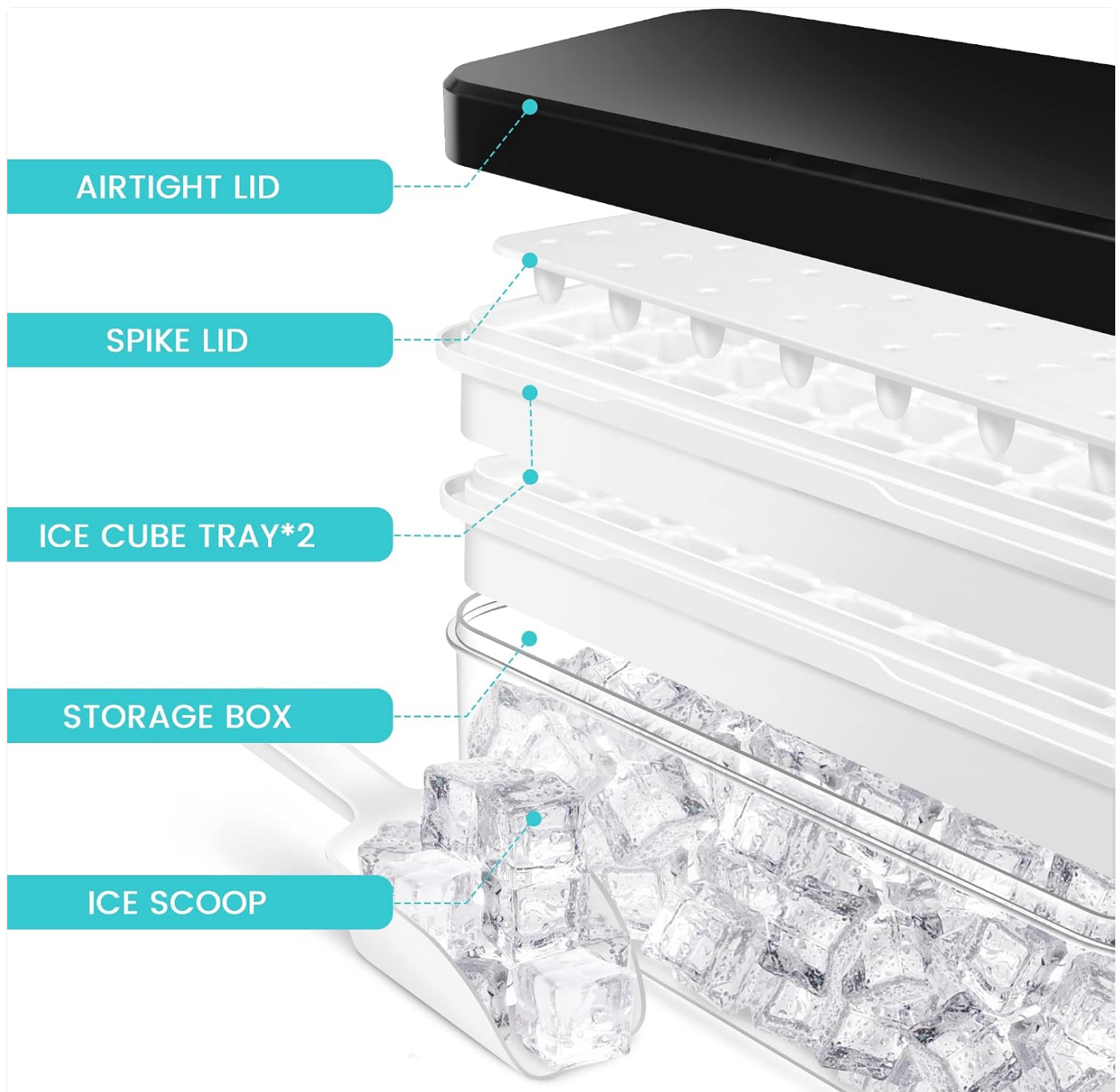


Image: An exploded diagram showing the individual components: airtight lid, spike lid (press plate), two ice cube trays, storage box, and ice scoop.
