Official instructions for the MasterCraft Jet Stream Blue Metal Flake Glitter.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This document provides essential information regarding the MasterCraft Boat Metal Flake Glitter, part number 853682, in Jet Stream Blue. This product is an 8-ounce lot of high-quality metal flake glitter designed for marine applications, commonly used to enhance the aesthetic of boat surfaces.

It is primarily intended for mixing with clear gel coating to achieve a sparkling finish. While originating from MasterCraft Boats, it may be suitable for use on other boat types.




Figure 1: A close-up view of the MasterCraft Jet Stream Blue Metal Flake Glitter, showcasing its vibrant blue color and fine flake texture. This image illustrates the product in its raw form, ready for application.

SETUP AND PREPARATION

Before applying the metal flake glitter, ensure you have all necessary materials and a suitable workspace. The glitter is designed to be mixed with a clear gel coating. It is crucial to select a gel coating compatible with your boat's surface and the intended application method.

- **Workspace:** Prepare a clean, well-ventilated area, free from dust and contaminants.
- **Safety Gear:** Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), including gloves, eye protection, and a respirator, as recommended by the gel coating manufacturer.

- Mix:** Carefully mix the desired amount of Jet Stream Blue metal flake glitter into the clear gel coating. Stir thoroughly to ensure even distribution of the flakes.
- Prepare Surface:** Ensure the boat surface is clean, dry, and properly prepared according to the gel coating manufacturer's instructions. This may involve sanding, cleaning, and priming.
- Apply:** Apply the glitter-infused gel coating to the prepared surface using appropriate methods (e.g., spraying, rolling, brushing) as recommended by the gel coating manufacturer.
- Cure:** Allow the gel coating to cure completely according to the manufacturer's specifications.
- Finish:** Once cured, additional steps such as sanding and polishing may be required to achieve the final desired finish.

MAINTENANCE

Once applied and cured within a gel coating, the metal flake glitter itself requires no specific maintenance beyond the standard care for the gel-coated surface. Maintain the boat's finish as you would any other gel-coated surface, using appropriate cleaning agents and protective waxes or sealants.

For storage of unused glitter, keep the container tightly sealed in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and moisture to preserve its quality.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This product is a raw material (metal flake glitter) and does not have operational components that would typically require troubleshooting. Any issues encountered during application, such as uneven distribution, poor adhesion, or finish imperfections, are generally related to the gel coating product, the application technique, or surface preparation.

For assistance with application-related problems, please consult the manufacturer of your gel coating product or a professional body shop/marine detailing service.
