## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Lifewit 3-Tier Bar Cart. ## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure safe use of your Lifewit Bar Cart, please observe the following precautions:

- Use caution when moving the cart on uneven surfaces to prevent tipping.
- Always secure the cart using the lockable wheels when not in use, especially if it contains fragile items.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 7.4 kg (16.3 lbs) on the top shelf to prevent damage or injury.
- Ensure all components are securely fastened during assembly and periodically check for tightness.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

The Lifewit Bar Cart features a robust design with three tiers, integrated wine racks, and glass holders, all supported by a durable metal frame and rustic brown particle board shelves.

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Lifewit Bar Cart is designed to be straightforward. All necessary tools and detailed instructions are included in the package. Please follow the steps below carefully.

## Before You Begin:

- Unpack all components and verify against the parts list provided in your instruction manual.
- Ensure you have enough clear space for assembly.
- Keep small parts out of reach of children.

## Assembly Steps:

1. Attach the wheels to the bottom frame. Ensure the two lockable wheels are positioned as desired for easy access.
2. Assemble the main metal frame structure according to the provided diagrams, securing all screws loosely at first.
3. Insert the bottom shelf into the designated slots on the frame.
4. Install the second tier, which includes the wine bottle racks.
5. Attach the top shelf, ensuring the glass holders are correctly oriented.
6. Once all components are in place, tighten all screws securely. Do not overtighten.
7. Verify the cart is stable and all parts are properly aligned.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Your Lifewit Bar Cart is designed for versatile use in various home environments. Here's how to best utilize its features:

### Mobility and Stability:

- To move the cart, unlock the two braked wheels by flipping the lever to the "OFF" position. Use the side handle for easy maneuvering.
- To secure the cart in place, flip the levers on the two braked wheels to the "ON" position. This will prevent the cart from rolling.

## Storage and Organization:

- **Top Shelf:** Ideal for serving drinks, holding barware, or displaying decorative items. Remember the weight limit of 7.4 kg (16.3 lbs).
- **Second Tier Wine Rack:** Designed to securely hold up to 6 standard wine bottles.
- **Glass Holders:** Utilize the four rows beneath the top shelf to hang 12-16 wine glasses, keeping them easily accessible and safe.
- **Bottom Shelf:** Provides ample space for additional bottles, ice buckets, shakers, or other larger bar accessories. The integrated fences help keep items secure during movement.

## MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life and maintain the appearance of your Lifewit Bar Cart.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a dry cloth. For spills, use a slightly damp cloth and dry immediately. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary.
- **Avoid Moisture:** Do not expose the cart to excessive moisture or direct sunlight for prolonged periods, as this may damage the wood finish.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bar cart, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cart is wobbly or unstable.	Screws are loose; uneven floor surface.	Ensure all assembly screws are tightened. Move the cart to a level surface. Engage wheel brakes.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wheels do not roll smoothly.	Brakes are engaged; debris in wheels.	Disengage wheel brakes. Check wheels for any trapped debris and clean if necessary.
Parts do not fit during assembly.	Incorrect orientation; manufacturing variance.	Double-check the assembly instructions and diagrams for correct part orientation. Do not force parts. If a part is genuinely defective, contact customer support for a replacement.
Top shelf appears to sag or is damaged.	Exceeded weight capacity.	Ensure the weight on the top shelf does not exceed 7.4 kg (16.3 lbs). Distribute weight evenly.


