INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the HOMIDEC 12-Cube Closet Organizer. This modular storage system is designed to provide a flexible and efficient solution for organizing various items in your home. Please read this manual carefully before assembly and use to ensure proper installation and safe operation.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not exceed 15 lbs (6.8 kg) per cube to prevent structural damage or collapse.
- Ensure proper assembly and stability by locking all sheets into the deepest layer of the connectors.
- Follow all assembly instructions carefully.
- Keep small parts away from children and pets during assembly.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly:

- Polyethylene plastic sheets (11.8" x 11.8" x 11.8" / 30 x 30 x 30cm)
- Sturdy metal frames (integrated within sheets)
- ABS resin connectors
- Cable zip ties (for added security)
- Assembly instructions

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The HOMIDEC 12-Cube Closet Organizer features a simple modular structure for easy assembly without the need for additional tools. Follow these steps:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all plastic sheets, connectors, and accessories from the packaging.
2. **Connect Panels:** Insert the edges of the plastic sheets into the slots of the ABS resin connectors. Ensure each sheet is pushed firmly into the deepest part of the connector for maximum stability. You may use the provided small hammer to gently tap the panels into place if needed.
3. **Build Layers:** Construct the organizer layer by layer, ensuring all connections are secure before proceeding to the next level.
4. **Customize Configuration:** The modular design allows you to build various shapes and sizes. You can arrange the 12 cubes in a 3x4, 4x3, or other custom configurations to fit your space.
5. **Enhance Stability:** For increased stability, use the included cable zip ties to secure adjacent panels, especially at the corners.
6. **Attach Elevated Feet:** If desired, attach the elevated foot connectors to the bottom cubes for improved stability and to lift the unit off the floor.

Not only a closet, but also a storage bin for garment racks and wardrobes, which greatly saves your space.



MAINTENANCE

To maintain the appearance and longevity of your HOMIDEC 12-Cube Closet Organizer:

- **Cleaning:** The polyethylene plastic sheets are waterproof and dust-proof. Wipe with a dry cloth to remove dust and light dirt. For tougher stains, use a damp cloth with mild soap and water, then dry thoroughly.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all connectors to ensure they remain securely locked. Re-secure any loose connections to maintain stability.
- **Weight Distribution:** Always distribute weight evenly across the cubes and adhere to the maximum weight limit per cube.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your organizer, consider the following:

- **Instability:** Ensure all panels are fully inserted into the connectors. Use the provided hammer to tap connections firmly. Add cable ties for extra reinforcement.
- **Damaged Panels/Connectors:** If any part is damaged, discontinue use and contact customer support for replacement parts.
- **Overloading:** Verify that no single cube exceeds the 15 lbs weight limit. Redistribute items if necessary.
