## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

---

Operating a motorcycle requires skill and adherence to safety guidelines. This HHH GTX 250 EFI motorcycle is designed for adult use. Always wear appropriate safety gear, including a helmet, eye protection, gloves, and protective clothing. Familiarize yourself with local traffic laws and regulations before riding.

- Always perform a pre-ride inspection.
- Do not operate the motorcycle under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Ensure proper tire pressure and brake function before each ride.

## 3. SETUP AND INITIAL ASSEMBLY

---

Your HHH GTX 250 EFI motorcycle requires some assembly upon arrival. It is factory packaged to ensure safe transport. Carefully unpack all components and refer to the included assembly guide for detailed instructions. Professional assembly is recommended if you are unfamiliar with motorcycle mechanics.

### 3.1. Unpacking and Inspection

1. Carefully remove the motorcycle from its shipping crate.
2. Inspect all parts for any signs of damage during transit. Report any damage immediately to the carrier and seller.
3. Verify all components listed in the "What's in the Box" section are present.

### 3.2. Basic Assembly Steps (General)

- Install the front wheel and fender.
- Attach the handlebars and mirrors.
- Connect the battery (if not pre-installed).
- Check and fill all fluid levels (engine oil, brake fluid, coolant).

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 4.1. Engine and Fuel System

The HHH GTX 250 EFI is equipped with a 223cc engine featuring Electronic Fuel Injection (EFI). The EFI system, managed by an Engine Control Unit (ECU), optimizes fuel delivery for efficient performance and fuel economy. This system continuously adjusts based on sensor data to ensure optimal engine operation.

## 4.2. Transmission

This motorcycle features a 6-speed manual transmission. Proper use of the clutch and gear shifter is crucial for smooth operation and to maximize fuel efficiency, especially at higher speeds.

## 4.3. Tires and Braking

The motorcycle is fitted with 17-inch front and rear tires, designed for stability and traction. Regularly check tire pressure and tread depth. The braking system consists of disc brakes on both front and rear wheels. Ensure brake fluid levels are correct and brake pads are not excessively worn.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity and safe operation of your HHH GTX 250 EFI motorcycle. Adhere to the maintenance schedule outlined in the separate service manual (if provided) or consult a qualified technician.

- **Engine Oil:** Check oil level regularly and change according to manufacturer recommendations.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine will not start	Low fuel, dead battery, faulty spark plug, kill switch engaged.	Check fuel level, charge/replace battery, inspect spark plug, ensure kill switch is off.
Engine stalls frequently	Idle speed too low, fuel system issue, air filter clogged.	Adjust idle speed, check fuel lines/filter, clean/replace air filter.
Poor braking performance	Worn brake pads, low brake fluid, air in brake lines.	Inspect/replace brake pads, check/refill brake fluid, bleed brake lines.
