1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your MARVO M726W Wireless Mouse. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- MARVO M726W Wireless Mouse
- USB Receiver
- User Manual (this document)
- *Note: Batteries are not included and must be purchased separately.*

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

3.1. Battery Installation

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the mouse.

2. Open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert the required batteries (e.g., AA or AAA, refer to the compartment label) ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

3.2. Connecting the USB Receiver

1. Remove the USB receiver from its storage slot, usually located near the battery compartment.
2. Plug the USB receiver into an available USB port on your computer (PC or Laptop).
3. Your computer should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. This may take a few moments.
4. Turn on the mouse using the power switch, typically found on the underside.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Basic Functions

- **Left Click:** Primary selection and activation.
- **Right Click:** Accesses contextual menus.
- **Scroll Wheel:** Scrolls through documents and web pages. Can also function as a middle click.

4.2. DPI Adjustment

The MARVO M726W mouse supports multiple DPI (Dots Per Inch) settings, up to 4000 DPI, allowing you to adjust cursor sensitivity. If your mouse has a dedicated DPI button (often located behind the scroll wheel), press it to cycle through available DPI settings. The RGB lighting may change to indicate the current DPI level.

4.3. RGB Lighting

The mouse features RGB lighting. Specific controls for lighting modes or colors may be available through a dedicated button on the mouse or via software (if provided by the manufacturer). Refer to the product's official website for any available software.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1. Cleaning

- Disconnect the mouse from your computer before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to wipe the surface of the mouse.
- For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild cleaning solution. Avoid excessive moisture.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or solvents.

5.2. Battery Replacement

When the mouse performance degrades or it stops responding, it is likely time to replace the batteries. Follow the battery installation steps in Section 3.1.

5.3. Storage

When not in use for extended periods, turn off the mouse to conserve battery life. Store the USB receiver in its designated slot to prevent loss. Keep the mouse in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1. Mouse Not Responding

- Ensure the mouse is turned on.
- Check if the batteries are correctly installed and have sufficient charge. Replace if necessary.
- Verify the USB receiver is securely plugged into a working USB port. Try a different USB port.
- Restart your computer.

6.2. Intermittent Connection

- Ensure the mouse is within the effective range of the USB receiver (typically up to 10 meters).
- Avoid placing the receiver near other wireless devices or large metal objects that might cause interference.
- Try plugging the USB receiver into a front USB port or a USB hub to reduce interference.

6.3. DPI or RGB Lighting Not Changing

- Ensure the mouse is powered on and connected.
- Press the DPI button repeatedly to cycle through all available settings.
- If applicable, check the manufacturer's website for any specific software or drivers required for advanced customization.
